I. WORLD NEWS ROUND-UP

PRESIDENT OF GUINEA (WEST AFRICA) DEMANDS AMIN'S RESIGNATION  
FOR HIS HOSTILITY TOWARD POPULAR MOVEMENT

NOV. 15 (IPS)—SEKOU TOURE, PRESIDENT OF GUINEA (WEST AFRICA), HAS DEMANDED THAT UGANDAN PRESIDENT IDI AMIN RESIGN AS PRESIDENT OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY (OAU) "BECAUSE OF HIS HOSTILE STANCE TOWARD THE POPULAR MOVEMENT (MPLA)." THE MPLA IS THE LEGITIMATE GOVERNMENT OF NEWLY INDEPENDENT ANGOLA. ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S W. GERMAN DAILY DIE WELT, AMIN HAD ATTEMPTED TO CREATE AN OAU "PEACE-KEEPING" FORCE TO ENTER ANGOLA AND COMPEL THE MPLA TO UNITTE WITH THE CIA-RUN MOVEMENTS.

BA'ATH PARTY REFUSES TO NEGOTIATE WITH FASCISTS.

NOV. 15 (IPS)—THE LEBANESE LEADERSHIP OF THE ARAB BA'ATH SOCIALIST PARTY (ABSP) HAS ANNOUNCED THAT IT IS OPPOSED TO NEGOTIATING WITH THE CIA-FASCIST SUPPORTED FALANGE OR MAKING ANY AGREEMENTS WITH IT, ACCORDING TO THE NOV. 15TH THAWRA, THE ABSP NEWSPAPER IN IRAQ.

AN ABSP SPOKESMAN MADE THE STATEMENT AFTER ELEMENTS OF THE ARAB NATIONALIST MOVEMENT IN LEBANON INDICATED THAT THEY WOULD BE READY TO JOIN A COORDINATING COMMITTEE MADE UP OF GOVERNMENT AUTHORITIES, THE PALESTINIAN RESISTANCE, AND THE FALANGE.

IRAQIS WANT GUARANTEE THAT THEIR BRD PURCHASES,  
WILL BE PROTECTED FROM INFLATION

NOV. 15 (IPS)—WEST GERMAN ECONOMICS MINISTER HAN FRIDERICH'S RECENT TRIP TO IRAQ HAS PRODUCED ONLY ORDERS FOR THREE AIRPORTS AND A 1200 KILOMETER LONG HIGHWAY RUNNING FROM THE NORTH OF IRAQ TO THE PERSIAN GULF.

FRIDERICH'S DID NOT SIGN A FORMAL COOPERATION WITH IRAQ BECAUSE THE IRAQIS WANTED A WRITTEN GUARANTEE THAT THEIR PURCHASES WOULD NOT BE DEVALUED BY INFLATION, WHICH FRIDERICH'S WOULD NOT ACCEPT. THE RESULTS OF THE TRIP WERE REPORTED IN YESTERDAY'S WEST GERMAN FINANCIAL DAILY, HANDELSBLATT.

SENATE COMMITTEE APPROVES RUMSFELD CONFIRMATION

NOV. 15 (IPS)—BY A UNANIMOUS VOTE, THE SENATE ARMED SERVICES COMMITTEE HAS APPROVED PRESIDENT FORD'S NOMINATION OF WHITE HOUSE CHIEF OF STAFF DONALD RUMSFELD AS THE NEW SECRETARY OF DEFENSE. THE APPOINTMENT NOW GOES TO THE FULL SENATE WHERE IT IS EXPECTED TO BE APPROVED BY A SIZEABLE MAJORITY.

SYMPTOMATIC OF THE CHANGING CLIMATE IN WASHINGTON, NOW THAT FORMER DEFENSE SECRETARY JAMES SCHLESINGER HAS RETIRED FROM GOVERNMENT, THE WASHINGTON POST YESTERDAY GAVE PROMINENT COVERAGE TO THE SOVIET UNION'S REJECTION OF THE LATEST U.S. PROPOSAL ON SALT II, CITING SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER'S SABOTAGE OF SALT NEGOTIATIONS AS THE REASON. QUOTING LIBERALLY FROM SOVIET OFFICIALS, THE POST NOTES THAT THE LATEST U.S. PROPOSAL, WHICH THE SOVIETS REJECTED, WAS UNACCEPTABLE BECAUSE IT AMOUNTS TO A REVISION OF THE ORIGINAL VLADIVOSTOCK ACCORD, SALT I. THE U.S. PROPOSAL INTRODUCES A NEW CATEGORY OF WEAPONS AND RAISES THE WEAPONS' CEILINGS AGREED TO AT VLADIVOSTOCK.

