ISRAELI SPOKESMAN SEES WAR AS PRELUDE TO NEW OIL CRISIS

Oct. 18 (IPS)--"Certainly it can be said that war as a prelude to a new oil crisis cannot be excluded," said an Israeli spokesman in Bonn today. "The main danger," he added, "is the Soviet Union. If they are not there, the Americans are surely already there."

The spokesman outlined the following scenario. "We will fire the first shot, or perhaps it is imaginable that the Arabs will be allowed the first, in order then to fully retaliate." When questioned about Israeli use of nuclear weapons in such a contingency he replied, "That is only a single possibility."

"We have learned from winning the last war and have become stronger," he continued. "The main hearth place for war is Syria. It has an immense arsenal of weapons and wants war. Moreover, there is the problem over the Golan Heights, which Israel would in no case give up."

The spokesman added in this regard that he had been fully briefed by his Ministry on the recent meeting held in the Villa Serbelloni in Bellagio, northern Italy, where Zbigniew Brzezinski of the Trilateral Commission--which presently has a task force in the Middle East--was reported to have discussed the political ramifications of war and oil embargoes on Western Europe and North America.

LABOR COMMITTEES STALL MIDDLE EAST WAR PLAN

Oct. 18 (IPS)--The current lull in press agitation about the Mideast indicates that Labor Committee organizing temporarily has stalled the Trilateral Commission's plans for a Mideast war.

The spread of the Labor Committee's exposure of the Trilateral Commission's gameplan, not only through New Solidarity but also through extensive briefings of government officials, journalists, and others has created a situation in which Rockefeller could not simply proceed to carry out a war precisely as the Labor Committees had indicated it would occur.

The penetration of the Labor Committees' Mideast analysis is indicated by the remarks of an Israeli spokesman in Bonn today, who laid out precisely the scenario for possible nuclear war between Israel and the Arab states which the Labor Committees had scooped earlier. Similarly, a Washington Post reporter yesterday responded to inquiries about the situation in the Mideast with a detailed report on what "a socialist group" has been saying--the socialist group being the Labor Committees.

The Labor Committees' success is in part due to the fact that Rockefeller, his hold over the financial and political world situation greatly strengthened over the last nine months, now has a

number of alternative options for accelerating his world fascist plot, options which we can expect to see developing into realities in the next days and weeks. But by stopping the intended war at this point, the Labor Committees have gained vital time and cut, ever so slightly, the massive edge which Rockefeller has over the working class in the overall correlation of class forces.

FRIEDRICHS AND SIMON WAGE PSYWAR IN MOSCOW

Oct. 18 OIPS)--Moscow played host in the past week to two leading emissaries from the Rockefeller cabal: U.S. Secretary of the Treasury William Simon and West German Economic Minister Hans Friedrichs. Ostensibly engaged in serious economic negotiations, both delegations conducted themselves to create confusion about detente for the Soviets.

Friedrichs was accompanied by Trilateral Commission member Otto Wolff von Amerongen, who had just carried out a similar mission to Poland the previous week. Friedrichs and Amerongen praised the development of East-West trade in general, but hedged on actual agreements for credit. In discussions of the possible joint construction by the Soviet Union and West Germany of a nuclear (fission) power plant in Kaliningrad, Friedrichs announced the condition that West Berlin be included in the plant's electric power grid. Raising the Berlin question in this form immediately introduces a cold-war chill into the Russians' detente fantasy.

Since Friedrichs was laying the groundwork for West German Chancellor Schmidt's upcoming visit to the Soviet Union (which the misguided Russians mark as a big event on the detente calendar), the Friedrichs-Amerongen group sowed considerable confusion.

Smiling Simon

Simon, on the other hand, was all smiles and assured newsmen that the Soviet negotiators "share my optimism." After sweet-talking Soviet Foreign Trade Minister Patolichev for three days, Simon returned to Washington and announced that he and President Ford will be reconsidering the recently revoked permission for grain sales to the Soviet Union. The anti-Soviet move initially was dictated by Nelson Rockefeller to UPI editors two weeks ago in San Francisco. The hint of reversing this major move against the Soviet Union is classic hard cop/soft cop psychological warfare.

Under this kind of strain, Leonid Brezhnev struck out wildly against his tormentors. Speaking on the occasion of the U.S.-Soviet Economic and Trade Cooperation Council talks, he growled harshly that the Soviet Union will not tolerate the introduction of extraneous issues (such as Soviet emigration policies) into trade negotiations. But Simon smiled and mildly restated his optimism.

It was learned today that President Ford and Senator Henry Jackson's Congressional "emigration lobby" have reached a compromise, which assumes Soviet concession of a more than 50 per cent rise in emigration. The message to Brezhnev is clear: Growl what you will, but we make the decisions.

