I. INTERNATIONAL

MOROCCAN ARMY IN REPLAY OF BARBARY COAST INTRIGUES--AGAINST ALGERIA

OCT. 6 (IPS) — "VIRTUALLY THE ENTIRE MOROCCAN ARMY, WITH ITS FRENCH AND AMERICAN TANKS AND ARTILLERY, IS DEPLOYED ALONG THE BORDER FACING THE SPANISH SAHARA--AND ALGERIA," YESTERDAY'S NEW YORK TIMES REPORTED.

THE TIMES SAYS THAT "THE SOVIET-EQUIPPED ALGERIAN ARMY" IS ALSO ON MOBILIZATION AND THAT THE OPPOSING FORCES ARE "READY FOR CONFRONTATION."

THE "DISPUTE" HAS BEEN FANNED BY MOROCCO'S U.S.-ALIGNED KING HASSAN, WHO RECENTLY BEGAN A CAMPAIGN AGAINST ALLEGED ALGERIAN "EXPANSION" WHILE HIMSELF THREATENING TO RE-OPEN A LONG-DORMANT DISPUTE OVER THE CITY OF TINDORF ON THE MOROCCAN-ALGERIAN BORDER. HASSAN HAS ALSO LAID CLAIM TO PHOSPHATE DEPOSITS AND TERRITORY OF THE SPANISH SAHARA.

"FORTRESS ISRAEL" IN CRISIS, LONDON SUNDAY TIMES REPORTS

OCT. 6 (IPS) — DISCUSSING THE GROWING "MALAISE OF INFLATION-RACKED ISRAEL," YESTERDAY'S SUNDAY TIMES OF LONDON REPORTS THAT AN INCREASING NUMBER OF ISRAELIS ARE EITHER EMIGRATING FROM ISRAEL OR EXPRESSING DISCONTENT ABOUT THE ECONOMIC CRISIS AND THE LACK OF LEADERSHIP CONFRONTING THE COUNTRY'S "DOUBTFUL FUTURE."

TIMES REPORTER ERIC MARSDEN QUOTES LETTERS FROM ISRAELIS TO LOCAL NEWSPAPERS ATTACKING THE FAILURE OF ZIONISM TO ACHIEVE ANY SECURITY IN THE REAL SENSE FOR THE JEWISH POPULATION. ONE LETTER PUBLICLY ATTACKED ZIONISM'S LEADERS FOR CREATING "AN ISLAND IN WHICH THEY HOPED TO ISOLATE THEMSELVES COMPLETELY FROM THE OCEAN OF HUMAN BEINGS AROUND THEM."

MARSDEN CONCLUDES THAT "ISRAEL'S LEADERS ARE TOO BUSY REBUILDING FORTRESS ISRAEL TO PAY ANY HEED" TO THIS PROBLEM.

NEW GOVERNMENTAL CRISIS IN LEBANON EMERGING

OCT. 6 (IPS) — LEBANESE PRESIDENT SULEIMAN FRANJIEH IS COMING UNDER HEAVY PRESSURE TO RESIGN, BOTH FROM LEBANESE LEFTIST KAMAL

JUMBLATT AND FROM OPPORTUNISTIC FEUDAL POWER-BROKERS RAYMOND EDDE AND SAEB SALEM, THE OCT. 3 SUDDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG REPORTS. THE PAPER EMPHASIZES THAT THIS IS ADDING A "PRESIDENTIAL CRISIS" TO THE ALREADY EXISTING "LEBANESE STATE CRISIS."

WEST GERMANY'S FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG FURTHER NOTES THAT SALEM AND EDDE ARE THREATENING TO RESIGN FROM THE SO-CALLED "COMMITTEE OF NATIONAL DIALOGUE," FORMED LAST WEEK AS A PATCH-WORK MEASURE TO STEM THE TIDE OF LEBANON'S RAPIDLY BURGEONING CIA-PROVOKED CRISIS.

150,000 YOUTH GATHER IN PARIS
TO FIGHT UNEMPLOYMENT

OCT. 6 (IPS) -- 150,000 FRENCH YOUTH RESPONDED TO A CALL ISSUED BY THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) TO DEMONSTRATE IN PARIS ON SATURDAY. THE DEMONSTRATORS, WHO WERE PROTESTING HIGH UNEMPLOYMENT DEMANDED A PROGRAM OF EXPANDED JOBS AND EDUCATION.

