## I. INTERNATIONAL.

### EGYPT GROWING RESTLESS AT U.S.-ISRAELI DIPLOMACY

JULY 18 (IPS) -- PROTRACTED AND FREQUENT ISRAEL-U.S. MEETINGS "HAVE CAUSED GROWING CONCERN IN CAIRO" THAT THE U.S. HAS SOFTENED ITS DEMANDS ON ISRAEL TO WITHDRAW FROM SINAI TERRITORIES, REPORTS YESTERDAY'S LONDON TIMES.

THE EGYPTIAN MOVE NOT TO RENEW THE MANDATE OF UNITED NATIONS TROOPS WAS MOTIVATED BY A "REAL FEAR ON THE PART OF THE EGYPTIANS THAT THE CURRENT AMERICAN PEACE OFFENSIVE WOULD COME TO GRIEF," SAYS THE TIMES.

### WEST GERMAN SOURCE REPORTS INCREASE IN STRENGTH OF ISRAELI PEACE FORCES

WIESBADEN, BRD, JULY 18 (IPS) -- A HIGHLY-PLACED WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY (SPD) SOURCE TOLD IPS YESTERDAY THAT "THE CAMP OF THE PEACE FORCES IN ISRAEL HAS DECISIVELY INCREASED. EVEN PRIME MINISTER RABIN WAS CHANGED IN THAT RESPECT" DURING HIS RECENT VISIT TO WEST GERMANY, THE SOURCE AFFIRMED.

### PLO SEEKS WEAPONS FROM RED CHINA

JULY 18 (IPS) -- A HIGH-LEVEL DELEGATION FROM FATAH, THE MAIN GUERRILLA GROUP OF THE PALESTINIAN LIBERATION ORGANIZATION (PLO), LEFT FOR PEKING WEDNESDAY TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE CHINESE FOR ARMS SUPPLIES, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN.

THE LIBYAN NEWSPAPER AS SAFIR REPORTS THAT THE DELEGATION IS HEADED BY ABU JIHAD, ALLEGEDLY A POWERFUL AIDE TO CIA-AGENT YASSER ARABAT, PLO CHIEF. THE SUN CITES INFORMANTS WHO SEE A NEW LEVEL OF RELATIONS BETWEEN PEKING AND THE PLO, AND DETECT "DISCONTENT" BETWEEN THE PLO AND MOSCOW.

### KISSINGER PROVOKED ISLAMIC CONFERENCE DECISION

JULY 18 (IPS) -- THE RECENT ISLAM CONFERENCE THAT CALLED FOR ISRAEL'S EXPULSION FROM THE UNITED NATIONS HAD ORIGINALLY ONLY PLANNED TO CALL FOR GENERAL ANTI-ISRAEL SANCTIONS, BUT SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER'S WARNINGS AGAINST AN ISRAEL EXPULSION "APPEARED TO PRODUCE A BACKLASH AND HARDEN THEIR RESOLVE," ACCORDING TO (E)

BEIRUT SOURCES REPORTED BY YESTERDAY'S CHRISTIAN SCIENCE MONITOR.

THE ANTI-ISRAEL MOVE WAS PUSHED BY SYRIA AND THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION.

#### SPD PRAESIDIUM RESOLVES IN SUPPORT OF CSCE

JULY 18 (IPS) -- THE PRAESIDIUM OF THE WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY ISSUED A STATEMENT AFFIRMING DETENTE AND SUPPORTING THE CONFERENCE ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION IN EUROPE (CSCE) ON THE RETURN OF SPD CHAIRMAN WILLY BRANDT FROM MOSCOW. "DETENTE POLICY," THE PRAESIDIUM STATED, "MUST BE REALIZED THROUGH PRACTICAL MEASURES, THE RENUNCIATION OF VIOLENCE MUST BECOME THE DOMINATING PRINCIPLE OF INTERNATIONAL POLICY." THE STATEMENT WAS PRINTED IN WEDNESDAY'S UNSERE ZEIT, NEWSPAPER OF THE WEST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