TRILATERAL COMMISSION RAILROADS NERA CONGRESSIONAL HEARINGS,
SUPPRESSES LABOR PARTY TESTIMONY

DETROIT, Oct. 18 (IPS)--Pete Signorelli, U.S. Labor Party candidate for Governor of Michigan, and Joe Spinola, Labor Party candidate for President of Teamsters Local 299, presented evidence on the fascist nature of the National Employment Priorities Act this morning at public Congressional hearings on the bill in Detroit. In particular, the two Labor Party candidates focused their testimony on exposing the sponsorship of the Act by Rockefeller's fascist planning body, the Trilateral Commission.

The Act would establish the National Employment Relocation Administration (NERA), in order to round up the masses of workers left jobless by the Rockefellers' calculated manipulations of food, fuel, and materials supplies and force their relocation to labor-intensive energy and other "development" camps.

When the chairman of the hearings, Representative William Ford (D-Mich.), brought United Auto Workers International Executive Board member Bard Young to the speakers' podium, Signorelli intervened to point out that Young was speaking on behalf of Rockefeller's Trilateral Commission, not auto workers. Signorelli then briefed the gathering for ten minutes on the fascist content of the NERA bill, followed by a five minute presentation by Spinola to the small audience of labor bureaucrats and middle-level politicians.

Senator Walter Mondale (D-Minn.), Trilateral Commission member and sponsor of the bill, sat paralyzed with a frozen grin during the Labor Party briefing. Unable to contradict Signorelli and Spinola, Mondale and Ford were silent even when Spinola indicted the NERA bill's Congressional sponsors as Nuremberg criminals for crimes against humanity. Finally Ford ordered deputy marshals quietly to evict the Labor Party organizers so that the bogus hearings could go on undisturbed.

The entire testimony, including the eviction of Labor Party spokesmen from today's hearings, was filmed by national network TV--ABC, CBS, and NBC.

In recent weeks this Commission, the Rockefeller brothers' international policy-making body of CIA labor, government, and business agents, secretly has been briefing politicians and labor-traitor bureaucrats in order to smooth the way for passage and implementation of NERA's fascist labor projects. These preparations

include possible perpetration of nuclear warfare in the Mideast to usher in Rockefeller's Second Great Oil Hoax and NERA-style labor recycling.

Labor Subcommittee Gags Labor Party Testimony

The U.S. Labor Party was denied the right to testify on the NERA bill by the Labor Subcommittee of the House Education and Labor Committee last week. House Subcommittee member Congressman John Dent (D-Penn.), a key Rockefeller organizer for NERA legislation, told the Labor Party, "You're the only real opponents" to the bill. It is precisely for this reason that Dent and his collaborators illegally have conspired to harass workers voicing opposition to the bill and have attempted to prevent the Labor Party from representing this working-class opposition at the hearings.

Subcommittee member Ford complained that he and other Congressmen have been "harassed" by workers--their constituents!--calling to protest the NERA legislation. Ford openly boasted, "We have made every effort to include everyone who has an opinion on the bill (in the hearings), except for those unfortunate people from the Labor Party."

Congressional Threats

This blatant admission of the Subcommittee's attempts to suppress the only organized opposition to the fascist NERA bill is compounded by House Labor Subcommittee staff director Robert Vagley's threats to prosecute the Labor Party for exposing the Tri-lateral Commission's organizing in support of NERA! Not surprisingly, Vagley started his Washington career at the CIA in 1963 and he later headed up the Capitol Hill Young Democrats.

Vagley and Rep. Dominick Daniels (D-New Jersey) are carrying out Rockefeller's orders "not to allow these hearings" to become "a platform for Labor Party ideas," by hanging up on worker constituents who call them about NERA. They also have illegally threatened to wiretap the telephones of these workers. Daniels has even attempted to coerce workers into giving him their phone numbers in order to make his wiretapping scheme a bit easier!

In addition, Congressional sponsors of NERA legislation from the Midwest and Midatlantic regions have been told by Vagley and Daniels to hang up on working class constituents who call to demand fair hearings and organized opposition to the NERA bill.

FRANCE TO EXPORT INDUSTRY TO THIRD WORLD

Oct. 18 (IPS)--In return for the financing of France's national debt by Rockefeller sheikhs and the Shah of Iran, President Giscard d'Estaing and the French employers federation, the CNFF, have agreed to ship industry lock, stock, and barrel to labor-

intensive projects in the Third World. The financing was accomplished through the issuance of short-term paper to the Arabs via the French nationalized banking sector.

