"COUNTERSPY" AGENT ATTACKS AND STABS TWO USLP ORGANIZERS

April 26 (IPS) -- Known police provocateur and Maoist controller, "Cappy" Pinderhues, attacked and stabbed two members of the U.S. Labor Party this morning in Baltimore while they were campaigning with Labor Party Congressional candidate William Salisbury at an unemployment center. The two organizers, Steven Cook and Carleton Braxton, were released from Maryland General Hospital in good condition, and the attacker has been arrested and charged with "aggravated assault and cutting" and "carrying a deadly weapon", together having a maximum penalty of 20 years in jail.

Pinderhues, formerly a black nationalist police-agent in Boston, has for the last year and a half been acting as the coordinator of police-controlled Maoist groupings in the Baltimore area - the "Revolutionary Union", "October League", and "Progressive Labor." One of these groups, the "Revolutionary Union" and its terrorist unit, the "George Jackson Brigade", are presently being deployed in Seattle under the direction of "Counterspy" to harass, assault, and threaten U.S. Labor Party organizers. The Washington, D.C.-based "Counterspy" grouping of "ex"-CIA agents has recently boasted that its "clearinghouse" has the "most extensive files" on the Labor Party, and has vowed to "stop the Labor Party."

The Baltimore Labor Party will be holding a press conference tomorrow, with time and place to be announced.