MEANWHILE, WOLFGANG MISCHNIK, PARLIAMENTARY FACTION LEADER OF THE WEST GERMAN FREE DEMOCRATIC PARTY, WRITES IN TODAY'S AUGSBURGER ALLGEMEINEN ON THE CSCE THAT "THESE AGREEMENTS HAVE TO DO WITH CONCRETE DECLARATIONS OF INTENT OF THE PARTICIPATING STATES, TO SOLVE EXISTING PROBLEMS PEACEFULLY, AND TO CREATE THE PRECONDITION FOR MORE ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL COOPERATION." MISCHNIK ALSO WRITES THAT AFTER THE CSCE, THE WEST WILL ALSO HANDLE THE STRATEGIC ARMS LIMITATIONS TALKS, SALT, SO THAT "HERE TOO, THERE WILL NOT BE ANY ONE-SIDED DEMANDS BY US." THIS SALT CONCESSION IS ENTIRELY CONTRADICTORY TO THE UNILATERAL CONCESSIONS THAT THE U.S. IS DEMANDING OF THE WARSAW PACT IN THESE DISCUSSIONS.

#### MAOIST PROVOCATEURS ATTACK ELC

WIESBADEN, BRD, JULY 18 (IPS) -- IN THREE SEPARATE INCIDENTS THIS WEEK, MAOIST POLICE PROVOCATEURS PHYSICALLY ATTACKED ORGANIZERS FOR THE EUROPEAN LABOR PARTY AT THE UNEMPLOYMENT OFFICE IN COLCOENE, WEST GERMANY. ON WEDNESDAY, THE MAOISTS FIRST ASSAULTED A WOMAN ELP MEMBER, THEN PUSHED DOWN ANOTHER ELP ORGANIZER WHO WAS PHOTOGRAPHING THE INCIDENT AND STOLE HIS CAMERA. IN ADDITION, THE BREMEN GROUP OF THE ELP WAS ALSO SET UPON BY MAOISTS OUTSIDE AN UNEMPLOYMENT OFFICE YESTERDAY. IN EACH OF THESE CASES, ELP ORGANIZERS WERE SAVED FROM SERIOUS INJURY BY THE UNANIMOUS SUPPORT OF UNEMPLOYED WORKERS WHO IDENTIFIED THE MAOISTS AS "FASCISTS".

IN A RELATED POLICE ACTION AGAINST THE ELP, THE BREMEN AND STUTTGART POLICE DEPARTMENTS HAVE SET EXORBITANT FEES FOR "SELLING PERMITS" TO PREVENT THE ELP FROM SELLING ITS PRESS IN THOSE CITIES. YESTERDAY THE POLICE OF BOTH CITIES DRUMMED UP PHONY CHARGES THAT THE ELP ORGANIZERS ARE "FORCING" WORKERS TO BUY NEUE SOLIDARITAET.

EEC MINISTERS MEET IN TOP SECRECY;  
HEAR W. GERMAN LABOR AGENT

JULY 18 (IPS) -- THE WEST GERMAN PAPER FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG REPORTS TODAY THAT UNDER HIGHLY UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES, WEST GERMAN TRADE UNION FEDERATION HEAD HEINZ OSCAR VETTER ADDRESSED THE COMMON MARKET COUNCIL OF MINISTERS' MEETING YESTERDAY, CALLING ON THE ASSEMBLY TO HOLD AN EXTRAORDINARY CONFERENCE ON EUROPEAN SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC PROBLEMS THIS FALL.

THE FRENCH PRESS, LED BY LE MONDE AND LE FIGARO, HAVE FAILED TO PICK UP THE VETTER STORY AND ARE SIMPLY SAYING THAT THE MEETING TOOK PLACE IN "TOP SECRECY" WITH ONLY "FRAGMENTED" REPORTS BEING LEAKED TO THE PRESS.

LE MONDE REPORTS PSP DEMO A BRAWL

JULY 18 (IPS) -- A PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY DEMONSTRATION IN LISBON TWO DAYS AGO WHICH GATHERED A RIGHTIST MOB OF 15,000, "REVEALED THE REAL IMAGE OF THE (SOCIALIST) PARTY." "THE DAMS BROKE, THE MASKS FELL," REPORTS THE INFLUENTIAL FRENCH DAILY LE MONDE JULY 17. ACCORDING TO LE MONDE'S LISBON CORRESPONDENTS A CLOSE COLLABORATOR OF PREMIER VASCO GONCALVES DENOUNCED THE PSP AS "THE TROJAN HORSE OF REACTION." LE MONDE ALSO IMPLIES THE PSP WAS INVOLVED IN SETTING UP THE RIO-MAIOR INCIDENT THREE DAYS AGO DURING WHICH PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY HEADQUARTERS WERE BURNT DOWN.