Both Giscard's new planning council and the CNFF announced last week that the future of French industry was in the oil-producing countries. Exports to the Mideast already have increased 55 per cent in the first seven months of this year. Next week, an important delegation of CNFF officials will be in Algeria, where they are expecting to receive a 10 billion Franc contract for the installation of factories there. Other markets which the CNFF considers open to them are Iran, Iraq, Indonesia, and Nigeria.

One of the key figures in implementing Rockefeller's policy in France is Jacques Ferry, who holds three major positions on the CNFF. Aside from being its Vice President, he is also President of its International Relations Committee and head of its Steel Federation. Ferry originated the "Ferry Plan," a policy of concentrating steel production in coastal areas while removing manpower from other areas. Its successful implementation has led to the construction of the huge Fos-sur-Mer steel and oil refinery complex near Marseilles. Recently 3,000 workers who were just laid off from the Lorraine steel plants have "agreed" to be relocated to Fos, where death rates are among the highest in the country.

In order to facilitate the flow of Arab funds into France, the regional planning agency DATAR, directed by "seal and search" expert Minister of Interior Poniatowski, has just announced the opening of a new office in the Persian Gulf.

UMW FUNDS PRODUCTIVITY STUDY BY BRAINWASHER

Oct. 18 (IPS)--IPS has come into the possession of documents that show that the United Mineworkers (UMW) is funding at least one of Dr. Eric Trist's three phase productivity studies in the coal fields. Trist, a leading CIA psychiatrist, is a brainwashing specialist.

Operating out of the Rockefeller funded Tavistock Institute, Trist was largely responsible for the destruction of the British Miners Union and mass layoffs of "unproductive miners" over the last two decades. Documents reveal that Trist is currently doing pioneer work that will lead to drastic layoffs in American coal fields and redeployment of miners to energy development projects.

One of Trist's current projects to produce "self-regulating" work teams (gangs) at the Rushton Mine in Johnstown, Pa. is being conducted under the auspices of the National Commission on Productivity (NCOP) of which Trilateral Commission member I.W. Abel has been a leading member. Trist, who presently operates out of the Wharton School in Philadelphia, is also employed by NCOP's National Quality of Work Center in Washington, D.C.

The Rushton study after one year is now in its third phase, during which worker-management committees have replaced foremen

and are setting wage levels and working conditions. This study in fascist labor methods is being financed jointly by Rushton mines and the UMW at \$32,500 each!

AGENTS IN PSP ATTEMPT HARASSMENT
OF LATIN LEFTISTS CLOSE TO LABOR COMMITTEES

NEW YORK, Oct. 17 (IPS)--In a last-ditch attempt to stop the growing hegemony of the National Caucus of Labor Committees and the Latin American Labor Committees in Latin communities throughout the United States, the CIA-controlled right wing of the Puerto Rican Socialist Party (PSP) has launched a campaign of harassment against former PSP members who have joined or come around the Labor Committees in the past few weeks.

The attacks are aimed directly against Labor Committee exposure of the CIA's plan to provoke race riots to divert the enormous ferment in Latin communities from working-class organizing into suicidal in-fighting between groups of workers. In reality the goals of these groups are identical: To stop the Rockefellers' plan for fascism, and to create workers governments worldwide within the next few years.

Based on our organizing the Labor Committees have the political credibility to blow the PSP wide open in the U.S. Along with the Revolutionary Union and the Socialist Workers Party, the PSP is one of the CIA's major U.S. countergang-type networks. The Labor Committees intend to pull out of the PSP the entirety of its pro-working-class membership. This potential is driving the agents within the PSP and their controllers into hysteria.

Desperate Moves

This hysteria has led them to stupid, desperate moves. Oct. 4 a car belonging to Ramon Ayala and Carmen Caceres was destroyed by fire--just three days after they officially joined the Labor Committees. Yesterday, the car of Juan Caceres, Carmen Caceres' brother, also was burned. Juan is not a member of the Labor Committees but has been so identified recently because of his close work with the Latin American Labor Committees.

The Labor Committee Security Staff has identified the arsonist as an agent-provocateur inside the PSP. This person had been pointed out to the leader of the U.S. branch of the PSP, Ramon Arbona, as an agent by both Carmen Caceres and Ramon Ayala many months ago. The agent in question is well known to other PSP members as an inciter to semi-terrorist activities in that group. He has taken credit for many "rip-offs," and claims to have been a member of ROTC--where he may have been recruited or brainwashed into the ranks of CIA operatives. Just before the attack on Ayala's car, the agent was heard to say that he was "out to get Ramon's ass."

