U.S. LABOR PARTY STATEMENT ON THE ELECTIONS

NEW YORK, N.Y., Nov. 6 (IPS)--The emergence of the U.S. Labor Party in yesterday's elections as the mass-based party of the working clashas transformed politics in the U.S. and throughout the world. Working class politics are no longer minority protest politics; the U.S. working class has now shown that it is ready to be mobilized around program of struggle against the Rockefeller forces and their plans t impose fascist economics in the U.S. and throughout the world.

In spite of massive electoral fraud, the vote for the Labor Par ty candidates is at least 10 per cent and in many areas will exceed the 10 to 20 per cent range. Official returns so far show 11 per cent for Alan Ogden in Richmond, Virginia in the 5th Congressional District, about 11 per cent for Larry Sherman in Boston's 9th Congressional District, and about 8 per cent for James Kiggen in the 8t Congressional District in Boston.

On the basis of straw polls taken within factories on the East Coast and in the Midwest, support for the Labor Party runs around 30 per cent among industrial workers. On this basis a 10 to 20 per cen vote is to be expected.

This is no simple protest vote. Over recent weeks the factorie and working class neighborhoods have come alive with political discussion and debate. Large sections of the U.S. working class, educated over months by the newspaper <u>New Solidarity</u>, have clearly iden tified who their enemy is and what he represents and they have under stood what has to be done to defeat the Rockefellers' conspiracy. Millions of workers have studied and debated the program for industrial expansion and for expansion of food production, based on a crash program of development of fusion power.

The U.S. working class, for the first time in a quarter century has begun to become conscious of the power it possesses as a class. Our task over the next few weeks is to consolidate the hundreds of thousands of workers who have expressed their support for the Labor Party into a political machine capable of beating back the Rockefeller programs for slave labor and deindustrialization. As workers be come conscious of what they have already done in this election, the 30 to 40 per cent support which the Labor Party now has in areas of our highest penetration can quickly go over to 60 to 70 per cent support.

We will present in court legal evidence of massive electoral fraud in New York City and State over the next few days. On this basis, plus the report of 10-12 votes in certain districts, we will show the national pattern of fraud. This is most obvious in situations where the lowest tallied votes were in the areas of highest Labor Party penetration and influence, such as South Philadelphia ar industrial areas in Michigan.

FARIS, Nov. 6 (IPS)--International Press Service has received report from informed sources that in the northern district of Paris, populated by immigrant workers from Africa, "gangs" have emerged attempting to sell firearms for 60 Francs apiece. IPS is now investigating the origins of these "gangs."

LIBYA-BASED TERRORIST NET SURFACES

Nov. 6 (IPS)--In the past two days, a Palestinian terrorist network, operating out of the CIA's central Mideast headquarters in Libya, has surfaced.

In a Nov. 5 front-page article in the <u>Washington</u> <u>Post</u>, correspondent Jim Hoagland reported that the number two man under Palestin Liberation Organization (PLO) chief Arafat, Salan Khalaf, alias Abu Iyad, has been accused of leading the heralded "Rabat plot" to murder King Hussein and other "moderate" Arab leaders. The murders were to take place during the recent Arab summit.

Officially "missing," Abu Iyad is rumored to be in Libya, where "he might be able to count on the support of Libya's Col. Qaddafi for an operation to undermine Arab efforts for a peaceful settlement with Israel....Khalaf has been identified by Western intelligence service as a head of the Black September terrorist organization, which stage the Munich massacre in 1972." The IPS United Nations brief on the Palestine Liberation Organization fully documents that the PLO is both CIA-funded and controlled.

A day later, a Jordanian plane was hijacked and rerouted to Ben ghazi, Libya by a group calling itself the "Jordan Free Officers." King Hussein has been a long-standing hated enemy of both the fanati Qaddafi and the Palestinian movement. While his recent "voluntary" withdrawal from the West Bank is a great "victory" for the liberatio movement, escalated operations against him are not to be excluded.

To add to the mayhem, the Israeli Air Force was on alert as the plane diverted its course to Libya, which puts into renewed focus re cent exclusive disclosures received by IPS that Israel is planning a preemptive strike against Libya.

DER SPIEGEL EDITOR ENDORSES NEO-NAZI STRAUSS

Nov. 6 (IPS)--Agent Rudolph Augstein, publisher of the widely-read West German newsweekly <u>Der Spiegel</u>, has blown his "liberal" cover in that magazine's latest issue by endorsing neo-Nazi Franz-Josef Strauss for the West German Chancellory.

Augstein's signed editorial praising the Bavarian fascist comes hot on the heels of Strauss' call for an independent European NATO, a line written for him at the secret Trilateral Commission meeting in Bellagio, Italy in October. By endorsing Strauss at this time, Augstein not only has confirmed that his previous "arch-enemy" status with Strauss was contrived farce, but also has exposed his own statuas an agent for Rockefeller's Trilateral criminals.

Augstein's record at Der Spiegel speaks for itself:

*1946--Der Spiegel is founded by Augstein and a British Army "Major" operating for British Intelligence.

*1947--British Intelligence gives clearance to Hans-Detlev Becker er and assigns him as Augstein's right-hand man at <u>Der Spiegel</u>. Becker had been the counter-espionage specialist of the Nazi High Command (OKW). He remains notorious for his connections to the West German BND (CIA), including a reputation as the "journalist" who was closest to Nazi master spook Reinhard Gehlen, founder and head of the BND from 1935 to 1968. Becker's work during his assignment to <u>Der Spiegel</u> wins him the "recommendation" of Trilateral Commission member Theo Sommer's newspaper <u>Die Zeit</u> as the man most eminently qualified to head the West German CIA.

