INTERNATIONAL PRESS ROUND-UP

IPS SPECIAL REPORT

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY DAILY PRAVDA YESTERDAY, IN FULL COGNIZANCE OF DEVELOPMENTS IN PORTUGAL AND ITALY, REVIVED LENIN'S ARGUMENT FOR A WORKING-CLASS VANGUARD PARTY WHICH CAN LEAD THE SEIZURE OF STATE POWER. THE LENGTHY FEATURE ON "LENINIST STRATEGY AND TACTICS" IS BY KONSTANTIN ZARODOV, A CANDIDATE MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE, AND EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNIST JOURNAL PROBLEMS OF PEACE AND SOCIALISM. IT APPEARED IN TIME TO GREET THE ARRIVAL IN MOSCOW OF GIAN-CARLO PAJETTA, AN ANTI-COMMUNIST AGENT IN THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY POLITBURO.

ZARODOV WRITES THAT IN THE SUMMER OF 1905, THE BOLSHEVIKS WERE WORKING TO "RESIST THE POSTURE OF THE CONCILIATORS WHICH WOULD HAVE MEANT RUIN FOR THE REVOLUTION." THIS POLEMIC OF SEVENTY YEARS AGO, SAID ZARODOV, "READS TODAY AS IF IT WERE A QUESTION OF EVENTS UNFOLDING BEFORE OUR VERY EYES. THE BOOK TALKS ABOUT RUSSIA, BUT THE SCALE OF THE LENINIST CONCLUSIONS IS UNIVERSAL."

ZARODOV RECALLS LENIN'S DEMOLITION OF THE MENSHEVIK "THEORY OF STAGES" -- WHICH WAS CONSEQUENTLY TO PLAGUE THE COMMUNIST MOVEMENT ITSELF FOR DECADES UNDER THE POPULAR FRONT POLICY --AND DENOUNCES IT IN TERMS PARTICULARLY APPROPRIATE TO THE PCI: "THE REVOLUTIONARY QUALITY OF THAT DICTATORSHIP LIES IN THE FACT THAT IT SUPPRESSES BY FORCE THE RESISTANCE OF THE REACTION AND ENSURES THE REALIZATION OF THE DEMOCRATIC DEMANDS OF THE PEOPLE... (IN THAT IT) REFLECTS THE WILL AND THE INTERESTS OF THE WORKING MAJORITY OF THE PEOPLE...THAT LENINIST THOUGHT...TOTALLY DEBUNKS THE OPPORTUNIST CONCEPTIONS THAT ARE STILL FASHIONABLE AND WHICH WOULD HAVE US BELIEVE THAT...THE SEIZURE OF...POWER IS ONLY SOME SORT OF FINAL ACT, THE RESULT OF SOME SORT OF NATIONAL REFEREN-DUM...."

EXPLAINING REVOLUTIONARY DEMOCRACY IN PRECISELY THE TERMS EXPRESSED BY PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER ALVARO CUNHAL, ZARODOV WROTE "FOR LENIN...THE POPULAR MAJORITY WAS NOT AN ARITHMETIC CONCEPT BUT A POLITICAL ONE...WHICH IS FORMED NOT ONLY AS THE RESULT OF THE CREATION OF REPRESENTATIVE, ELECTORAL ORGANS OF POWER, BUT IN THE COURSE OF THE IMMEDIATELY REVOLUTIONARY ACTIONS OF THE POPULAR MASSES, THEIR INDEPENDENT POLITICAL ACTIVITY, WHICH TRANSCEND THE PROSAIC NORMS OF 'PEACEFUL' ACTIVITY THAT WOULD AGREE WITH THE ROUTINES OF BOURGEOIS LIFE."

RETURNING EXPLICITLY TO THE SITUATION IN 1975, ZARODOV FINISHED: "MODERN-DAY COMPROMISERS SHOW NO REGARD FOR THE INDEPENDENCE OF HE PROLETARIAN PARTY EVEN IN WORDS. THEY WOULD LIKE TO DISSOLVE IT INTO AN IDEOLOGICALLY AMORPHOUS ORGANIZATION, INTO ANY ALLIANCE AT ALL CREATED ON THE BASIS OF THE FORMULA 'UNITY FOR UNITY'S SAKE.' BUT THEIR LOGIC IS THE SAME: IT'S MENSHEVIST....THIS IS THE SOURCE OF CALLS FOR THE COMMUNISTS TO BE 'MODERATE,' THAT IS, TRANSLATED INTO CLEAR POLITICAL LANGUAGE: TO BE DRAGGED ALONG ON THE TAIL OF THE MOVEMENT RATHER THAN MARCHING AT ITS HEAD."