In Philadelphia last Saturday, Oct. 12, the PSP declared its intentions to "blow away" Labor Committee organizers. When New Solidarity salesmen arrived at a regular distribution site, nine PSP goons were stationed at the corner of 5th and Canbria Streets --normally a spot where there would be only two PSPers peddling their counterinsurgent rag Claridad.

NCLC Warns Agents of Exposure Before Working Class

The Labor Committees have issued a public warning that if any harm comes to Carmen Caceres, Ramon Ayala, or Juan Caceres, their children, or any members of their families, the Labor Committees and the working class will hold responsible both the PSP and the individuals mentioned above.

PSI CLASS TRAITORS URGE WORKERS TO FOLLOW BRITISH EXAMPLE

Oct. 17 (IPS)--The same factions in the Italian Socialist Party (PSI) which have carried out slanders and goon attacks against the European Labor Committees this week initiated a propoganda campaign aimed at the desperate Italian working class. These PSI factioneers proposed to Italy's trade unions and workers that they follow the example of the British Labour Party. As the Labor Committees have documented, the Labour Party is run entirely by the Rockefeller-funded Tavistock Institute in London, pioneers in brainwashing and psychological warfare.

Three speeches reported in the PSI newspaper Avanti Oct. 15 bring out this theme explicitly. Francesco DeMartino, the Socialist Party secretary and leader of the majority faction, called for "courageous political decisions which first of all will succeed in getting the workers' consensus, just as occurred in Great Britain, on the line indicated by the Labour Party."

DeMartino was echoed by the Socialist parliamentary group leader Mariotti who held out a "new order in national society... meaning contact with the unions, an important political fact which permitted the Labourists themselves to get an absolute majority."

Finally, PSI central committee member and president of the Tuscany regional government Lelio Lagorio announced: "The PSI in substance asks that Wilson's example be followed. Against the strategy of our conservatives, who like the British ones are advancing an anti-crisis program founded on a total no to the neediest classes and defiance of the unions, the PSI--like the Labour Party--counterposes a program of harsh austerity but supported by the unions, with many no's but some yes's capable of tying the masses to the institutions." (emphasis added)

The Reality of the Labour Party

Under the misleadership of the Labour Party, the British population has capitulated to criminal policies like Prime Minister Harold Wilson's "Social Contract," which has driven workers into slave labor conditions in the North Sea oil development projects. Meanwhile, British living standards since last January have collapsed to sub-human levels. In Italy, the major spokesman for the "social contract" has been chief CIA agent Ugo La Malfa, head of the Republican Party.

The Turin daily La Stampa, owned by Trilateral Commission member Gianni Agnelli (of FIAT) and directed by another Trilateral agent Arrigo Levi, quickly picked up the PSI leaders' willingness to adopt the "Labour"-La Malfa-CIA line. Playing on the opportunism of the Italian "Socialists" who hope to pick up votes by following this ploy, La Stampa's editorial today notes: "You can turn the words around however you like, but what you end up with is that social pact of which La Malfa talks and which gave the most votes to the Labour Party in England...There's much uncertainty in the PSI."

The one uncertainty is whether the class traitors in the party leadership will be able to feed the Tavistock line to Italian workers.

ROCKEFELLER "SCANDALS:" PSYWAR ON CONGRESS

WASHINGTON, D.C., Oct. 16 (IPS)--By scurrying away from Nelson Rockefeller's challenge immediately to reopen Senate hearings on his confirmation as Vice President, Congress has admitted that its recent widely-publicized investigation of Rockefeller is a farce.

Rockefeller's demand to testify this week on his six-figure cash gift to Tri-state transportation czar William Ronan and other small-time scandals in effect told Congress to put up or shut up.

"I'm being tried in the press," Rockefeller cried just before Congress reached its decision. However, the sources of the various newspaper stories on his political philanthropy have in all cases been either Rockefeller's own press secretary Hugh Morrow, leading Rockefeller press organ the New York Times, or the handpicked Watergate and Law Enforcement Assistance Administration operatives on the House Judiciary Committee.

Controlled Leaks

The so-called Rockefeller scandals, his financial contributions for a 1970 smear job on Senatorial candidate Arthur Goldberg and contributions to newspaper columnist Thomas Braden, are a product of all three of these "informed sources." Certain persons "close to the Judiciary Committee" leaked the story to New

York Times reporters who then played a game in print with Rockefeller and his press secretary to create the illusion that the press and Congressional committees are doing an investigative job.

What the press never mentioned was that Goldberg and Braden have been Rockefeller associates since their days in the Office of Strategic Services, the predecessor of the CIA. Nor did they report that Clifton Daniel, who directed the scandal from his post as Washington Bureau chief of the New York Times, is one of Rockefeller's closest associates.