*1960s--Augstein with Becker brings his BND-collaboration into the open by engineering the scandal which became known as the "Spiegel Affair." The Adenauer era is forced to an end, allowing a government to come to power more amenable to the changed NATO doctrine for the 1960s--"flexible response." The BND-orchestrated removal of Franz-Josef Strauss as Defense Minister wins Augstein his "liberal" image as the "arch-enemy" of the Bavarian fascist.

*1974--NATO planning for West Germany's current armed forces reorganization is undertaken at the direction of the CIA-Brookings Institute of the U.S. Implementation is placed in the hands of the West German Defense Ministry's Planning Staff, whose Deputy Director is Hans Schmelz, former Chief Editor of Der Spiegel under Augstein.

*1974--Nov. 3, in an interview in the French weekly Le Point, Franz-Josef Strauss calls for an independent, politically unified Europe, with a NATO force separate from the U.S.--a directive of the Trilateral Commission.

*1974--Nov. 3, <u>Der Spiegel</u> carries a signed editorial by Augstein endorsing Strauss for Chancellor of West Germany.

ISRAEL STEPS UP WAR PACE AS CIA ESCALATES GUERRILLA ACTIVITY

Nov. 6 (IPS)--In a speech yesterday to Parliament, Israeli Prime Minister Yitzchak Rabin blustered that: "It doesn't enter our minds to negotiate with a body [the Palestine Liberation Organization] that would negate our existence as a state and resorts to violence and terror to destroy our state." The PLO is nothing more than a "murden organization," according to this Israeli leader.

Rabin's remarks followed quickly on the heels of Israeli deportation of prominent West Bank Arab leaders accused of support for the PLO and membership in the Palestinian National Front, which allegedly had "perpetrated acts of murder and terrorism." The London Times indicated that other issues were at stake. The Israelis, they said, had revised their policy after the decision of Jordan's King Hussein at Rabat to hand the West Bank to the PLO in order "to underline Israel's refusal to deal with the PLO."

Combined with continual press reports of overnight consolidation of proto-governmental infrastructures by the CIA-manipulated PLO and the guerrilla operations threatened to coincide with the Nov. 13 Palestime debate at the UN, such Israeli security operations quicken the pace of the war momentum.

WORKING CLASS ELECTORAL VICTORY: LABOR PARTY EMERGES AS MASS-BASED MOVEMENT

NEW YORK, N.Y., Nov. 6 (IPS)--Yesterday in a historic first for communist organizing in the United States, Labor Party candidate Alan Ogden, running for Congress from the 5th Congressional District in Richmond, Virginia, polled 7,539 votes--11 per cent of the vote--according to the official Board of Elections tally. In San Francisco, Labor Party candidate for School Board Richard Clancy won 14,338 votes. Boston results show Labor Party candidates Laurence Sherman and James Kiggens winning 10 to 12 per cent of the total vote.

As of yesterday, the U.S. Labor Party is officially the massbased party of the working class.

*A detailed analysis of the 11 per cent Richmond vote total by the Labor Party National Operations Center in New York City yielded the following breakdown: In black working class areas, the U.S. Labor Party polled 30 to 35 per cent of the vote, in interracial working class sections the Labor Party vote was 20 per cent, in white working class areas the turnout for the Labor Party was 8 to 12 per cent of the vote. These figures reflect the strength of Labor Party ideas among wide sections of the working class population of the skilled, employed, and unemployed.

*In South Boston, mass Labor Party organizing exposing the phonbusing issue and the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration's racriots brought out Labor Party votes of 17 and 14 per cent in two districts in the Sherman race.

*In San Francisco, first projections for Labor Party candidate Richard Clancy for School Board were 12 per cent. The next "official" vote count gave Clancy only 6.2 per cent, still a high 14,338 votes.

Preliminary "official" totals nationwide with returns incomplete for most campaigns show that the U.S. Labor Party "officially" received 50,739 votes--despite massive fraud. In fact, Labor Party candidates polled at least 20 per cent of the vote nationally.

Labor Party Countermeasures Against Vote Fraud

In New York State--where only one per cent of the total vote, or 50,000 votes for a gubernatorial candidate places a third party permanently on the ballot--the evidence of vote stealing from U.S. Labor Party gubernatorial candidate Tony Chaitkin is already in. Labor Party voters have signed affidavits swearing to having voted in election districts where official counts register no Labor Party votes!

In a suit to be presented before the New York State Supreme Court Friday, Nov. 8, the U.S. Labor Party will enter a plea on Article 333 of the state election law demanding that voting machines in targeted election districts be impounded pending investigation of electoral fraud. This plea supplements the Labor Party complaint already in Federal Court showing that the New York City ballot was deliberately designed to obscure the Labor Party line and confuse voters. This was affirmed in a decision by New York Federal Court Judge Charles L. Brieant, Jr., Thursday, Nov. 4. Evidence from Buffalo, Albany, Schenectady, and Rochester also will be introduced at Friday's court appearance.

In South Philadelphia, where Labor Party candidate Bernie Salera ran for Congress in a campaign followed nationally by workers, the Labor Party is planning similar court action to impound voting machines. Television newscasts there reduced their initial reports of Salera's vote from 5,000 to 1,800 to 1,000!

FOOD EXPORT BANS DICTATED AT ROME

ROME, Nov. 6 (IPS)--At a secret meeting of the major food producers held during the World Food Conference here, Eockefeller henchman and FAO head A.H. Boerma dictated the terms of his bosses' food control policy: food exports to the advanced countries, especially Western Europe and Japan, are to be slashed by trade controls and the food is to be diverted into a "food reserve." Henry Kissinger backed these plans to spread starvation to the advanced countries by threatening any nation which did not participate with being cut off entirely from the world food market--a food export ban.

