PCI DEMANDS COMMUNIST MOVEMENT CONFORM TO NATO POLICY

OCT. 10 (IPS) -- A DELEGATION OF TOP AGENT LEADERS FROM THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY WHO ARE ATTENDING A TWO-DAY-OLD EAST BERLIN MEETING TO PREPARE DOCUMENTS FOR SUBMISSION TO THE UPCOMING MEETING OF EUROPEAN COMMUNIST PARTIES, HAS THREATENED TO SPLIT THE WORLD COMMUNIST MOVEMENT, ACCORDING TO ANALYSTS HERE. ACCORDING TO TODAY'S UNITA, THE PCI PAPER, GIAN CARLO PAJETTA, THE TOP NATO AGENT HEADING THE PCI DELEGATION, HAS REFUSED TO ACCEPT A "COMMON DOCUMENT" DRAFTED FOR SUBMISSION TO THE FORTHCOMING CONFERENCE, UNLESS IT IS AMENDED "SUCH AS TO ALLOW THE DOCUMENT TO BE ACCEPTED BY THE 27 PARTIES." THE PCI SUPPORTS THE NATO ALLIANCE AND THE IMPOSITION OF FASCISM ON THE ADVANCED SECTOR.

THE ANALYSTS BASE THEIR ASSESSMENT OF THE IMPLICATIONS OF THE PCI'S STANCE ON STATEMENTS PUBLISHED BY SEVERAL CAPITALIST PRESS SOURCES CLOSE TO THE PCI DURING THE PAST WEEK. THE STATEMENTS URGED THE PCI TO THREATEN A WALK-OUT FROM THE CONFERENCE ON THE GROUNDS THAT THE SOVIET UNION WOULD CAPITULATE TO SUCH A SPLIT THREAT FROM FEAR OF "INTERNATIONAL ISOLATION."

THE DOCUMENTS RELEASED BY THE MEETING REPRESENT A COMPROMISE POSITION BY THE PRO-SOVIET HARDLINERS VIS-A-VIS THE PCI THREAT. THE TWO RESOLUTIONS, ON CHILE AND SPAIN, FOCUS ON QUESTIONS OF "LIBERALIZATION," "ANTI-REPRESSION," AND WERE DESCRIBED BY THE ANALYSTS AS "ESSENTIALLY APOLITICAL." THE RESOLUTION ON SPAIN MAKES SIGNIFICANT CONCESSIONS TO CIA AGENT SANTIAGO CARRILLO, HEAD OF THE SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY, AND A LEADING PCI ALLY.

THE ANALYSTS CAUTIONED AGAINST A FINAL ASSESSMENT ON THE RESULTS OF THE MEETING HOWEVER, NOTING THAT THERE HAS AS YET BEEN NO COMMENT ON THE MEETING FROM SUCH HARD-LINE PARTIES AS THE FRENCH COMMUNISTS, NOR INDEED FROM THE SOVIETS THEMSELVES.

ILLINOIS DEFAULTS ON BILLS

CHICAGO, OCT. 10 (IPS) -- THE STATE OF ILLINOIS FAILED TO MEET \$17.3 MILLION IN ACCOUNTS PAYABLE YESTERDAY, INCLUDING \$1.6 MILLION IN PAYROLL CHECKS, BECAUSE THE STATE'S GENERAL FUND DID NOT HAVE THE CASH.

AS OF THIS MORNING, STATE BUDGET OFFICIALS WERE MAKING PLANS TO SPEED UP THE PROCESSING OF REVENUES AS THEY COME IN TO MINIMIZE THE DELAY IN THE DELIVERY OF THE CHECKS, BUT DEPUTY CONTROLLER ROBERT MANDEVILLE SAID THAT THE STATE WILL CONTINUE TO LIVE HAND-TO MOUTH BECAUSE SPENDING CONTINUES TO OUTSTRIP REVENUES.

MEANWHILE, MAYOR RICHARD DALEY OF CHICAGO CONTINUES TO MAINTAIN THAT GOVERNOR DANIEL WALKER DELIBERATELY EXACERBATED THE STATE'S FISCAL CRISIS. AS LATE AS TODAY, DALEY SUPPORTERS IN THE STATE LEGISLATURE WERE ATTEMPTING TO OVERRIDE WALKER'S EDUCATION BUDGET CUTS ON THE BASIS THAT THERE IS NO REAL FISCAL CRISIS.

BY PUBLICIZING THE CRISIS IN THIS FASHION, OBSERVERS FEEL THE WALKER ADMINISTRATION WILL FORCE DALEY TO EITHER FOLLOW THE ROUTE OF NEW YORK CITY MAYOR BEAME AND IMPLEMENT MASSIVE AUSTERITY, OR ENDORSE THE U.S. LABOR PARTY'S CALL FOR A DEBT MORATORIUM.