Right on cue, the moment Congress retreated under Rockefeller's challenge, the New York Times rushed into print an editorial, undoubtedly written beforehand, blasting the legislators for postponing Rockefeller's "day in court."

The Real Scandal

Congress has before it the testimony of Labor Committee Chairman Lyn Marcus from the previous Senate Rules Committee hearings on Rockefeller. Congress also has the extensive U.S. Labor Party brief on the Rockefeller empire, his family's establishment of supranational fascist institutions like the Trilateral Commission --more powerful than any mere national government. As the Labor Committee Stop Rockefeller Campaign demonstrated across the country, Congress has all the evidence and the popular support needed to break open the real scandal of Rockefeller's fascist plans.

Thus, Senate Rules Committee Chairman Howard Cannon's statement that he still expects Rockefeller to be confirmed after new hearings are held following the November elections indicates precisely that most Congressmen are not serious about a real investigation of Rockefeller. They are setting themselves up for a cover-up scandal of more than Watergate proportions.

GOVERNMENT REPLACES AEC, BUILDS NUCLEAR SECURITY THREAT

Oct. 16 (IPS)--Acting in a record 24 hours with no prior publicity, both houses of Congress last week passed--and President Ford signed --a bill abolishing the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) and creating a single new Energy Research Development Administration (ERDA) to direct all energy-related activities of the Federal government, in accord with Rockefeller plans for slave labor "energy projects." Research and development regarding "energy sources" until now has been shared between the AEC and at least three other government agencies--the Interior Department, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the National Science Foundation.

The Atomic Energy Commission, to be renamed the Nuclear Energy Regulatory Authority under ERDA, has increased its security budget from \$50.7 million to \$89.8 million this year. Its aim is to advance

the government's terror campaign to provide the public climate for acceptance of megadeath nuclear policies. The press has aided these scare tactics with well-placed news articles on the imminent danger of small nuclear weapons being built or stolen by political terrorists.

"Terrible Trouble"

Journalist Jack Anderson, a chief purveyor of "leaked" information from the CIA, gave the public a full briefing on this terrorist threat in the September issue of Parade magazine: "If the terrorists get their hands on nuclear weapons," Anderson muses, "they could hold entire cities for ransom. And the likelihood is that the threatened cities wouldn't be such faraway places as Beirut, Belfast, and Bangkok. The experts believe that foreign terrorists...will carry their warfare to America." And if that isn't enough hard evidence to scare you into backing increased national security measures, Anderson adds the "fact" that U.S. arsenals are "vulnerable." "These two factors," he concludes, "spell terrible trouble for the U.S. in the year ahead."

Where did Jack Anderson get his facts? He cites only four sources: the FBI's National Bomb Data Center, the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, the International Association of Chiefs of Police, and the Ford Foundation--i.e., the world's foremost domestic counterinsurgency ("terrorist") organizations.

Rockefeller's liberal helpers in Congress--Senators Mondale (D.-Minn.), Hart (D.-Mich.), and Ribicoff (D.-Conn.)--are advancing this blatant scare campaign with a push for action towards a tightly run national security force. Mondale and Hart are urging a two to three year postponement on the use of plutonium as a fission fuel until there is "a nuclear security force making background checks on anyone who might conceivably have an opportunity to steal the material." Ribicoff also has been yelping about the equal priority of security as well as operating safety in the construction of fission reactors. Last April, he released an Atomic Energy Commission document in which AEC bureaucrats confessed that their measures to foil terrorists were inadequate.

CIA Nuclear Terror

Despite the concern of these gentlemen, the only "terrorists" who have tried and succeeded in an attempt to steal nuclear weapons, as Jack Anderson points out, were the CIA-trained Green Berets. As in the takeover of the small town of McMinnville, Oregon last spring, the Green Berets claim that the nuclear heist was just a "practice maneuver."

AGRICULTURAL REPORT

NATIONAL FARMERS ORGANIZATION DIRECTS FOOD WITHHOLDING

Oct. 15 (IPS)--The National Farmers' Organization (NFO) has launched a frenzied national campaign of food destruction and withholding, which plays directly into Rockefeller's strategy of dismantling world food production. Last night, the NFO leadership held over 160 local meetings around the country calling on farmers to withhold food from the market in order to force up prices. Today, the NFO directed a Wisconsin farmers' slaughtering of over 650 calves, a protest action also threatened by livestock farmers in other states.

The food shortages which could result in U.S. cities this winter will complete the psywar arsenal of energy shortage hoaxes, mass layoffs, and provoked race riots with which Rockefeller intends to terrorize the working class and isolate farmers. Since the NFO top leadership long has been advised and funded by the United Auto Workers, it is possible that the orders for the food destruction drive came from Rockefeller's Trilateral Commission itself--through Leonard Woodcock.