The implementation of these new moves to destroy food productio and distribution comes at a time when John D. Rockefeller III's final solution to the opulation problem is already being carried out on a mass scale in the "skeleton camps" of Bangladesh, India and the Sahel.

The export control plan, the details of which are still secret, Will endanger the flow of about 25 million tons of food which is imported annually by Japan, Britain, Germany, Italy, the Metherlands and Belgium. Although food consumption of these countries will be reduced to subsistence levels, without a doubt none of the food diverted will find its way to Rockefeller's Fourth World exterminaticamps. The Rissinger visit to India and Bangladesh, which resulted in the pledging of a tiny 600,000 tons of aid to the two countries, the cutting off of all US aid to large areas of the Sahel, the brutal refusal to aid Honduras at a time when the U.S. alone holds more than 15 million tons in grain, all demonstrate that the decision to starve the Fourth World is already made. The food diverted from workers' tables will go into "food reserve banks," to be doled out as Rockefeller pleases.

SOVIET INACTION

In the face of Rockefeller's brutal imposition of food control and famine on the advanced countries and his elimination thus far of millions of Asians, Africans and Latin Americans, the Soviet Union has done nothing. In fact, the Soviets have placed themselves on the verge of providing a left cover for genocide. They have actually gone so far as to attend the secret meetings where Boerma and the other flunkies have dictated the food export controls and have agreed to consider participating in the schemes.

Rockefeller's cops have done their best to make sure the International Caucus of Labor Committees is not around to bust up their plans as it did at the Bucharest Population Conference. Not only were attempts made to bar IPS correspondents, officially accredited by the UN, from the proceedings, but outside the conference twelve ICLC organizers were beaten up by the Rome police as they distributed a leaflet exposing the conference and the cannibals behind it.

COUNTERGANG COVER

To conceal Rockefeller's guilt for the extermination camps of Bangladesh and the slashing of advanced country consumption through trade controls, the conference set up a propaganda barrage to push Rockefeller's plans under suitable left rhetoric. The "Roman Forum," a collection of 26 minor Goebbels led by Barbara Mard and Rockefelle foundation President John H. Knowles, blames the "too fat" workers of the advanced countries for Rockefeller's starvation of Bangladesh The "Forum" advocates immediate food rationing in Morth America and Nest Europe to provide more food for aid.

THE TRILATERAL'S SUGGESTION

The Roman Forum is flanked by the so-called Transnational Institute, fielded for the occasion by the CIN-funded Institute for Policy Studies based in Mashington, D.C. They too propose a "radical solution: technology doesn't work in the Third Morld; farmers should get money with investment control centralized in an international body. In other words, those chosen third world sectors should put their life blood and labor power in hock to Chase Manhattan, farmer by farmer.

The worst travesty in the whole Roman arena is the left borderguard role played by the Italian Communist Party (PCI), whose newspaper, L'Unita has embraced the "radical" proposals of the countergangs -- workers in the advanced sector must sacrifice "democratically" for the starving third world. Citing arch-cannibal and known CIA agent Rene Dumont, L'Unita attributes the problem to "the cannibalism of the 'center' in regard to the 'periphery'." Once again, the PCI has fallen lock, stock and barrel for the CIA line fashioned to set up "greedy" industrial workers throughout the advanced sector for the chopping block along with their third world brothers.

SOVIETS BLAMED FOR SUGAR HOAX AS SHAH HOARDS

Nov. 6 (IPS)--The Rockefeller-engineered sugar shortage took a new twist this week as scare headlines in U.S. newspapers accused the Soviets of buying up scarce supplies. Like the recently contrived scandal over Soviet grain purchases, these stories are part of an ongoing effort to drum up an international "red scare" aimed at decapitating working class struggles. Meanwhile, the real hoarder-the CIA's Shah of Iran--goes undetected and gains a convenient cover story.

Iran, Kuwait, and other Rockefeller oil company Arab fronts are squatting on a three-year sugar supply they recently bought at record prices--at least two million tons of sugar. The Soviets' alleged purchase amounted only to 400,000 tons--or about one-quarter of what they usually import in a year! The Philippines, which supposedly sold the sugar to the USSR, denies that the sale was ever made!

Although no real shortage exists, world sugar prices more than quadrupled on the commodity exchanges this year. This transparent hoax represents a severe blow to working class families worldwide who traditionally turn to sugar as a substitute for more expensive protein-rich foods during depression periods. British workers, who sustain themselves through a day of back-breaking speedup by pausing for an afternoon cup of liquid sugar (tea), were the first to feel the pinch this year.

The panic now is spreading to Western Europe and the United States. On Nov. 5, San Francisco workers were greeted by headlines in the local yellow press, the <u>San Francisco Examiner</u>: "Soviets Drop Sugar Bomb." Later that day, sugar was reported to have disappeared from area stores.

Phony Shortage

The phoniness of the "shortage" is obvious given that world sugar production will increase this year. Despite recent flood damage lowering Eastern Europe sugar beet production and the crop shortfalls in Western Europe attributed to weather and "virus yellows," these losses are more than offset by the rise in world sugar cane production. According to the West German analyst F.O. Licht's October figures, every major sugar cane producing country expects bumper crops. Licht estimates that world sugar cane production will increase 5.4 per cent over last year's crop. Given the destruction of working class incomes in the last year, consumption is bound to collapse: Only substantial hoarding and speculation could have produced the fourfold price rise!

