# LODF Legal Offensive Closes in on Levi, FBI

April 10 (IPS) — During the next two weeks, all of the U.S. Labor Party's major cases against the FBI police-state apparatus will be moving forward. This is our heavy artillery: with it we have Attorney General Edward Levi. FBI Director Clarence Kelley and their gestapo agents cornered. The evidence obtained through pre-trial discovery in these cases can put Levi and his co-conspirators

out of a job for good.

The legal cases are all in place and moving — now we need the money and lawyers to maximize our legal firepower. Here is the schedule for the next two weeks.

#### Case

### Detroit FBI (Ghandhi v. Police Department and FBI).

The USLP's most advanced legal case, well on the way to nailing Kelley and the FBI for illegal Cointelpro acts and interference in elections.

### FBI—Freedom of Information Act (LaRouche v. Kelley).

National suit against Kelley and Levi demanding disclosure of files on NCLC and USLP, and an injunction prohibiting Cointelpro activities against USLP.

# Reading (NCLC v. City of Reading, FBI, and ATF).

Suit against Levi. Kelley. the Treasury Department's Alcohol. Tobacco and Firearms division (ATF), and local police for conspiracy against the USLP after the Labor Party exposed the FBI-ATF terrorism network.

### New Jersey FBI (USLP v. Banks).

Suit against FBI conspiracy to disrupt the Labor Party electoral campaign and against FBI informant Anthony Banks who stole telephone lists and election petitions from USLP.

#### New York State Police (LaRouche v. Rockefeller).

Suit against Nelson Rockefeller, N.Y. state police, and N.Y. city police for illegal surveillance and collection and use of police files for harassment.

#### New Jersey State Police (NCLC v. Brennan).

Suit against New Jersey state police and Elizabeth city police charging conspiracy to harass USLP organizing.

#### UAW (UAW v. NCLC).

UAW is suing NCLC for \$30 million. USLP countersuit hits UAW-FBI in-plant kapo network.

Motion to compel FBI to testify.

Motion to compel police to produce files on USLP.

Depositions of police and of USLP plaintiffs.

## Move for injunction against FBI.

Appeal of Government Accounting Office's denial of request for documents alleging that the NCLC is a "subversive" group.

Submit interrogatories to Kelley and Levi.

# Begin pre-trial discovery with interrogatories and motions to produce police files.

Answer FBI's motion to dismiss case by proving federal conspiracy.

# April 12: Hearing on FBI's motion to dismiss the USLP

Begin pre-trial discovery of evidence.

# Move for default judgment against Rockefeller and other defendants who failed to answer by Jan. 1 deadline.

File amended complaint showing plan and practice of police conspiracy.

Begin pre-trial discovery by moving to get police to produce their files.

Gather evidence from UAW members, in preparation to begin discovery in early May.