PCP CALLS FOR DEFEAT OF FASCIST REACTION

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) PUBLISHED A DECLARATION LAST NIGHT CALLING FOR "UNITY AND ACTION" TO DEFEAT THE PRESENT WAVE OF "UNLEASHED FASCIST VIOLENCE." THE STRONGLY-WORDED COMMUNIQUE, PUBLISHED IN TODAY'S FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY DAILY L'HUMANITE, STATED: "A SHORT WHILE AGO, REACTION WORE A POPULAR, DEMOCRATIC, SOCIALIST MASK. TODAY IT ADVANCES WITH ITS FACE UNCOVERED....THE PEOPLE HAVE THE RIGHT TO EXPECT, TO DEMAND FROM THE ARMED AND SECURITY FORCES THAT THEY ACT WITH RESOLUTION TO REPRESS, IN CERTAIN CASES TO SMASH, COUNTER-REVOLUTION AND GUARANTEE PUBLIC FREEDOM. IF THEY ACT THUSLY, THE ARMED FORCES WILL HAVE THE PEOPLE WITH THEM, INCLUDING THOSE WHO TODAY ARE INTIMIDATED BY FASCIST VIOLENCE." THE COMMUNIQUE CONCLUDED WITH A CALL TO ALL, INCLUDING SOCIALISTS AND CATHOLICS, TO JOIN WITH THE PCP IN PUTTING DOWN THE WAVE OF TERRORIST VIOLENCE, AND FOR THE FORMATION OF "DEFENSE AND VIGILANCE COMMITTEES" THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

PCP'ERS REPULSE RIGHT-WING MOB IN NORTH

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) MILITANTS, DEFENDING THEIR LOCAL OFFICES IN THE NORTHERN TOWN OF FAFE, TODAY FIRED INTO A RIGHT-WING CROWD THAT WAS DEMONSTRATING OUTSIDE. ONE PERSON WAS KILLED AND FIVE OTHERS WERE WOUNDED.

"LEFTIST MARINES," RECENTLY ARRIVED FROM THE SOUTH, WERE SUBSEQUENTLY SENT TO FAFE TO HELP PROTECT THE PCP OFFICE, REPORTS UPI. SEVERAL WEEKS AGO, THE PCP OFFICE IN FAFE WAS THE TARGET OF A TERRORIST BOMB ATTACK.

L'HUMANITE ATTACKS CARVALHO

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--PORTUGUESE GENERAL CARVALHO'S DECISION TO REAPPOINT COL. COSTA NEVES AS COMMANDER OF THE COPCON (PORTUGUESE SECURITY POLICE) AMADORA REGIMENT "DOES NOT SEEM TO BE OF THE NATURE TO RE-ESTABLISH THE COHESION IN THE RANKS OF CERTAIN MILITARY UNITS, NOR TO DEFUSE THE ANTI-COMMUNIST CAMPAIGN," TODAY'S FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY DAILY L'HUMANITE STATED. L'HUMANITE SAID THAT CARVALHO'S MOTIVES ARE NOW BEING QUESTIONED IN LISBON. NEVES WAS REMOVED FROM HIS POST LAST WEEK BY MEMBERS OF HIS OWN UNIT.

CHURCH PROVOKING ATTACKS ON PCP SAYS NY TIMES

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE PORTUGUESE CATHOLIC CHURCH IS AGITATING ITS MEMBERS TO ASSAULT THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY'S (PCP) OFFICES AND MEMBERS ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. THE PRIEST RESIDING OVER THE FUNERAL OF ONE OF THE ANTI-COMMUNIST ATTACKERS KILLED LAST WEEKEND "EXORTED THE CROWD TO GO TO THE NEARBY CITY OF BARGA" FOR A DEMONSTRATION, NOTES THE TIMES.