TODAY'S HUMANITE, NEWSPAPER OF THE PCF, EMPHASIZES THAT THE YOUTH WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE DEMONSTRATION DID NOT RESORT TO ANARCHIST RIOTING OF THE SORT STAGED BY ULTRALEFT "GAUCHISTE" ELEMENTS DURING DEMONSTRATIONS AGAINST THE FRANCO GOVERNMENT LAST WEEK.

ECEVIT CALLS FOR CLOSER TURKISH
RELATIONS WITH THE SOVIET UNION

OCT. 6 (IPS) -- THE GREEK GOVERNMENT'S NEWSPAPER, KATHIMERINI, REPORTS THAT IN A RECENT INTERVIEW TURKEY'S OPPOSITION LEADER, SOCIAL DEMOCRAT BULENT, ECEVIT EXPRESSED RESERVATIONS REGARDING THE ALLIANCE BETWEEN TURKEY AND THE USA, AND URGED CLOSER RELATIONS BETWEEN TURKEY AND THE SOVIET UNION WITHIN THE CONTEXT OF A "NEW BALANCED FOREIGN POLICY OF TURKEY," WHICH WOULD ENSURE THE "NATIONAL SECURITY AND WOULD BRING TURKEY CLOSER TO THE NON-ALIGNED WORLD."

TURKEY SHOULD LEAVE NATO, ECEVIT SAYS, AND "DEVELOP A NEW CONCEPTION OF NATIONAL SECURITY" WHICH WOULD ALLOW HER TO MINIMIZE HER MILITARY EXPENDITURES.

BRITISH COLUMNIST WARNS AGAINST CONFRONTATION
WITH SOVIETS: COUNSELS "KENNAN LINE"

OCT. 6 (IPS) -- IN A WARNING AGAINST RECENTLY-REVIVED NATO PLANS TO STAGE A "LIMITED" NUCLEAR CONFRONTATION WITH THE SOVIET UNION, LONDON TIMES COLUMNIST RICHARD DAVY COUNSELED OCT 2: "IF WE HAND THEM PORTUGAL ON A PLATE THEY WILL BE TEMPTED TO TAKE IT. TO ME THEIR EFFORTS THERE ARE EVIDENCE OF ADVENTUROUS OPPORTUNISM, NOT A MASTERPLAN. THERE ARE AREAS WHERE OUR INTERESTS OVERLAP, IN AVOIDING WAR, IN SPENDING LESS ON ARMS, ...IN TRADING WITH EACH OTHER...THE SOVIET RESPONSES ARE MIXED AND VARIABLE AND THERE IS A POSSIBILITY THAT THEIR INTENTIONS CAN BE MODIFIED OVER THE YEARS."

DAVY CITED NO EVIDENCE FOR HIS PREDICTION, WHICH IS KNOWN AS "CONVERGENCE THEORY" OR THE "KENNAN LINE" IN THE UNITED STATES.

MILITARY AND CIVILIANS JOIN TO PROTEST POLITICAL PURGES IN PORTUGAL

OCT. 6 (IPS) — CIVILIANS AND MILITARY JOINED TOGETHER THROUGHOUT PORTUGAL ON OCT. 3 TO VOICE SOLIDARITY WITH THE NEWLY FORMED COMMUNIST SUPPORTED UNITED SOLDIERS WILL WIN MOVEMENT (SUV). IN BEJA, SOUTHERN PORTUGAL, AND IN THE NORTHERN CITY OF OPORTO, WORKERS AND SOLDIERS DEMONSTRATED TO PROTEST THE "TRANSFERRING" OF SOLDIERS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE SUV. THE DEMONSTRATORS CONSIDER THESE TRANSFERS TO BE POLITICAL PURGES, AND SHOUTED "REACTIONARIES OUT OF THE BARRACKS."

IN OPORTO, THE PARTICIPANTS DEMANDED THE REINSTATEMENT OF COMMUNIST BACKED GENERAL EURICO CORVACHO. IN COIMBRA, IN CENTRAL PORTUGAL, THE SUV ANNOUNCED THAT IT WOULD HOLD A MARCH NEXT WEEK. AND PRO-SUV SOLDIERS AT THE MONSATO AIRBASE NEAR LISBON VOTED TO "CENSURE THE FORMATION OF THE NEW MILITARY SECURITY FORCE, (AMI) WHICH SUV FEELS IS REPRESSIVE," ACCORDING TO TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN.

