To the U.S. Congress: Glass-Steagall Now!

May 1—Mexican nationals are signing a “Message from Mexico,” addressed to members of the U.S. Congress, calling upon them to “immediately” enact HR 129, to restore Franklin Roosevelt’s Glass-Steagall Act. Signators are also endorsing the Schiller Institute’s [Frankfurt Resolution](#), which is also being forwarded as part of their message.

The LaRouche Movement in Mexico began circulating the statement this week as part of the week of international mobilization for Glass-Steagall. The manifesto identifies the threat of global hyperinflation and the nature of the HR 129 bill, and warns: “Without a Glass-Steagall-style regulatory standard for the financial system, in the United States and the world, a world economic collapse shall be imminent, and, as our former President José López Portillo stated before the United Nations in 1982, our nations shall be the victims of ‘a new medieval Dark Age with no possibility of a Renaissance.’ We ask that you not lose this historic opportunity, this ferment which has crossed the border, that is discussed in 17 states in the United States, in Europe, in international banking circles, and which we are discussing in Mexico due to the work of Mr. LaRouche’s Movement for a new economic system. Sign onto HR 129 and you will be a patriot and a citizen of the world.”