SOVIETS PUBLICIZE WESTERN SUPPORT FOR EAST-WEST TRADE

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE SOVIET NEWSPAPER PRAVDA YESTERDAY RAN A SERIES OF INTERVIEWS WITH WEST GERMAN POLITICIANS AND INDUSTRIALISTS WHO SUPPORT THE INCREASE OF EAST-WEST TRADE. AMONG THOSE CITED WAS FINANCE MINISTER LAUSEN OF SCHLESWIG-HOLSTEIN, BASE OF THE PRO-TRADE STOLTENBERG FACTION OF WEST GERMAN INDUSTRIALISTS.

PRAVDA COMMENTS, "SOVIET CONTRACTS CANNOT, OF COURSE, FREE CAPITALIST SOCIETY FROM ITS CONGENITAL AILMENTS, BUT THESE CONTRACTS DO RELIEVE THE FATE OF MANY WORKING PEOPLE."

ZAIRE-BACKED FNLA OFFENSIVE PUSHES COLONISTS OUT OF ANGOLA

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--ESCALATING AGGRESSION BY THE ZAIRE-BACKED NATIONAL FRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF ANGOLA (FNLA) IS DRIVING THE PORTUGUESE SETTLERS OUT OF ANGOLA ACCORDING TO A SOVIET NEWS AGENCY (TASS) RELEASE QUOTED EXTENSIVELY IN TODAY'S WEST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY DAILY UNSERE ZEIT.

OFFICIALS OF THE PRO-SOVIET POPULAR MOVEMENT FOR THE LIBERATION OF ANGOLA (MPLA) TODAY CONFIRMED THAT CAPTURED FNLA TROOPS SPEAK ONLY FRENCH AND ZAIREAN DIALECTS. VIRTUALLY ALL ANGOLANS SPEAK SOME PORTUGUESE.

ANGOLAN REFUGEES TO BE USED AS COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY STRIKE FORCE IN PORTUGAL

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE REPATRIATION OF ANGOLAN REFUGEES HAS BEEN SEIZED UPON BY SECOND INTERNATIONAL LEADERS IN FRANCE AND OTHER COUNTRIES AS A MENS FOR A FASCIST STRIKE FORCE IN PORTUGAL TO CARRY OUT COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ATTACKS AGAINST THE PORTUGUESE OMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) IN AN EFFORT TO DESTABILIZE THE CURRENT PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT.

"FRENCH PRESIDENT VALERY GISCARD D'ESTAING SAID THAT FRANCE WAS READY TO HELP PORTUGAL EVACUATE SOME 250,000 TO 300,000 PERSONS FROM THE TERRITORY...(OF ANGOLA)," REPORTS TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST.

THE TWO THOUSAND ANGOLAN PORTUGUESE WHO HELD A MEETING IN LISBON'S SPORTS STADIUM WERE DESCRIBED AS "CLEARLY EXTREME RIGHT-WINGERS," BY TODAY'S NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, THE PAPER OF THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

THE ATTACKERS WHO DESTROYED PCP HEADQUARTERS IN FAMALICAO HOISTED UP A HAND PAINTED SIGN ON THE RAVAGED BUILDING WHICH SAID "HOUSE OF ANGOLAN REFUGEES" ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

TOMORROW IN LISBON, RETURNED RIGHT-WING PORTUGUESE COLONISTS FROM ANGOLA WILL HOLD A MARCH ON THE PRESIDENTIAL PALACE, REPORTS TODAY'S UNITA, NEWSPAPER OF THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

UNITA IN UNITED FRONT WITH FNLA

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE NATIONAL UNION FOR THE TOTAL INDEPENDENCE OF ANGOLA (UNITA), THE SO-CALLED THIRD PARTY IN ANGOLA, HAD OPENLY ENTERED INTO THE CURRENT FIGHTING IN SUPPORT OF THE CIA-CONTROLLED NATIONAL FRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF ANGOLA (FNLA). UNITA IS PRESENTLY ENGAGED IN HEAVY ATTACKS ON THE CITY OF LOBITO NOW HELD BY THE PRO-SOCIALIST POPULAR FRONT (MPLA) ACCORDING TO THE GERMAN DISPATCH SERVICE (DBP) AND OTHER GERMAN PRESS SOURCES.