At each NFO meeting, local officials played a tape of NFO president Oren Lee Staley calling for food withholding actions and the establishment of an NFO-controlled national collection, dispatch, and delivery system for farm goods. The NFO already has leased 600 grain hoppers for this purpose. In upstate New York, NFO leaders spoke in terms of consolidating 30 per cent of all beef and dairy production under NFO control.

Stressing the go-it-alone nature of their struggle, Staley said: "We have to do it ourselves, no one else can do it for us." He warned especially against allowing unnamed "non-members" at meetings, ostensibly because the organization is under investigation by the Securities Exchange Commission for fraudulent dues collection.

Labor Party Organizers Warn NFO Against Farmer-Only Struggle

U.S. Labor Party organizers intervened at eight NFO gatherings, including three in upstate New York, two in Michigan, and meetings in Chicago, Denver, and Sacramento. Farmers listened attentively as the socialist organizers briefed them on the Rockefeller-World Bank plan to destroy "non-creditworthy" agriculture and thereby eliminate one billion "useless eaters." The proposed withholding tactic is in line with the Rockefeller gameplan of reducing working class consumption, the organizers warned. Farmers must give up suicidal farmer-only struggles by joining the working class fight for expanded food production based on an emergency farm debt moratorium and development of fusion power as an energy source.

The lively questioning of Labor Party speakers which followed these presentations contrasted sharply with the demoralized response to Staley's speech. In West Branch, Michigan, the meeting of 100 farmers would have adjourned without any discussion if not for Labor Party organizer Wayne Evans' insistence on political discussion. Evans' speech drew out a full range of responses from the swinish "Aren't workers paid too much?" to a clear recognition that Evans had spoken the truth. Evans' proposal for building a farmer-worker alliance impressed farmers as more serious than the NFO officials' windbagging, for despite the NFO pitch for new membership, no one would sign up.

Although NFO executive member Butch Swain and some second-level leaders took some initial steps to organize with the Labor Party this summer, many have held back since. One of the reasons is an organizational financial crisis and threats to place the organization into receivership. It was predictable that, under pressure, these more honest farm leaders would go along with withholding actions, a standard NFO tactic and the way the organization was built. The NFO, already discredited among farmers, must be held responsible for helping whip up hysterical food destruction by farmers around the country, driving one more wedge between farmers and their working class allies.

PROTESTING U.S. FARMERS URGE FOOD DESTRUCTION AND CUTBACKS

Oct. 16 (IPS)--Livestock farmers throughout North America have stepped up their desperate protest actions, destroying their own livestock and threatening to withdraw from production. In most cases, farmers' anger has been diverted by politicians along protectionist lines that remove responsibility for the crisis from the Rockefeller cabal. A few leading examples have been compiled by IPS:

*In Curtis, Wisconsin, Oct. 15, the NFO led about 300 farmers in the slaughter of more than 650 calves and 15 pigs as a protest against rising feed costs and low prices for farm products.

*In Oklahoma, a new group emerged calling itself the "Concerned Cattlemen of Oklahoma." Frank Spagna, the chairman of this self-described "grass-roots group of farmers," has announced an eight-point program, including demands to halt all imports of beef and dairy products and to stop all exports of fertilizers.

*In Southeast Colorado, 250 cattlemen met to discuss the economic crisis. Henry Blackburn, president of the Southern Colorado Cattlemen's Association, voiced these farmers' despair: "The bottom's dropped out of the market and we're at our wits end." The president of the Colorado Cattlemen's Association is leading a delegation to Washington, D.C., to meet with President Ford.

*In East and West Texas, beef and dairy farmers are holding off on their threatened slaughter actions until they meet with U.S. Department of Agriculture officials and House Agriculture Committee head, W. R. Poage. The Texas Commissioner of Agriculture John C. White, who is acting as the farmers' "advocate," has called for beef and dairy import controls.

*In Quebec, at an Oct. 12 rally, 1500 farmers led by the Quebec Farmers Union threatened to stop all cattle shipments until the spring unless they receive subsidies.

ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION CONTROLS WORLD FOOD CONFERENCE

Oct. 13 (IPS)--The Rockefeller Foundation is the real power running the upcoming United Nations World Food Conference, IPS was told today. In an Oct. 13 interview, a Rockefeller Foundation information officer admitted to IPS that although former Egyptian government official S. Marei is the nominal director of the World Food Conference, the real controller is the deputy director Dr. John Hannah. Hannah began his career in food control under the personal guidance of Nelson Rockefeller in 1949, when Rockefeller headed up the predecessor agency to AID. A faithful Rockefeller family servant ever since, Hannah has drawn his Food Conference staff directly from the top officials of the Rockefeller Foundation's agricultural section. The major document to be submitted to the conference by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) actually was written by Dr. Colin McClung of the Rockefeller Foundation.