II. CONTINENTAL

CABALISTS CAVORT IN CHINA

OCT. 6 (IPS) — A DELEGATION OF LEADING ROCKEFELLER CABALISTS LEFT OCT. 3 FOR AN 18-DAY VISIT TO CHINA WHERE THEY PLAN TO MEET WITH MAOIST OFFICIALS IN PEKING, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. THE GROUP IS LED BY ARTHUR ROSEN, PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL COMMITTEE ON UNITED STATES-CHINA RELATIONS, AND CYRUS VANCE, CHAIRMAN OF THE ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION AND VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL ON FOREIGN RELATIONS (CFR). THE TRIP WAS MADE AT THE INVITATION OF THE CHINESE.

CHURCH ADMITS ASSASSINATION PLANS

OCT. 6 (IPS) — SENATOR FRANK CHURCH (D-ID), CHAIRMAN OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE, ADMITTED ON ABC TELEVISION'S ISSUES AND ANSWERS YESTERDAY, THAT THE CIA HAD NOT ONLY PLOTTED ASSASSINATIONS OF FOREIGN LEADERS, BUT HAD ACTUALLY ATTEMPTED TO IMPLEMENT ASSASSINATION PLANS. CHURCH SAID THAT "BOTH PLOTS AND ATTEMPTS SPAN MANY YEARS" ENCOMPASSING THE EISENHOWER, KENNEDY AND JOHNSON ADMINISTRATIONS.

REUSS ANNOUNCES QUIXOTIC ENERGY PLAN

OCT. 6 (IPS) — REP. HENRY REUSS, MILWAUKEE DEMOCRAT AND CO-SPONSOR OF THE SLAVE LABOR REUSS-HAWKINS BILL, IS PUSHING WINDMILL CONSTRUC-

TION AS AN ECONOMIC ALTERNATIVE TO PRESENT ENERGY SUPPLIES, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. A WEEK AGO REUSS BEGAN OPERATION OF A \$5,000, 80-FOOT WINDMILL ON HIS PROPERTY AND BELIEVES THE DEVICE CAN BE ADAPTED TO URBAN AREAS. A MODERN-DAY DON QUIXOTE, REUSS RECENTLY TOLD THE TIMES: "ONE WIND GENERATOR DOESN'T STEAL WIND FROM ANOTHER ANYMORE THAN ONE SAILBOAT STEALS FROM ANOTHER. AND THEY COULD BE COMBINED WITH TV AERIALS TO BE ESTHETICALLY PLEASING." REUSS HAS NOTIFIED THE ENERGY RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF HIS "TRAILBLAZING" DISCOVERY AND REPORTS THAT THEY, TOO, AGREE, "THE ANSWER, MY FRIENDS, IS BLOWING IN THE WIND."

III. ORGANIZING AND INTELLIGENCE

USTASHI LEADER BACKS NUCLEAR WAR, 2ND INTERNATIONAL

OCT. 6 (IPS9 — LEV E. DOBRIANSKI, A NATIONAL WAR COLLEGE PROFESSOR AND HEAD OF UKRANIAN CONGRESS COMMITTEE OF AMERICA ENDORSED CLAIMS BY RETIRED ADMIRAL ELMO "ZUMWALT AND OTHERS" THAT THE SOVIET UNION IS DEVELOPING A "FIRST AND SECOND" NUCLEAR STRIKE CAPABILITY TO BE READY IN 1978. DOBRIANSKI CALLED FOR IMMEDIATE ECONOMIC EMBARGO OF THE SOVIETS NOW TO HALT THEIR INITIATIVE. ALSO A CONSULTANT FOR THE UNITED STATES INFORMATION AGENCY AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT, DOBRIANSKI DELIVERED HIS REMARKS AT A CONFERENCE ON NATIONALISM IN THE SOVIET UNION AND EASTERN EUROPE SPONSORED BY THE CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY IN DETROIT.

ALTHOUGH KNOWN AS A HARD CORE "USTASHI" (EAST EUROPEAN) ANTI-COMMUNIST, DOBRIANSKI ALSO HAS PRAISE FOR THE CIA-LINKED "SOCIALIST INTERNATIONAL." "THANK GOD FOR THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATS IN EUROPE," HE SAID, "BECAUSE OF THEM THE U.S. DIDN'T HAVE TO COME IN (PORTUGAL) DIRECTLY. IF ANYONE KNOWS HOW TO DEAL WITH COMMUNISTS IT IS THE SOCIAL DEMOCRACY."