JONAS SAVIMBI, HEAD OF UNITA, DEMANDED A FULL MOBILIZATION OF HIS 8,800 SOLDIERS AND HAS BEGUN TRAINING FOR AN ADDITIONAL 15,000-0,000, REPORTS DBP.

SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT EXPOSES CIA

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--AFTER IDENTIFYING TWELVE SUSPECTED CIA AGENTS POSING AS OFFICIAL AMERICAN VISITORS, THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT AS CONCLUDED THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT IS ISSUING PASSPORTS WHICH IDENTIFY AGENTS AS TECHNICIANS, ADMINISTRATIVE EXPERTS, ACCOUNTANTS AND OTHER OFFICIALS IN ORDER TO GET ITS OPERATIVES INTO THE COUNTRY. ACCORDING TO THE JOHANNESBURG STAR, THE INVESTIGATION BEGAN AFTER MR. ROBERT JASTER WAS IDENTIFIED AS AN AGENT POSING AS A DIPLOMAT USING A PASSPORT ISSUED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

FDP CHAIRMAN BLASTS REVANCHISTS

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--WOLFGANG MISCHNIK, CHAIRMAN OF THE WEST GERMAN FREE DEMOCRATIC PARTY, TODAY CHARGED THAT CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC PARTY SPOKESMEN'S ATTACKS ON THE RECENTLY CONCLUDED CREDIT AGREE-MENTS BETWEEN POLAND AND WEST GERMANY "WOULD PLEASE THOSE WHO HAVE NEVER REALIZED THAT THE SECOND WORLD WAR CAN NO LONGER BE WON."

MISCHNIK STATED THAT "THE AGREEMENT IS TO BE WELCOMED...AND NATURALLY IS VERY CLOSELY DEPENDENT UPON THE RESULTS OF THE SECURITY CONFERENCE IN HELSINKI," ACCORDING TO THE FRANKFURTER RUNDSCHAU TODAY.

WEST GERMAN FREE DEMOCRATIC YOUTH ATTACK LEBER AND SCHLESINGER

UGUST 7 (IPS) — MICHAEL KLEFF, SPOKESMAN FOR THE WEST GERMAN FREE DEMOCRATIC PARTY (FDP) YOUTH ORGANIZATION, YOUNG DEMOCRATS, ISSUED A PRESS RELEASE TODAY DENOUNCING U.S. SECRETARY OF DEFENSE SCHLESINGER AND WEST GERMAN DEFENSE MINISTER LEBER FOR THEIR "FLEXIBLE RESPONSE" NUCLEAR WAR DOCTRINE. KLEFF'S RELEASE CALLS THE OLICY "DISASTROUS," AND PERSONALLY ATTACKS LEBER AS "MACABRE AND RRESPONSIBLE."

W. GERMAN GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCES TRANSIT DEAL WITH DDR

UGUST 7 (IPS)—THE WEST GERMAN GOVERNMENT EXPECTS AN EXPANSION F ECONOMIC RELATIONS WITH THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC IN THE NEAR FUTURE, GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN KLAUS BOELLING ANNOUNCED TODAY. ACCORDING TO DEUTSCHLANDFUNK RADIO NEWS, BOELLING SAID THAT THE EXPANSION OF TRANSPORT ROUTES BETWEEN WEST GERMANY AND BERLIN WAS BEING UNDERTAKEN.

BOMB SHELTERS PROPOSED AS SOLUTION TO UNEMPLOYMENT IN WEST GERMANY

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--REGIONAL NEWSPAPERS IN THE INDUSTRIAL RUHR REGION OF WEST GERMANY TODAY PROPOSED THAT UNEMPLOYED WORKERS BE HIRED TO BUILD BOMB SHELTERS. EXPRESS CARRIED THE HEADLINE "SELF-DE-FENSE AGAINST ATOMIC DEATH," AND THE NEUE RUHR ZEITUNG WROTE THAT "IN CASE OF WAR THERE IS TOO LITTLE DEFENSE -- ONLY ENOUGH ROOM FOR 2 TO 3PER CENT OF THE POPULATION."

