KISSINGER ORDERS ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT AGAINST PLM ORGANIZER

June 13 (NSIPS) -- Mexican Labor Party organizer Marcelino Barbosa was the victim of a hit-and-run assassination attempt this afternoon in the south-west of Mexico City. He has been hospitalized and his condition is not yet known. Witnesses at the scene report that a White Dodge Dart with license plate #763-BSY ran a red light and accelerated to hit Barbosa as he crossed the intersection of Angel Urraza and Cuauhtemoc Avenues.

The assassination attempt comes as the latest of a series of attacks against members and supporters of the Mexican Labor Party (PLM) over the last week. The attacks have included arbitrary firings of workers organizing with the PLM, break-ins into the homes of PLM leaders, threatening visits to members' homes by police agents, and death threats from the CIA-controlled 23rd of September League terrorist organization. The terror operations against the PLM are aimed at halting the PLM's exposure of widespread terror networks in Mexico that are controlled by the Rockefeller family and U.S. Secretary of State, Henry Kissinger. Kissinger is currently in Mexico.

The Rockefeller and Kissinger terror apparatus has been activated on a national scale over the last month as part of an operation to isolate and destabilize Jose Lopez Portillo, the Presidential candidate of the ruling PRI party and the assured winner of the July 4 Presidential elections. Rockefeller and Kissinger are attempting to split Lopez Portillo from the pro-development policies of current President Luis Echeverria in order to open Mexico up for the implementation of genocidal economic and political policies that would reduce Mexico's population by 30 million people.

The PLM has previously identified Interior Minister Moya Palencia as a key controller of terrorist operations in Mexico, and as the front man for the Monterrey Group of industrialists who are the local executors of Rockefeller's plans for the Mexican population.

Marcelino Barbosa is a Professor of Physics at the School of Science at the National Autonomous University of Mexico. Further information on his condition and the attempted murder will be released as soon as it is available.