Despite the high prices, U.S. and Western European sugar growers have not benefitted significantly. Most U.S. sugar cane producers contracted their crop at \$14 a ton last winter, so they will not receive any payment at the current world price--now \$51 a ton on the New York exchange. Domestic sugar beet farmers have suffered large

losses each year since 1971, and many are trying their luck at other crops. The U.S. Sugar Act, which previously set quotas and protected domestic farm prices, has been allowed to expire by Congress as of the end of this year. Sugar growers have protested that when the Sugar Act expires they will be edged out of the market by foreign sugar cane producers controlled by multinational cartels.

Cuba Covers for Rocky

In still another development, Castro's Cuba is prostituting itself by lending support to the formation of an OPEC-style Latin American sugar producers' bloc proposed by the governments of Mexico and Argentina. In so doing, Cuba has offered an "anti-imperialist" cover to the Rockefeller multinationals' direct attack on workers' consumption.

Meanwhile, traditional U.S. suppliers Philippines and Brazil ar playing coy and withholding supplies from the U.S. The press is speculating about a Cuban-U.S. "rapprochment," which would lead to Cuba's partial replacement of the Philippines in the U.S. market. Philippines President and mass murderer Marcos took advantage of the dropping of U.S. quotas to adopt a "progressive, independent" stance Marcos sent his wife to negotiate a trade deal with the Peoples' Republic of China to buy crude oil in exchange for Philippines' sugar and other raw materials. Thus Marcos will attempt to sucker the Chinese into a Rockefeller-controlled South Asian "self-sufficiency" zone based on slave labor.

THERE IS NO DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

Nov. 6 (IPS)--Two U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) spokesmen told IPS yesterday that there are no policy differences between Rockefeller, the State Department, and USDA over food banks and stockpiling. USDA Assistant Secretary for International Affairs Clayton Yautter expressed great dismay over UPI and AP press reports of a split between the State and Agriculture Departments. "Let me make it clear that there is no difference between our policies," Yautter stated, "none whatever. I say this without equivocation. For some reason, people are trying to make out a difference."

Yautter's colleague in the USDA, Assistant Administrator for International Trade Gordon Fraser, echoed Yautter's claim that the State Department already has swallowed the USDA. Referencing Secretary of State Kissinger's statement to the Rome Food Conference yesterday, Fraser said: "We are for an internationally coordinated system of nationally held food reserves. There are no differences; there are no differences."

The hysterical reaction of these two officials follows the hast retreat made by Secretary of Agriculture Butz since he has come unde intense pressure from the State Department. Butz was forced to modify his nominal "pro-farmer" position on expanding food productior and to come out for international stockpiling of food. In exchange for being allowed to head--in name only--the U.S. delegation to the Rome Food Conference, Butz has bartered away any semblance of a food policy independent of Rockefeller's plans for systematic, strategic starvation of the world's working class.

ROCKEFELLER AGENTS AT ROME WORLD FOOD CONFERENCE ORDER POLICE ATTACK ON LABOR COMMITTEE; WOODCOCK IN U.S. CALLS FOR FOOD EMBARGO ON EUROPE

Nov. 5 (IPS)--Twelve members of the International Caucus of Labor Committees (ICLC) and reporters for the International Press Service (IPS) at the United Nations World Food Conference in Rome were crimi nally assaulted today by Italian police of the 113th Riot Unit. Unconfirmed reports indicate that today's attack was coordinated by a liaison between conference organizers and the police. Extraordinary circumstances surrounding the attack include the inability of police who led today's attack to explain the motivation for their orders and the fact that there is no prior history of police attacks against Italian ICLC organizers. These circumstances strongly imply that the plans for today's attack were out of the hands of the police responsible for its implementation.

The Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO) World Food Conference convened in Rome today is organized for Rockefeller by World Bank head Robert McNamara, World Food Bank advocate John A. Hannah, U.S. Secretary of State Henry Kissinger, leading Club of Rome cannibalism advocate Aurelio Peccei, and FAO head Boerma.

Woodcock Gives It Away

The real purpose of the conference was revealed in a speech last night by Rockefeller co-conspirator and Trilateral Commission head of the UAW Leonard Woodcock when he addressed an international audience at Chicago's Temple Shalom on the possibilities of nuclear warfare in the Middle East and an Arab oil embargo by stating: "Food is a weapon this country can use...to make sure that Europe does not go its own way...There is evidence of a gathering storm on the horizon, and with the oil embargo, there is the potential for world cataclysm."

When U.S. Labor Party candidate for Mayor of Chicago Ed Waffle spoke at the meeting to expose Woodcock as an "expert on fascism setting up nuclear war in the Middle East," Woodcock responded, "They call themselves the U.S. Labor Party, NCLC, and NUWRO [North America Unemployed and Welfare Rights Organization]. They have this slick newspaper they publish in three languages. I don't know where they get their money...probably Moscow."

ICLC Literature Kept Out

The unique impact of Labor Committee organizing which evoked Noodcock's hysterical response last night is the spectre haunting Rockefeller's agents in Rome. ICLC members and IPS representatives in Rome were attacked immediately after they arrived at the conference and began distributing a leaflet, "Cannibals Organize Morld Food Conference Farce." Police confiscated copies of the leaflet and <u>Huova Solidarieta</u>, Italian language edition of <u>Hew Solidarity</u>, the international newspaper of the ICLC and National Caucus of Labor Committees published in six languages, and they violently beat ICLC organizers and forced them into police cars to be taken to police headquarters.

The ICLC literature identified Rockefeller's Morld Food Conference flunkys organizing for the Second Great Oil Hoax and mass starvation and called on the Soviet Union and workers' states to upset Rockefeller's plans for involving the socialist bloc and underdeveloped countries as his left cover for mass starvation.