FIGHTING CONTINUES IN SOUTH LEBANON

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--PALESTINIAN GUERRILLAS FIRED ROCKETS INTO A NORTH ISRAEL BORDER TOWN YESTERDAY. THE ATTACK WAS COUNTERED BY AN ISRAELI BOMBING RETALIATION INTO SOUTHERN LEBANON. OFFICIAL REPORTS INDICATE THAT THE RECENT 3-DAY ROUND OF FIGHTING HAS CLAIMED 18 LIVES. THE CHRISTIAN SCIENCE MONITOR FURTHER REPORTS THAT THE LEBANESE INFORMATION MINISTER HAS ANNOUNCED A \$13 MIL-LION ARAB GRANT TO SOUTH LEBANESE PALESTINIANS TO COUNTER AN IS-RAELI PLAN TO "DRIVE PEOPLE OUT OF THE BORDER AREA."

NY TIMES SLANDERS IRAQ

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--ROVING CIA-CONNECTED REPORTER JUAN DE ONIS AS-SERTS THAT "IRAQ IS...PRODUCING A NEW CLASS OF RICH BUREAUCRATS AND PROPERTY OWNERS IN A SOCIETY THAT IS SUPPOSED TO BE DEDICATED TO REVOLUTIONARY SOCIALISM," IN YESTERDAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. ONIS REPORTS THAT THE WESTERN BUSINESSMEN FLOCKING TO IRAQ TO BID ON DEVELOPMENT CONTRACTS "ARE DISCOVERING THAT THE BOURGEOIS SPIRIT OF PRIVATE GAIN AND COMFORT IS VERY MUCH ALIVE" IN IRAQ.

CONTINENTAL PRESS REPORT

HOUSE AID BILL INCLUDES DEBT CANCELLATION PROVISION

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE HOUSE INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE YES-TERDAY APPROVED A \$1.35 BILLION FOREIGN ECONOMIC AND FOOD ASSIS-TANCE BILL THAT ALLOWS THE AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT TO FORGIVE LOAN REPAYMENTS FROM COUNTRIES THAT PLOW THEIR PRO-CEEDS FROM IMPORTED GRAIN SALES INTO "AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT." THE BILL ALSO EARMARKS FOR AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS ALL LOAN MONEY REPAID.

THE HOUSE AUTHORS OF THE REDRAFTED ADMINISTRATION BILL ARE, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES, CLEMENT ZABLOCKI (D-WIS), DONALD FRASER (D-MINN) AND CHARLES WHALEN (R-OHIO).

CIA'S COLBY ADMITS NSA DOMESTIC PHONE TAPS

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE, WILLIAM COLBY, TESTIFIED YESTERDAY BEFORE THE HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE THAT THE NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY (NSA) HAD MONI-TORED DOMESTIC TELEPHONE CONVERSATIONS. ACCORDING TO SEVERAL PRESS ACCOUNTS, COLBY DENIED THAT THE PRACTICE WAS ILLEGAL.

REP. LES ASPIN (D-WIS) TERMED THE PRACTICE A "VERY, VERY CLEAR" VIOLATION OF THE FIRST AND FOURTH AMENDMENTS.

COLBY FINGERS KISSINGER ON CIA INTERVENTION IN CHILE

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--UNDER QUESTIONING BEFORE THE HOUSE SELECT COMMIT-TEE ON INTELLIGENCE YESTERDAY, CIA DIRECTOR COLBY ADMITTED AND DEFENDED ILLICIT CIA INTERVENTION AGAINST THE FORMER CHILEAN GOV-ERNMENT OF SALVADOR ALLENDE, SAYING THE OPERATIONS WERE APPROVED BY NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL 40 COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN HENRY KISSIN-GER. COLBY'S REMARKS WERE REPORTED IN TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST.

FORD ASKS CONGRESS FOR \$20 MILLION MORE FOR CREEP

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--PRESIDENT FORD ASKED CONGRESS TODAY FOR AN ADDI-TIONAL \$20.4 MILLION FOR THE TREASURY DEPARTMENT'S BUREAU OF AL-COHOL, TOBACCO AND FIREARMS, THE NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS TODAY. FORD'S STATED AIM IS TO DOUBLE THIS CREEP DEPARTMENT'S OPERATIONS IN THE TEN LARGEST U.S. CITIES.