"WHAT KIND OF LIMITATION IS IT," ASKED ONE SOVIET OFFICIAL QUOTED BY THE POST, "IF EACH TIME YOU INTRODUCE A NEW WEAPON YOU INCREASE THE NUMBER? WHAT BOTHERS US THE MOST, IS THE TREND AWAY FROM LIMITATION. IF IT PERSISTS, WHAT'S THE USE OF AN AGREEMENT?"

II. ORGANIZING AND INTELLIGENCE REPORT

HAYDEN REFUSES TO DENY LINKS TO ROCKEFELLER TERROR APPARAT

SAN FRANCISCO, NOV. 15 (IPS)—TOM HAYDEN, A KEY CIA OPERATIVE IN THE U.S. STUDENT MOVEMENT IN THE 1960S AND CURRENTLY A CONTENDER FOR THE DEMOCRATIC CANDIDACY FOR U.S. SENATOR FROM CALIFORNIA, REFUSED TO DENY HIS CONNECTIONS TO THE DOMESTIC FASCIST TERROR APPARATUS NOW UNDER THE CONTROL OF ATTORNEY GENERAL EDWARD LEVI.

HAYDEN MADE HIS COMMENTS BEFORE 600 PEOPLE AT A CAMPAIGN FORUM AT SAN FRANCISCO STATE IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION FROM THE LABOR PARTY.

THE LABOR PARTY TOOK OVER THE FORUM, AFTER HAYDEN WAS UNABLE TO DEFEND HIS FASCIST ECONOMIC PROGRAM. THE AUDIENCE BEGAN HECKLING HAYDEN'S PROPOSALS FOR "ECONOMIC DEMOCRACY," SOLAR POWER, AND THE EATING OF FISH TO END THE FOOD CRISIS. AFTER A LABOR PARTY SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THE TERM "ECONOMIC DEMOCRACY" WAS COINED BY RAND CORPORATION COUNTER-INSURGENTS, HAYDEN DISPATCHED A GOON SQUAD TO EXPEL THE ORGANIZERS. THE THUGS, HOWEVER, WERE RESTRAINED BY THE AUDIENCE AND HAYDEN WAS FORCED TO ABRUPTLY END HIS SPEECH.

SEVERAL HUNDRED STUDENTS STAYED TO HEAR A FULL INTERNATIONAL BRIEFING FROM THE LABOR PARTY AS PHOTOGRAPHERS SNAPPED PICTURES.

THE NOV. 13 SAN FRANCISCO CHRONICLE'S COVERAGE OF THE HAYDEN FORUM STRONGLY SUGGESTS THAT HAYDEN'S CONTROLLERS ARE DUMPING HIS CAMPAIGN AS USELESS. THE CHRONICLE ERRONEOUSLY ATTRIBUTES TO HAYDEN A U.S. LABOR PARTY STATEMENT THAT "THE RADICALISM OF THE 1960S IS THE FASCISM OF THE 1970S." HAYDEN'S BASE OF SUPPORT IS COMPOSED OF EXACTLY THESE 1960S PROTO-FASCISTS. THE CANDIDATE IS REPORTED TO HAVE QUICKLY LEFT SAN FRANCISCO.

HAYDEN IS RUNNING AGAINST INCUMBENT SEN. JOHN TUNNEY (D-CA), WHO HEADS THE SENATE JUDICIARY SUBCOMMITTEE ON CIVIL LIBERTIES. THIS COMMITTEE IS NOW IN DISCUSSIONS WITH THE RULES COMMITTEE IN PREPARATION FOR THE BEGINNING OF AN INVESTIGATION OF THE MANSON ASSASSINATION THREAT AGAINST THE USLP AS WELL AS MASSIVE ELECTORAL FRAUD IN THE 1975 ELECTIONS.

CAREY'S AUSTERITY PACKAGE RUNNING INTO SWAGS;  
BARBERO PROPOSES BANK TAX

ALBANY, N.Y., NOV. 15 (IPS)—STATE ASSEMBLYMAN ANTHONY BARBERO (D-BKLYN) IS CURRENTLY CIRCULATING A PROPOSAL AT THE EMERGENCY SESSION OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE HERE CALLING FOR SIGNIFICANT NEW TAXES ON INCOME-YIELDING SECURITIES OF BANKS.

OBSERVERS NOTED THAT THE PROPOSAL IS BROADLY REFLECTIVE OF RESISTANCE AMONG STATE LEGISLATORS TO APPROVING GOVERNOR CAREY'S COMPREHENSIVE AUSTERITY "ANTI-DEFAULT" PACKAGE.