BUTZ CAPITULATES TO ROCKEFELLER'S FOOD CONTROL

Nov. 4 (IPS)--At a Brussels press conference yesterday, U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Earl Butz reportedly capitulated to State Department demands concerning his role at the United Nations Morld Food Conference. Butz, who officially heads the U.S. delegation, called for the establishment of a new "world food agency" along the same lines proposed by the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO). The Rockefeller Foundation-authored FAO proposal would establish a supranational agency allowing the Rockefeller cabal fingertip control over world food supplies.

Butz' cave-in followed a week of lengthy State Department "consultations" with Agriculture officials, who have been terrorized by rumors of a major "reorganization" by the Ford Administration in which the USDA and other recalcitrant holdovers from the Nixon era will be purged.

The original USDA position paper on the food conference, which was blacked out by most of the national press, actually denies the existence of any "Malthusian crisis" and points out the potential for increasing world food output. The Rockefellers have counted on press created hysteria over "unavoidable" food shortages as the justification for setting up the fascist food control apparatus. Butz' ability to expose the Zero Growth quackery of Lester Brown and other new Malthusians threatened to blow Rockefeller's whole game.

While briefing Agriculture Department officials on Rockefeller's plans for the world food conference last week, the U.S. Labor Party discovered widespread disgruntlement among bureaucratic layers over Helson Rockefeller's scizure of the government. As a result, the Labor Party's Mashington, D.C., branch has targeted the USDA along with several Congressmen for an extended organizing campaign.

FORRESTER'S MAZI "SCIENCE" SPREADS THROUGH ACADEMIA

Nov. 4 (IPS)--Last month, HIT professor and author of Limits to Growth Jay Forrester received a medal from the Franklin Institute for his advocacy of "food triage"--the selective withholding of food as a means of eliminating "unwanted" population growth. Forrester recommended the limiting of agricultural production as well as halting exports in order to accomplish his genocidal goal. Since the Franklin Institute conference, other self-styled "scientists" and academics--their morality long ago destroyed by Rockefeller control of university funding and jobs--have joined the campaign to make mas starvation "acceptable."

Dr. Philip Handler, president of the Hational Academy of Scienc has released a statement arguing that since population growth has outstripped food production, the developed nations may have to "forget" South Asia. "Cruel as it may sound," Dr. Handler said, "if the developed nations do not intend the colossal all-out effort commensurate with this task, then it may be wiser to let nature take its course as Aristotle described it: 'From time to time it is necessar that pestilence, famine, and war prune the luxuriant growth of the human race'."

Handler nevertheless concludes on a "humanitarian" note, stating that developed countries are to avert the "economic disasters, resentments, and terrorism" stemming from Third World starvation by diverting immense amounts of capital to the poorer countries for "development" purposes. This will require, he said, that they cut down drastically on their own per capita (i.e., working class) income.

What Handler, Forrester, and the other Mazi doctors systematically ignore in their "doom and gloom" projections of limited resources is the availability of nuclear fusion power technology--a nearly infinite, non-polluting energy source which can be harnessed for industrial and agricultural expansion. The professors' "oversight" is not mercly accidental, but betrays their ultimate subservience to the Rockefeller oil interests which for years have sabotaged the development of fusion power through their control of the Atomic Energy Commission.

LABOR PARTY EXPOSES ANTI-COOP MOVE

Nov. 3 (IPS)--Ray Martino, the U.S. Labor Party candidate for New York State Attorney General, released a statement decrying the "socalled anti-trust measures of the U.S. Justice Department."

Martino said, "Under the cover of fighting inflation, U.S. Treasury Secretary Simon and Attorney General Saxbe have launched an 'anti-trust' offensive actually aimed at destroying farmer-owned cooperatives. The 'Watergating' and jailing of two leaders of the

largest dairy coop, Associated Milk Producers, Inc., was a warning shot fired for every political farmer and farm organization. Although thousands of U.S. dairy farmers go bankrupt and leave production each month, they don't put up any real fight.

"Actually, most farmers haven't the slightest notion of how to fight this assault and they will continue to go down to defeat as long as they organize simply around higher prices. The 'farmers' crisis' is not really just a farm problem. It is an intennational attack on workers' food supplies launched by the Rockefeller family through the squeeze on farm credit and an energy hoax which tripled fertilizer and fuel prices. Farmers who want to fight this international enemy--Rockefeller--have only one choice: Join the U.S. Labor Party's farmer-worker alliance."

SCHLESINGER DISCUSSES LIMITED NUCLEAR WAR IN WEST GERMANY

Nov. 5 (IPS)--In reference to present negotiations between U.S. Secretary of Defense James Schlesinger and West German Chancellor Helmu Schmidt and his Defense Minister Georg Leber, a highly placed West German military official today told IPS that the governments of the United States and West Germany presently are preparing to violate in ternational armaments limitation agreements signed in Paris in 1955. The official said: "You know Germany has nuclear delivery means capable of firing nuclear weapons....Yes, they are short- and mediumrange."

Furthermore, the official revealed that the Schmidt government is prepared to see Western Europe destroyed in tactical nuclear warfare. This type of limited nuclear warfare is what Schlesinger has been pushing as a "conceptual breakthrough" for the Soviet Union since January. "Schlesinger is the most sensible man on the issues, the official said. He understands that "limited nuclear warfare may well be fought out on West German soil--but that is better than blow ing up the whole world."