KRAFT URGES U.S. DROP DETENTE

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--NOTING WHAT HE CALLS A "SUDDEN RISE IN ANTI-COMMUNIST FEELINGS" IN THE UNITED STATES, SYNDICATED COLUMNIST JOSEPH KRAFT WRITES TODAY THAT "THE DETENTE STRATEGY MAY RUN ITS COURSE." KRAFT URGES THE U.S. TO LOOK FOR "AN ALTERNATIVE TO DE-TENTE DIPLOMACY" IN THE AFTERMATH OF THE CSCE, AND SEEK TO STRENGTHEN TIES WITH MAO'S CHINA.

NEW YORK TIMES SAYS PAID LABOR IS "MISCHIEVOUS NOTION"

AUGUST 7 (IPS) -- THE NEW YORK TIMES EDITORIAL STAFF TODAY URGES REVIVING "AN OLD AND HONORABLE AMERICAN TRADITION OF SELF-HELP" IN ORDER TO OFFSET THE DRASTIC STAFF AND SERVICE CUTBACKS IMPOSED ON NEW YORK CITY BY THE BANKS.

QUOTING PROFESOR RICHARD NETZER OF NEW YORK UNIVERSITY, "THE NOTION THAT PAID LABOR SHOULD, AS A GENERAL RULE, SUBSTITUTE FOR VOLUNTEER EFFORTS SURELY IS ONE OF THE MORE MISCHIEVOUS PRODUCTS OF THE 1960'S," THE TIMES EDITORIALLY ENDORSES THE PROPOSALS OF THE STATE CHARTER REVISION COMMISSION WHICH WOULD SET CITY INHAB-ITANTS TO WORK ON A "VOLUNTEER" BASIS TO REPLACE LAID-OFF CITY WORKERS.

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--FEDERAL DISTRICT COURT JUDGE THOMAS GRIESA OVER-TURNED AS UNCONSTITUTIONAL A NEW YORK TRANSIT AUTHORITY POLICY PREVENTING EMPLOYMENT OF METHADONE USERS, ACCORDING TO THE NEW YORK TIMES TODAY. THE RULING CONCLUDED THAT "A PERSON MAIN-TAINED ON A CONSTANT DOSE OF METHADONE CAN PERFORM NORMALLY BY EVERY STANDARD THAT RELATES TO EMPLOYABILITY."

BEAME CONSIDERS SANIT REHIRES

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--MAYOR BEAME IS REPORTEDLY CONSIDERING REHIRING UP TO 165 LAID-OFF SANITATIONMEN TO REPLACE 195 MEN WHO RETIRED IN JULY, ACCORDING TO THE NEW YORK TIMES. AT A MEETING YESTERDAY WITH THE MAYOR, SANITATION UNION HEAD JOHN DELURY CHARGED THAT THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT WAS IN A STATE OF CHAOS DUE TO REDUCED MANPOWER.

NY TIMES ATTACKS SANITMEN

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE NEW YORK TIMES ATTRIBUTED THE CITY'S "GARBAGE MESS" TO "MUNICIPAL MISMANAGEMENT AND UNION GREED" IN AN EDITORI-AL TODAY, CHARGING THE UNIFORMED SANITATIONMEN'S ASSOCIATION WITH MAINTAINING "SOME OF THE MOST WASTEFUL WORK RULES EXTANT," AND FURTHER CLAIMING THAT SANITMEN IN RECENT WEEKS HAVE WORKED "SUB-STANTIALLY BELOW EVEN THEIR OWN USUAL LOW LEVEL OF PRODUCTIVITY."

ARGENTINA BANS BASIC IMPORTS UNTIL YEAR'S END

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--ARGENTINA'S NEW MINISTER OF ECONOMICS PEDRO BON-NANI APPROVED A NEW IMPORTS REGIMEN THIS WEEK WHICH PUTS A BAN ON A WIDE RANGE OF IMPORTS UNTIL THE END OF THIS YEAR. FIGURING PROMINENTLY AMONG THE RESTRICTIONS LISTED ARE TRACTORS.

BUNDESBANK DUMPS U.S. TREASURY NOTES, FORCES U.S. HYPERINFLATION

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--THE REPORTED SALE OF AN ASTONISHING \$1.5 BILLION WORTH OF NON-MARKETABLE U.S. TREASURY SECURITIES REPORTED IN TO-DAY'S NEW YORK TIMES HAS BEEN TRACED BY IPS TO HAVE BEEN ORIGI-NATED BY THE BUNDESBANK, THE WEST GERMAN CENTRAL BANK.