CHICAGO SUN-TIMES SLAMS GOVERNMENT
FOR "MASSIVE SUBVERSION OF CONSTITUTION"--
CALLS FOR FBI DIRECTOR KELLEY'S OUSTER

CHICAGO, OCT. 10 (IPS) -- AGENCIES OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ARE ENGAGED IN "MASSIVE LAWLESSNESS AND SUBVERSION OF THE CONSTITUTION," STATES AN EDITORIAL IN YESTERDAY'S CHICAGO SUN-TIMES. ATTACKING THE FBI FOR INCORPORATING CRIMINAL OPERATIONS INTO ITS ACTIVITIES, THE SUN-TIMES SAYS "THESE ARE THE TACTICS OF A POLICE STATE, NOT THE BUSINESS OF A DEMOCRACY," AND CALLS FOR THE IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL OF FBI DIRECTOR CLARENCE KELLEY.

KENNEDY CALLS FOR COMMISSION
TO SCRUTINIZE CIA ZOMBIE FACTORIES

OCT. 10 (IPS) -- SENATOR EDWARD KENNEDY (D-MASS) YESTERDAY INTRODUCED A BILL INTO CONGRESS TO TRANSFORM THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR THE PROTECTION OF HUMAN SUBJECTS OF BIOMEDICAL AND BEHAVIORAL RESEARCH INTO A PERMANENT BODY AND UPGRADE ITS FUNCTIONING AND IMPACT, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. THE COMMISSION IS CURRENTLY INVESTIGATING PSYCHOSURGERY AND RESEARCH INVOLVING PRISONERS AND THE MENTALLY RETARDED.

IN A STATEMENT INTRODUCING THE BILL, KENNEDY CHARGED THAT "THE REVELATIONS OF THE PAST MONTHS CONCERNING BIOMEDICAL AND BEHAVIORAL RESEARCH ABUSES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND THE CIA UNDERSCORE THE URGENT NEED TO EXPAND THE NATIONAL COMMISSION'S JURISDICTION AND TO EXPAND IT NOW."

IN ADDITION TO ESTABLISHING THE COMMISSION AS A PERMANENT BODY, THE KENNEDY BILL, CO-SPONSORED BY SEN. RICHARD SCHWEIKER (R-PA.) WOULD DOUBLE ITS SIZE BY ADDING THE SECRETARIES OF HEALTH, EDUCATION AND WELFARE, AND DEFENSE; THE CIA DIRECTOR; THE VETERANS ADMINISTRATION HEAD; PLUS FOUR SENATORS AND FOUR REPRESENTATIVES.

SHRIVER LAUDS ECHEVERRIA ON U.N. SPEECH;
FORESEES MASSIVE THIRD WORLD DEBT MORATORIA

CHICAGO, OCT. 10 (IPS) -- DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL HOPEFUL R. SARGENT SHRIVER TOLD A CAMPAIGN FUNDRAISING DINNER LAST EVENING THAT HE SUPPORTS MEXICAN PRESIDENT ECHEVERRIA'S CALL FOR VASTLY EXPANDED TRADE BETWEEN THE INDUSTRIALIZED AND THIRD WORLD NATIONS. SHRIVER TOLD HIS AUDIENCE OF 300 THAT DETENTE AND EXPANDED EAST-WEST TRADE MUST BE DEFENDED AGAINST POLITICAL ASSAULTS.

RESPONDING TO QUESTIONS FROM LABOR PARTY REPRESENTATIVES, SHRIVER ALSO SAID HE COULD FORESEE MASSIVE UNILATERAL DEBT MORATORIA BY THE THIRD WORLD, BUT SAID HE THOUGHT THIS WAS NOT A SHORT-TERM PROSPECT.

EARLIER, SHRIVER ATTENDED A PRIVATE THREE-HOUR MEETING WITH CHICAGO MAYOR RICHARD DALEY AND DEMOCRATIC PARTY NATIONAL CHAIRMAN ROBERT STRAUSS. THE THREE REPORTEDLY DISCUSSED PLANS FOR THE UPCOMING DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL COMMITTEE MEETING IN WASHINGTON, AND "POLITICS IN GENERAL."

IPS EXCLUSIVE:
BRANDT DENIES BEING 30-YEAR U.S. AGENT

FRANKFURT, BRD OCT. 10 (IPS) -- FORMER WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR AND CURRENT CHAIRMAN OF THE WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY (SPD) WILLY BRANDT YESTERDAY REPEATEDLY DENIED NUMEROUS PUBLISHED REPORTS THAT HE HAS ACTED AS A U.S. INTELLIGENCE OPERATIVE SINCE THE SECOND WORLD WAR AND THAT HIS ROLE HAS INCLUDED CONDUITING CIA MONEY TO ANTI-COMMUNIST FORCES IN PORTUGAL AND FINLAND.