CANADA'S TRILATERAL LABOR REPRESENTATIVE

Nov. 5 (IPS)--In an exclusive interview with IPS, Research Director for the Canadian Labour Congress Russell Bell proudly volunteered th information that he is a member of the Trilateral Commission--the implementing arm for Rockefeller cabal policy. Bell bragged that he was chosen because of "contributions" he personally could make for the Rockefeller cabal. These included, at the last Trilateral Commission meeting, helping to set up a Trilateral group to brief Parliament.

When IPS asked Bell if there was a conflict of interest between his membership on the Trilateral Commission and his position on the Central Labour Congress, he reacted with amazement: "We have all kinds of committees where labor and management sit together to solve various economic problems. This has been going on for years. We have the British-North America Committee and the Canadian-America Committee."

Both committees are Rockefeller think-tanks, with representatives from Rockefeller-controlled companies and banks such as Chase Manhattan and First National City. The Canadian-American Committee, which boasts Trilateral Commission member I. W. Abel as its "labor" representative, produced a report on agriculture in 1970 which said Third World countries were doomed because it was "no longer profitable" for the developed countries to feed them.

Self-admittedly, Bell's job is to funnel the Trilateral line for implementation by the Labour Congress. His job, Bell said, is "...t make economic policy recommendations to chief officials here." Bell received his training at the government think-tank, the Economic Council, and he has had no connection to trade unionism. As he put it, "I never came up through the trade union ranks."

CANADIAN LABOUR FEDERATION CALLS FOR PARTICIPATION IN RECYCLING

TORONTO, Nov. 5 (IPS) -- The President of the Ontario Federation of Labour Dave Archer opened up the OFL's conference Oct. 28 with a call for increased labor participation on Canada's manpower boards. Modelled after the Nazi Labor Front, these boards would facilitate relocation of workers into forced work projects.

Archer's plea for union collaboration in the recycling of the Canadian workforce was accompanied throughout the convention by the attempt to chain the approaching working class ferment to the corpse of the agent-ridden New Democratic Party (NDP). Bored delegates lis tened while Toronto Labour Council treasurer William Barker complained that "I go into working class homes and I can't even get the to put an NDP sign on their front lawn." About one-half of the dele gates were reading the North American Labor Party declaration callin for immediate dismantling of the manpower boards and other Rockefeller agencies--like the National Emergency Planning Establishment, an alternative government apparatus for "emergencies."

The bureaucrats also maintained their torpor in the face of Labor Party exposure of industrial brainwashing operations in both the U.S. and Canada run by the United Auto Workers, the United Steelwork ers, and other unions. Stephen Lewis, Ontario-based NDP hack and so of national NDP head David Lewis, could only screech, "I'm a fascist I'm a fascist!" when approached by Labor Party representatives.

A similar suicidal performance is taking place this week at the British Columbia Federation of Labour meeting. The International Woodworkers Association, dominant force in the Federation, reported has written to the British Columbia manpower boards demanding consutation on the fate of laid off workers.

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN FISCAL CRISIS

Nov. 5 (IPS)--With the outbreak of a full-scale credit crisis, the Federal government has been thrown into a fiscal crisis. Brought of by the unprecedented contraction of banking liquidity coordinated by the Rockefeller-controlled Federal Reserve System and the top New York money center banks, this Federal fiscal crisis in turn has exac erbated the credit crisis. As a result of the rapid downturn in economic activity occurring over the past few months, tax receipts of the Federal government have begun to drop off sharply. While the latest statistics available through July 1974 reveal an inflow of Federal tax receipts in all categories above the levels of the previous year, there are indications that this trend has already been reversed.

Most of the tax receipts flowing into the Treasury Department through July were made possible by huge inventory profits, generated on the basis of price revaluation caused by the high rate of inflation. As a result of the decline in the rate of inventory accumulation and the rise in the rate of inventory liquidation--both provoked by the cutoff of credit to the corporate and consumer sectors--corporate profits (as well as the tax receipts based on them) already have begun to fall sharply.

The collapse of profits will be advanced further by the increasing shift of corporate inventory accounting methods from "last inlast out" to "first in-first out." This new method in effect reduces the price inflation of goods on inventory, and therefore it reduces the fictitious profits which the corporations can mark up. This accounting method alone threatens to discount corporate profits by approximately \$67 billion. This will mean a significantly lower flow of corporate tax receipts into Treasury coffers, thus by itself doubling the Administration's projected unified budget deficit of \$5 billion.

Signs of Federal government tax receipt shortfall have begun to surface. The Treasury announced Oct. 29 a massive amount of Treasury refinancing through Dec. 15. During this period, the Treasury will offer bonds and notes of over \$9 billion.

Further reflection of the cash-strapped plight of the Treasury has been its recent decision to draw down its deposits on account with the Federal Reserve System, which to date has over \$2 billion.

The effect of this financial solution to the Treasury's deficits will be a further drain of liquidity from the system, thus making it less available for the needs of industry, commerce, and agriculture, on which the continuation of real production depends. Obviously, this will further contract corporate profits and thus the flow of Federal taxes into the Treasury.

Thus Rockefeller's final solution to the ever-growing mountain of Federal deficits ultimately will take the form of massive taxation of the shrinking numbers of employed, productive workers to finance "employment" for the growing numbers of unemployed in slave labor development projects. These Rockefeller death camps will "solve" the problem of inflationary fiscal deficits.

MILITARY EXPERT SAYS ISRAELIS HAVE NUCLEAR WEAPONS

Nov. 5 (IPS)--New York Times military expert Drew Middleton today confirmed that the Israelis possess nuclear weapons. In a deliberately vague statement, Middleton conceded: "I guess they have them, though I couldn't prove it. I have never seen them and no Israeli has ever said they have them."