IN ADDITION TO SOME \$800 MILLION IN NEW CITY AND STATE TAXES, CAREY'S HOPES TO GUARANTEE THE VALUE OF THE NEW YORK BANKS' INVESTMENT IN NEW YORK PAPER THROUGH A REGIMEN OF BUDGET CUTS AT THE CITY AND STATE LEVEL, CONTRIBUTIONS BY MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES OF \$85 MILLION A YEAR TO THEIR PENSION FUNDS, AND THE INVESTMENT OF \$2.5 BILLION FROM THESE PENSION FUNDS IN NEW CITY SECURITIES, WHICH WOULD BE USED TO PAY BACK THE BANKS.

ROCKEFELLER OPERATIVES IN THE LEGISLATURE ARE REPORTED NERVOUS THAT SUPPORT FOR SUCH PROPOSALS AS BARBERO'S MIGHT PREVENT THE SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION FROM BEING A "RUBBER STAMP" FOR THE CAREY PLAN AND THEREBY JEOPARDIZE FEDERAL SUPPORT FOR THE PACKAGE.

DAILY WORLD REPORTER REVEALED AS PALME ACCOMPLICE

NEW YORK, NOV. 15 (IPS)—IPS HAS LEARNED THAT THE PROVOCATEUR WHO ASKED A PLANTED QUESTION CONCERNING IPS' ALLEGED CONNECTIONS TO THE CIA AT A UNITED NATIONS PRESS CONFERENCE BY SWEDISH SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC OLOF PALME ON NOV. 11 WAS GENE TOURNOUR, A MEMBER OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY USA AND A STAFF REPORTER FOR THE PARTY'S NEWS-PAPER, THE DAILY WORLD.

TOURNOUR ADMITTED HIS ROLE IN A TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH THE NATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES' OFFICE IN NEW YORK CITY YESTERDAY. TOURNOUR, WHO PUBLISHED ANOTHER SLANDER ARTICLE ON IPS, THE NCLC, AND THE U.S. LABOR PARTY IN YESTERDAY'S DAILY WORLD, ALSO TOLD THE USLP THAT "WHAT YOU GUYS DON'T UNDERSTAND IS THAT PALME AND BRANDT (WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY LEADER) ARE THE PROGRESSIVE, LEFT-WING OF THE SOCIAL DEMOCRACY." BRANDT HAS BEEN WIDELY EXPOSED AS A 30-YEAR AGENT OF THE CIA.

TOURNOUR'S LATEST SLANDER ARTICLE IS AIMED AT HELPING FOSTER AN ENVIRONMENT FOR INCREASED THUGGERY AND ASSASSINATION ATTEMPTS AGAINST NCLC, USLP, AND INTERNATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS. PALME, A LEADING EUROPEAN ROCKEFELLER AGENT, IS RELIABLY REPORTED TO HAVE OUTLINED SUCH A PROGRAM IN HIS SPEECH TO ROCKEFELLER'S "COUNCIL ON FOREIGN RELATIONS" YESTERDAY, TITLED "THE LEFT FORCES IN EUROPE."

ERDA ATTACKS SOVIET FUSION EFFORT; WARNS OF BUDGET CUTS

ST. PETERSBURG, FLA., NOV. 15 (IPS)—ENERGY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (ERDA) OFFICIALS HAVE ATTEMPTED TO COUNTERACT GROWING SUPPORT FOR A CRASH PROGRAM OF FUSION DEVELOPMENT BY SPREADING TWO PROVOCATIVE RUMORS AT THE PLASMA PHYSICS CONFERENCE HERE THIS WEEK.

ERDA OFFICIALS ATTACKED THE SOVIET FUSION PROGRAM AS "OVERRATED" AND NOT UP TO THAT OF THE U.S. EFFORT AND HAVE ARBITRARILY MOVED AGAINST U.S. SCIENTISTS WHO PRAISE SUCH EFFORTS. IN ONE CASE, A U.S. RESEARCHER, WHO HAD PRAISED THE SOVIET LASER FUSION PROGRAM AFTER A VISIT TO MOSCOW, WAS SUMMARILY CUT FROM ALL PROJECT FUNDING, ACCORDING TO SOURCES AT THE CONFERENCE.

NON-ERDA OBSERVERS AT THE CONFERENCE, HOWEVER, CORRECTLY EVALUATED THE SOVIET EFFORT AS FAR SUPERIOR TO THE U.S. FUSION PROGRAM.

ANOTHER ERDA-CIRCULATED RUMOR CLAIMED THAT THE AGENCY'S FUSION PROGRAM WOULD SOON BE MASSIVELY CUT AS A RESULT OF PRESIDENT FORD'S PROPOSED \$28 BILLION OVERALL BUDGET SLASH. SUCH RUMORS WERE AIMED AT LIMITING THE DEBATE ON THE PROGRAM TO A DISCUSSION OF "ALLOCATION OF LIMITED RESOURCES" RATHER THAN THE ISSUE OF A BROAD, CRASH FUSION DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.
