LAROUCHE SAYS "LIQUIDATE THE FALANGE"

WIESBADEN, W. Germany, April 26 (IPS)--U.S. Labor Party presidential candidate Lyndon H. LaRouche last night again proposed the "immediate liquidation of the Falange" in Lebanon as an "indispensable included step of any effort to prevent general Middle East war and possible thermonuclear confrontation."

"Let us hear no diplomatic cretinism on this point," he emphasized. "Every informed political agency knows exactly what the Falange is. Equally important, we all know--or should know--the possible price of not disassembling that particular monster."

LaRouche emphasized that the Falange is "in terms to which the general public is accustomed, entirely a CIA creation," developed for the purpose of destabilizing Lebanon through "an attempted replay of the Northern Ireland scenario" and for the purpose of "providing Kissinger and Company with a variety of options for escalating a Middle East war into a possible thermonuclear confrontation."

"Once the Falange's bloody tactics are instrumental in bringing right-wing warhawks into power in Jerusalem, and those warhawks move into the Rand Corporation's projected breakaway ally mode, the world would be very close to the brink of general thermonuclear war."

"There are several available options for liquidating the Falange," he added. "Under the proper arrangements the Syrian army could be a suitable instrument. Something like that may unfortunately prove necessary, since I have reason to believe that a significant part of the support for the gang comes from oil companies and other sources outside the efficient control of the White House's command structure."

"Of course," he qualified, "it would have to be made clear that Israel will absolutely not treat a clean-up of the Falange as a red-line condition," emphasizing that "the Falange has some curious bedfellows in various parts of the Middle East and elsewhere."

LaRouche stated, "The American working class should note that the Falange is a part of the same terrorist network as the Weathermen bombers, Black September, the Red Brigades, the Baader-Meinhof gang, the Latin American death squads and those pathetic psychotics mysteriously released from mental institutions to carry out killings in Baltimore or bombings in the Boston state house. It is not accidental that the hands controlling those terrorist gangs are the same hands that originate and spread