Middleton, who previously disputed the National Caucus of Labor Committees' analysis of Rockefeller's scenario for war in the Mideast, today during an IPS interview raised no objections. He outlined how the upcoming war would look: "It is a mistake to think any war will be like the last one. This war will be more widespread that the last, going well beyond the Sinai Desert and Golan Heights. You will probably see long-range missiles fired by both sides. A few such missiles, even with conventional warheads, could make a mess out of Tel Aviv." He suggested further that the Egyptians and Syrians will set up a naval blockade against Israel and said, "If you think any European country will run the blockade, you're more optimistic than I am."

Asked to comment on Rockefeller's role in the Mideast, Middleton, who was exposed as a CIA agent by the Soviet Union in 1952, claimed he was "not qualified to say anything on that."

TRILATERAL AGENT LEADS "GRASS ROOTS" DRIVE FOR SLAVE LABOR

Nov. 5 (IPS)--Leading liberals and labor fascists will hold a conference on Economic Priorities in Washington, D.C., Nov. 16. Called ostensibly for the creation of public employment jobs, the conference is organized primarily by the Democratic Study Group, a liberal Congressional caucus. This caucus is headed directly by Rep. John Culver (D.-Iowa), who is a member of the Trilateral Commission.

The conference on Economic Priorities itself merely represents a psywar assault on those still credulous enough to believe the bour geois press--in its publicization of a "grass roots" drive for the creation of slave-labor jobs for the masses of workers now being lai off.

STRAUSS READY TO FORM COALITION WITH SCHMIDT

UMW STRIKE: PRESS BUILDS TENSION AS UAW AGENT PREPARES STRIKE SUPPORT

Nov. 5 (IPS)--As the press builds the United Mineworkers (UMW) strik scheduled for next week as "unavoidable," IPS has established that a leading United Auto Workers (UAW) brainwash expert will be coordinat ing the critical UMM strike support activities.

In an interview last week with William Goode, former UAW education director and the man who guided the "education" of the UNW lead ership at the UAW Black Lake Center for behavior modification, Goode told IPS that he would be leaving for Washington this week to begin strike support preparations. Goode, currently the dean of the Empir State Labor College in New York, stated that he would be assisted by the Democratic Socialist Organizing Committee, a group of social fas cists currently involved in organizing support for Rockefeller's slave labor legislation, and by the Cornell School of Industrial Relations, a major Rockefeller-controlled think-tank.

Meanwhile, the CIA-controlled press is deliberately manipulating tensions within the working class around the issue of a coal strike showdown by issuing contradictory stories about whether the strike i off or on.

Leaking their intentions to keep all options open vis-a-vis the coal strike, the <u>New York Times</u> reported Oct. 27 that as a result of the "reform procedure" granting the right of full membership contrac ratification, both sides were sure that a final settlement would be delayed past the deadline, touching off a walkout. On the other hand, the <u>Times</u> says, such a course of action also suggests the possibility of the governments' use of the Taft-Hartley 90-day "cooling off" period, which could further delay action by the miners.

Several days later, the <u>New York Times</u> reported Nov. 1 that "tentative agreement" had been reached on noneconomic issues and tha there probably would be a settlement by the weekend. But the <u>Times</u> laid out one condition: If there is a walkout, the rank and file miners are to blame.

By Nov. 4, the entire CIA press, including the <u>Washington Post</u>, the <u>New York Times</u>, and the <u>Wall Street Journal</u>, were declaring that the strike is "inevitable" regardless of what both sides do at this point.

PCI LAUDS SMALL BUSINESSES AND THE "EDUCATION" THEY PROVIDE

MILAN, Nov. 5 (IPS)--At a press conference here yesterday marking the Opening of a meeting between the Italian Communist Party (PCI) and small and medium industrialists, CIA agent and PCI leader Giorgio Amendola stated that small and medium sized businesses are "indispensable" to the Italian economy. Along the same lines, the PCI's newspaper Unita stated yesterday that the small industries afford "a more professional training of workers which often cannot even be realized elsewhere, neither inside the school nor in the large industry."

The PCI's statement comes at precisely the same time that legislation has converted the Italian educational system into a "community as a school" maintaining that experience is more important than formal education. Under this local community control fascist setup, the Italian school population will inevitably be sent to factories for "education"--as Unita alludes--thus completely devastating the Italian working class through outright union-busting.

Today's <u>Corriere della Sera</u>, a major Italian daily, reports that the PCI representatives, led by Amendola, put forward specific proposals calling upon Italian banks to support small and medium businesses by relaxing credit "for the good of the Italian economy," while asking the trade unions to "understand the problems of small employers" and make "reasonable" contract demands. As justification for this latter proposal, <u>Corriere</u> reports, the PCI leaders have dredged up illusions to the 1950s, "a time when workers had dignity." At that time, the PCI leadership recommended that negotiations between small and large employers be handled separately, giving favored treatment to the small employers.

As an indication of how well agent Mendola is carrying out his subversion of the PCI, the coverage of the conference is identical in <u>Unita</u> and in <u>La Stampa</u>, owned by Rockefeller agent and industrialist Agnelli.

SCIENCE FICTION WRITER PUSHES FASCIST "SOLUTION"

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., Nov. 5 (IPS)--In a special briefing here today to mark UNESCO's publication of his Zero Growth children's book <u>Earth: Our Crowded Spaceship</u>, science fiction writer Isaac Asimov used his reputation as a liberal and an "expert" to prepare his audience to accept psychologically Rockefeller's fascist final solution. Talking non-stop with a prophecy of doom that included no viable solution to the problems of population, food, and ecology, Asimov terrified the bourgeois journalists at his press conference into momentary silence. Asimov stated that "personally" he thought the comfortable level of population which earth could support was one billion. The IPS UN correspondent asked Asimov how he proposed to eliminate the other three billion people from the earth, noting, as he had mentioned, that wars and disasters had not been effective in lowering the population growth rate since the 14th century's Black death.