Although the Foundation does not expect any specific food control schemes to emerge from the conference itself, the main objective is to convince all participating governments to accept the principle of food control, the Foundation spokesman stated.

FAO BACKS FOOD CONTROL

Oct. 15 (IPS)--The head of the UN-affiliated Food and Agriculture Organization Boerma issued a call yesterday for every major food-exporting country to set aside a part of their production for the developing countries. Thus Boerma has backed the mechanism for Rockefeller's plan to take control of the world's food supplies and make political decisions about who shall eat.

Boerma praised the Ford Administration's cancellation of the Soviet Union's grain order, which he said was the type of action necessary to insure food supplies for the poorer nations. Under the cover of alleviating "Third World" famines, Boerma is moving to establish a world rationing system where selected labor-intensive "development" zones will receive grain while the rest of the population is allowed to starve.

ATTACKS ON BUTZ, MILK CO-OPS CONTINUE

Oct. 14 (IPS)--The Rockefeller forces have stepped up their campaign to oust U.S. Agriculture Secretary Earl Butz from office. A Federal District Court judge in Minneapolis has ruled against Butz in a suit brought by the Food Research and Action Center of New York and the Minneapolis Legal Aid Society on behalf of the National Welfare Rights Organization (NWRO), Butz is charged with failure to implement the Food Stamp Act's outreach requirement for development of a program to inform low-income families of their rights to food relief.

Since NWRO is a mere HEW-front which has supported various government programs such as the forced-work welfare programs, the real issue cannot be food stamps alone. Rather, Butz represents a persistent thorn in Rockefeller's side, impeding his food control policies.

A second attack on Butz in today's press dovetails with the efforts to dismantle farmer-owned cooperatives. An Associated Press release in today's New York Times accuses the U.S. Department of Agriculture of covering up the extent to which milk co-ops have charged bottlers more than the Federal minimum prices. The article plays up the "bargaining muscle" of milk co-ops to raise prices and stresses their immunity from anti-trust laws. This is only one of a barrage of articles in the Times and Washington Post aimed at eliminating farmers' legal protections from anti-trust suits provided under the Capper-Volstead Act.

NAZI SCIENTIST CALLS FOR "A NEW MODE OF LIFE"--GENOCIDE

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 17 (IPS)--Two hundred scientists and others sat politely yesterday as Jay Forrester, sociopathic professor of management at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, called for mass starvation as the only solution to the world's problems. Forrester was reporting to a two-day "scientific" conference at the Franklin Institute here on his "Humanitarian Ethics of Food Relief," which calls for world triage.

Triage was originally a French term referring to a practice established in the army during the first World War. Battle casualties were divided into two categories: those who would not survive, even with medical attention, were abandoned to unattended certain death, so that those whose wounds were not so serious could receive a fuller share of scarce medical supplies and aid.

Forrester is a long-standing employee in the Rockefellers' academic stable of sub-humans. His earlier computer study, the totally specious "Limits to Growth," was financed by the Club of Rome, an international agency itself financed by the Rockefeller Foundation, and Giovanni Agnelli of Fiat. This first "garbage in-

garbage out" print-out predicted that natural resources would run out by the year 2000 if Zero Growth were not enforced in the 1970s. Now that the Rockefellers' timetable for fascist domination is targeted for 1975, Forrester's computer has accelerated its "numbers games" calling for mass extermination as the only means of overcoming the capitalist crisis.

Starve Them Out

In his talk at the Franklin Conference, "The Limits to Growth Revisited," Forrester stated: "Overpopulation, food shortages, and lack of energy are now so great that a transition to a new mode of life is unstoppable." According to Forrester, "Triage on a world scale must be used to reduce the population so that diminishing supplies of food and energy are not rapidly exhausted."

Forrester left no room for doubt of the dead seriousness of his fascist intentions. He proposed, as an example of how to begin carrying out triage, that agricultural production of the advanced capitalist countries should be reduced so that exports to the underdeveloped countries could be halted. "This would not have a great effect on the hungry, but would have the beneficial effect of keeping the population down," stated Nazi scientist Forrester.

An audience of actual human beings would have dragged this mass murderer from the stage and strung him up. Instead, Forrester received the Potts medal for his two genocidal "numbers games" computer studies. The praise for Forrester's murderous "numbers games" is no surprise. This Franklin Conference, the first, was organized by none other than the chairman of Rockefeller University, Dr. Frederick Sietz.