IN MAKING THE DENIAL, BRANDT DIRECTLY CONTRADICTED STATEMENTS BY AN INFLUENTIAL MEMBER OF HIS OWN PARTY, EUGEN LODERER, THE HEAD OF THE WEST GERMAN METALWORKERS UNION, WHO WAS QUOTED IN SWEDISH RADIO AND NEWSPAPERS TWO DAYS AGO AS SAYING THAT MR. BRANDT HAD PERSONALLY DONATED FUNDS TO BE TRANSFERRED TO SWEDEN WHERE THEY COULD BE SMUGGLED TO ANTI-COMMUNIST TRADE UNIONISTS IN FINLAND. ON OCT. 7, THE TREASURER OF THE FINNISH SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY WAS ARRESTED AT THE SWEDISH BORDER ATTEMPTING TO SMUGGLE \$58,000 INTO HIS COUNTRY.

SPEAKING AT A PRESS CONFERENCE AT THE 1975 FRANKFURT BOOK FAIR, BRANDT WAS SUPPORTED IN HIS DENIAL OF SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC COMPLICITY IN CIA-ORGANIZED ANTI-COMMUNISM BY SWEDISH PREMIER OLOF PALME AND AUSTRIAN CHANCELLOR BRUNO KREISKY, BOTH SOCIAL DEMOCRATS.

MR. PALME IN FACT HELPED CLARIFY THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATS' ROLE: "WE HAVE ONLY BEEN THE MEDIATORS," THE SWEDISH PREMIER SAID.

THE PRESS CONFERENCE, ATTENDED BY OVER 100 JOURNALISTS, WAS DOMINATED BY A DISCUSSION OF AGENCY. A SAMPLE EXCHANGE:

QUESTION: "MR. BRANDT, ON THE SWEDISH RADIO YESTERDAY THERE WAS AN INTERVIEW WITH MR. LODERER WHO IS NOW IN TOKYO. HE EXPLICITLY SAID THAT PART OF THE MONEY HE HAD SENT TO SWEDEN WAS A DONATION BY YOU. SO WHO IS RIGHT, MR. LODERER OR YOU?"

BRANDT: "DID YOU REALLY HEAR THIS? THEN THIS MUST BE BASED ON A MISUNDERSTANDING. IT IS NOT TRUE."

SWEDISH JOURNALIST: "I AM FROM SWEDEN. I JUST HEARD THIS ALSO, FROM SOME COLLEAGUES OF MINE. IS IT TRUE?"

BRANDT: "NO, IT IS NOT...I WANT TO REPEAT AGAIN, THIS QUESTION WITH LODERER MUST BE BASED ON SOME ERROR."

SAME JOURNALIST: "BUT WHERE THEN ARE THESE 100,000 DEUTSCHEMARKS COMING FROM?"

BRANDT: "MR. LODERER IS A DISTINGUISHED PERSON. HE WILL DEFEND HIMSELF WHEN HE COMES BACK."

AT ONE POINT DURING THE MEETING, BRANDT REFERRED TO IPS CORRESPONDENTS AS "TROTSKYIST FASCISTS," AND PALME TOLD THE PRESS CONFERENCE: "IPS IS AN AGENCY FOR WHICH YOU DON'T HAVE TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS, YOU SIMPLY HAVE TO ORGANIZE OTHER JOURNALISTS TO KICK THEM OUT."

WEST GERMAN PARLIAMENTARY LEADERS
PUSH CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATS
ON TRADE AND DETENTE

OCT. 10 (IPS) -- WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARLIAMENTARY LEADER HERBERT WEHNER AND HIS FREE DEMOCRATIC COUNTERPART WOLFGANG MISCHNIK, BOTH ADVOCATES OF DEVELOPMENT AND DETENTE, TODAY MADE SWEEPING INTERVENTIONS INTO THE SPLIT BETWEEN PRO-DEVELOPMENT AND PRO-ROCKEFELLER FORCES IN THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION. FREE DEMOCRAT MISCHNIK, WRITING IN THE AUGSBERGER ALLEGEMEINE, PRAISES THE RECENT VISIT OF CDU CHAIRMAN HELMUT KOHL TO MOSCOW, WHERE KOHL ADVOCATED THE PRO-TRADE AND DETENTE POLICIES OF THE CDU FACTION OF GERHARD STOLTENBERG. MISCHNIK EXPLAINS THAT THE QUESTION BEFORE THE CDU NOW IS WHETHER KOHL'S POLICY WILL WIN OUT, OR WHETHER THE CORPORATIST AGENT WING OF THE CDU AROUND GENERAL SECRETARY HELMUT BIEDENKOPF AND THE NEO-NAZI FACTION OF THE BAVARIAN FRANZ JOSEF STRAUSS WILL SUCCEED IN SABOTAGING EAST-WEST RELATIONS.

EXTENDING THE CHALLENGE, HERBERT WEHNER WROTE IN THE HAMBURGER NACHRICHTEN THAT THE CDU AS A PARTY IS SO SPLIT ON EAST-WEST POLICY THAT "THEIR REACTIONS ARE NONCOMMITTAL, CONTRADICTIONARY, AND SOMETIMES INSUFFERABLE."