ALTHOUGH IT IS NOT YET CLEAR WHETHER THE BUNDESBANK SOLD THE SECURITIES IN AN ECONOMIC WARFARE MOVE TO FORCE THE U.S. FEDERAL RESERVE BANK TO REFLATE IN THE U.S., OR IF THE SALE WAS A JOINT

U.S. TREASURY-BUNDESBANK MANEUVER TO BYPASS FEDERAL RESERVE CHAIRMAN ARTHUR BURNS, WHO IS COMMITTED TO A TIGHT MONETARY POL-ICY, IT IS CLEAR THAT THIS MOVE FORCED THE U.S. TREASURY TO AN-NOUNCE AN ADDITIONAL \$6 BILLION TREASURY SECURITY SALE TO COMPEN-SATE FOR ITS PURCHASES OF SECURITIES HELD BY THE BUNDESBANK. THE NET EFFECT OF THE BUNDESBANK SALE WOULD BE TO FUEL A HYPERINFLA-TIONARY CREDIT EXPLOSION IN THE U.S.

HENRY JACKSON PUSHES NATIONAL BIG MAC

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--HENRY (SCOOP TSE DUNG) JACKSON IS PRESENTLY DRAFTING A BILL THAT WOULD CREATE "STATE-LOCAL ASSISTANCE AGEN-CIES" UNDER A NEW FEDERAL AGENCY. THIS NATIONAL BIG MAC PROGRAM WOULD GIVE FEDERAL BACKING TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT LOANS FOR PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE. THE BILL WOULD INCLUDE SPECIFIC FISCAL STAN-DARDS FOR ALL CITIES RECEIVING LOANS, SUCH AS A BALANCED BUDGET, ACCORDING TO A JACKSON AIDE.

MADIST GANG ESCALATES AGAINST THE ELC

HANNOVER, BRD, AUGUST 7 (IPS)--LAST NIGHT OVER 30 MAOIST GOONS HERE FROM THE SO-CALLED COMMUNIST PARTY OF GERMANY, MARXIST-LEN-INIST (KPD) VIOLENTLY BROKE UP A FORUM BY THE EUROPEAN LABOR COM-MITTEES (ELC). FOLLOWING THIS SECOND MAOIST ATTACK IN THREE DAYS, THE EXECU-TIVE OF THE INTERNATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES REISSUED ITS CALL FOR THE FORMATION OF ANTI-FASCIST DEFENSE COMMITTEES IN WEST GERMANY IN A EUROPEAN-WIDE LEAFLET.

USLP BOYCOTT SETS KRESGE'S EXECUTIVES RANTING

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--YESTERDAY, MR. TENINGAS, THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OF-FICER OF NATIONAL KRESGE'S MANAGEMENT, INFORMED CALLERS: "WE WILL NEVER GIVE IN TO THE LABOR PARTY BOYCOTT. YES, WE'RE BEING HURT...." IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION REGARDING REPORTED FINANCIAL DAMAGES TO KRESGE, TENINGAS SHRIEKED, "WE HAVE NO WAY TO ESTIMATE THE EFFECT OF THE BOYCOTT, AND NEITHER DO THEY (THE USLP)!!!"

THE WELL-KNOWN INVESTMENT FIRM, MERRILL, LYNCH, STATED YESTER-DAY THAT THE USLP "NATIONAL BOYCOTT OF KRESGE'S IN A PERIOD LIKE THIS MEANS FINANCIAL DEATH."

REMORALIZED UNION BUREAUCRATS ARE BEGINNING TO TALK OF ORGAN-IZING DRIVES AGAINST OTHER SCAB STORE CHAINS, USING THE THREAT OF THE K-MART STRIKE AS A "BARGAINING CHIP."

SCOOP EJECTS IPS FROM BUFFALO CONFERENCE

AUGUST 7 (IPS)--DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE SCOOP JACKSON, KEEPING PLANS FOR A BUFFALO PRESS CONFERENCE UNDER WRAPS UNTIL THE LAST MOMENT, YESTERDAY ABANDONED HIS PAST POLICY OF FLACCID DEFENSELESSNESS BEFORE THE U.S. LABOR PARTY'S EXPOSURE OF HIS IN-SANE SUPPORT FOR LIMITED NUCLEAR WARFARE.