LOVE IN THE LOCKER ROOM

JULY 18 (IPS) -- "THE KEY TO THE POLITICAL SITUATION IN SPAIN, AS IN PORTUGAL, IS HELD BY THE ARMY. BUT THERE IS NO REASON TO DOUBT ITS LOYALTY TO (PRINCE) JUAN CARLOS ONCE HE SUCCEEDS" TO THE POST OF SPAIN'S AGING DICTATOR, GEN. FRANCO. THUS WRITES WINSTON S. CHURCHILL, A MEMBER OF BRITISH PARLIAMENT AND GRANDSON OF THE BRITISH WORLD WAR II LEADER, ON THE EDITORIAL PAGE OF YESTERDAY'S LONDON DAILY TELEGRAPH. AS EVIDENCE FOR HIS CLAIM THAT PRINCE JUAN CARLOS HAS THE INTENSE SUPPORT OF FRANCO'S BASE, THE SPANISH MILITARY, CHURCHILL QUOTES THE FOLLOWING COMMENT THAT JUAN CARLOS MADE TO HIM IN AN EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW. "WHEN YOU HAVE SPENT TWO YEARS NAKED UNDER THE SHOWER WITH SOME 350 OF YOUR CONTEMPORARIES IN MILITARY ACADEMY, THERE ARE FEW BARRIERS BETWEEN YOU AND THEM."

MAC TREASURER: "IT HAS TO LOOK EQUITABLE",  
BUT "THE PENTAGON HAS A BACKUP"

NEW YORK, JULY 18 (IPS) -- DONNA SHALALA, THE TREASURER OF THE MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE CORPORATION (BIG MAC) SAID TODAY THAT A WAGE FREEZE AND CITY LAYOFFS COULD BE IMPOSED "IF YOU MAKE IT LOOK EQUITABLE."

"I THINK THAT THE UNIONS WILL GO ALONG WITH IT," THE COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY URBAN SPECIALIST SIAD, "IF IT LOOKS AS IF SOMEONE IS TAKING A LAYOFF WHILE SOMEONE ELSE HAS TO TAKE A TAX INCREASE, OR IF THE CITY IMPOSES A WAGE FREEZE BUT EXEMPTS INCOMES UNDER \$9,000 A YEAR."

PROF. SHALALA WAS ASKED WHETHER, IN CASE THE UNIONS DID NOT GO ALONG, THE MAC HAD ANY ALTERNATE PLANS. "OH, YOU BETTER ASK THE PENTAGON ABOUT THAT," SHE SAID. "I UNDERSTAND THAT THEY HAVE A SPECIAL BACKUP UNIT ASSIGNED TO EVERY CITY FOR EMERGENCIES."

#### CHICAGO PRESS SLANDERS USLP

JULY 18 (IPS) -- YESTERDAY'S EDITION OF THE CHICAGO DAILY CALUMET NEWSPAPER, WITH A READERSHIP IN THE MAIN COMPRISED OF STEELWORKERS, FEATURED TWO ARTICLES SLANDERING THE U.S. LABOR PARTY. THE OUTSTANDING FEATURE OF THE LIBELS -- TIMED TO PRECEED USLP PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE LYNDON LAROCHE'S MIDWEST TOUR -- WAS THE ALLEGATION THAT THE LABOR PARTY STAGED A RIOT AT A STEELWORKERS UNION HALL LAST MONDAY, WIDELY KNOWN TO HAVE BEEN PROVOKED BY THE FBI'S MAOIST "REVOLUTIONARY UNION."

#### NEW JERSEY POLICE "ADVERTISE" FOR THE USLP

TRENTON, NEW JERSEY, JULY 18 (IPS) -- YESTERDAY, DURING A U.S. LABOR PARTY NEIGHBORHOOD WALKING TOUR LED BY ELIOT GREENSPAN, USLP CANDIDATE FOR NEW JERSEY STATE REPRESENTATIVE, POLICE SOUND CARS CIRCULATED THROUGH THE WORKING-CLASS AREA TELLING RESIDENTS NOT TO GO NEAR THE LABOR PARTY AND NOT TO BUY NEW SOLIDARITY BECAUSE "THESE PEOPLE ARE COMMUNISTS."