DEFLATION CLAIMS FIRST CASUALTIES IN WORLD FINANCE

Oct. 18 (IPS)--At least ten financial companies throughout the industrial world have turned over during the last 48 hours, the first casualties of David Rockefeller's international deflation policy. Several times that many are expected to follow within the next ten trading days.

Without exception, this week's casualty list is made up of marginal financial operators, banks and securities outfits who eked their living by juggling between various markets. But more significant than the array of corpses is their cause of death: the historical period of ever-expanding capitalist credit which gave these hustlers a free ride has ended. Already in the first stages of collapse, the financial markets have shaken out their lice.

Worst hit among national sectors is Italy, where the break-up of the Sindona banking empire has triggered a chain of failures which threatens to eradicate the country's non-governmental finance

sector. On orders from Italian finance minister Guido Carli and the U.S. Federal Reserve Board, bankruptcy judges struck down the two pillars of the Sindona group this week. Franklin National Bank, once the twentieth largest U.S. banking house, and the Banca Privata Italiana, Italy's biggest private bank, either were absorbed or dissolved by David Rockefeller's cronies, leaving debts unpaid and several institutions in trouble. Two medium-sized Italian banks, the Banca di Milano and the Interbanca, suffered runs this week in the shadow of Sindona.

The immediate cause of death of these institutions was the month-long collapse of the Italian stock market, a highly speculative arena which hosted any number of major operators. Several other Italian finance houses are reportedly in difficulty for this and other reasons.

Contacted in New York, a spokesman for the Bank of America International, part-owner of the stricken Interbanca, told IPS that no support operation was being considered. "We're trying to reduce our exposure in Italy as much as possible," the world's largest commercial bank stated.

In a similar development, one of Portugal's largest commercial banks and the major force on the country's stock market was taken over by the government to prevent collapse. On other stock markets, Jessel Securities in Great Britain, a reputed high-stakes speculator, and Alexander Brown and Sons, one of the most venerable brokerage firms in the U.S., are reported to be insolvent. Alexander Brown, which claims to be the country's oldest stockbrokers, is under investigation by the Securities and Exchange Commission for stock fraud.

Casualties

On line at the mortuary are at least 150 American banks on the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation's "trouble list," and several hundred international operators.

Three months ago, the week's catch of bankruptcy victims would have inspired Jeremiads on the financial pages of the CIA press. This week, the New York Times failed to mention the Italian disasters. The obituary notices were hidden between the columns by depressed financial editors. The collapse is now taken for granted; the average capitalist doesn't want to hear any more about it.

Why Now?

Directly behind the slaughter is the prostration of all capitalist markets, from the broken stock markets to the sleepy foreign exchange desks. Inventory liquidation--the liquidation of close to \$150 billion in raw materials or unsold wares in the U.S. alone--could reduce the profitability of U.S. corporations by three-quarters during the last three months of 1974. While the chips are still falling, there is no sane way to place a valuation upon stocks, or shares in companies' profits.

By the same token, interest rates no longer have meaning, since the borrowing of money wholesale and the lending of money retail through the banking system is shutting down. As IPS has reported, the top U.S. banks are refusing to take new deposits and refusing to lend them, while the rate of new credit creation has fallen to one per cent a year. With 12 per cent inflation, this is a negative rate of credit increase of 11 per cent a year--precisely equal to the rate of credit contraction between 1929 and 1935! Interest rates are falling, while new bank loans are as hard to come by on Wall Street as pink unicorns.

The foreign exchange market--which trades billions of different currencies according to more or less attractive interest rates --has lost its yardstick, since the numbers might as well be attached to lottery tickets. The hustlers who worked the quick buck side of this market have no more prospects than cockroaches in a ghost town. In the last two days, ten of them were made aware of it

FREEMAN PROMOTES PLAN TO PAY AFRICAN DEBT

Oct. 12 (IPS)--Former U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Orville Freeman is spearheading the Rockefeller drive for labor-intensive agriculture. Freeman has proposed the bringing together of Arab oil money, American agriculture expertise, and fertile African land as the "solution" to world food shortages. His goal is to expand production of rice, sugar, cocoa, and grains--not for African consumption but for export to pay off the African governments' heavy foreign debts.

Freeman says that the proposal already has been accepted by representatives of agro-industry who met in Toronto last month in a special "consultation" with World Food Conference officials. The list of companies which attended the Toronto conference reads like a who's who in Rockefeller cabal-linked supranationals: Bechtel, Cargill, Dow Chemical, Fiat, Ford, General Mills, International Harvester, Mitsubishi, Unilever, Barclays Bank International....