Asimov stated bluntly that the only effective way of cutting the population down to one billion was by "raising the death rate." In this respect, he said, "thermonuclear war" and the kind of "mass famines" we will see in the future will raise the death rate more efficiently than the wars and famines of the past.

In pseudo-moral fashion, Asimov added that of course there is "only one humane way of lowering the population...by birth control... This may be impossible. If so we have catastrophe."

When <u>New Solidarity</u> science editor Chuck Stevens asked Asimov whether he favored the development of thermonuclear fusion power to provide the necessary energy to ensure the survival of the human race, Asimov hedged: "I favor the development of controlled fusion," he said, "along with solar energy...but even if fusion is shown scientifically feasible, the engineering problems involved in building a workable system may take 30 years. Earth must survive these 30 years." In addition, Asimov mentioned that the heat from fusion power was "liable to melt the polar icecap," thus submerging sealevel areas.

Stevens pressed Asimov again, citing the evidence from noted scientists that a fusion system is possible within this decade. Asimov became schizophrenic, stating that: "If you have people who are authorities in the field, I can scarcely argue with them....I can only say that somewhere inside me, I think they are wrong....No matter what we do, we are not going to have fusion before the year 2000."

Throughout his terrifying portrayal of a future of plagues, famine, nuclear holocaust, and ecological disaster, Asimov showed no sign of understanding actual humanity and man's creative capacity to use technology for solving problems. Asimov admitted he had no solutions: "If I really knew what the Rome [Food] Conference should do, he said, "I should be in Rome."

SENATOR FULBRIGHT DETAILS ROCKEFELLER'S FOURTH REICH

Nov. 4 (IPS)--In an "historic speech" Nov. 2, Rockefeller's major foreign policy planner Senator William Fulbright (D.-Ark.) laid out the complete scenario for Rockefeller's "new world realities." Thes "realities" include:

*War in the Middle East.

*A new oil boycott.

*Depression in the United States, Europe, and Japan.

*A possible "Armageddon"--war between the United States and the Soviet Union.

Indulging in a bit of deja vu, the <u>New York Times</u> informed its readers that Fulbright's speech took place in the same spot as anoth er equally historic policy statement. This speech, delivered by Winston Churchill at Westminster College in Fulton, Missouri in 1946 inaugurated the mythology of the Iron Curtain. This was the cabal's policy which destroyed the Communist influence in the labor unions throughout the Western world and put world finance in Rockefeller's back pocket.

Fulbright's speech lays out Rockefeller's plans for a Fourth Reich. War between the Arabs and Israel "will most certainly bring on a ruinous oil boycott," Fulbright said, and with this second Rock efeller-engineered war and boycott, a serious depression in the Unit ed States will ensue.

"But is democracy threatened?" asked Fulbright. If we were com munists or Marxists, he says, this scenario would most certainly see to indicate that democracy was down the drain. Not so, he stated, echoing Hjalmar Schacht and Benito Mussolini, "the cure for inflatio is to live less extravagantly...to go back to living more simply...w must prepare ourselves for even greater sacrifices in our standard o living than we made during World War Two."

In other words, Fulbright warned, get ready for fascism--with a democratic face.

Westminster College honored Senator Fulbright for his frank statement of Rockefeller policy with an honorary doctor of law degre --as they had honored Winston Churchill for instituting Red Scare diplomacy.

STRAUSS CALLS FOR EUROPEAN MATO AGAINST SOVIETS

Nov. 4 (IPS)--Franz-Josef Strauss, the Nazi chairman of the West German Christian Social Union based in Bavaria, explicitly endorsed the Trilateral Commission's military strategy for Europe yesterday in an interview with the French weekly magazine Le Point.

Strauss, whom Leonid Brezhnev branded a "revanchist"--one who wants to return to Nazism--during the recent visit of West German Chancellor Helmut Schmidt to Moscow, proposed that NATO be "subdivided into two distinct, independent sections--one American and the other European." According to Strauss, "even though the only power the Soviet Union respects is the U.S.A., Europe cannot continue to hang on the Americans' coattails." Instead, Strauss advocated the Trilateral Commission's policy to "Finlandize"--or neutralize--Western Europe, thus attempting to force the Soviet Union to accept a parallel "Finlandization" of Eastern Europe. This concept of "Finlandization" was laid out by CIA columnist C. L. Sulzberger in the New York Times today.

With Trilateral Commission policy coming from rabid anti-communist Strauss, the reality of the Barbarossa operation now underway against the Soviets is clear. In view of the distinct possibility of a Schmidt/Strauss coalition government in West Germany, the Soviets also must face the spectre of having to deal with Strauss himself in military matters.

VILLA SERBELLONI: ROCKEFELLER'S FULL-TIME SPOOK HOUSE

Nov. 4 (IPS)--The Villa Serbelloni, scene of the secret Trilateral Commission meeting three weeks ago, is apparently a full-time spook house. When covens of Rockefeller planners are not haunting the premises, CIA "Covert Operations" chief Henry Cord Meyer uses the secluded retreat in Bellagio, Italy to write studies of Nazi Germany.

Meyer, who made headlines in the beginning of 1974 when he was shipped to Britain to oversee the CIA's preparations for a military coup there, used a Villa Serbelloni dateline in the acknowledgements section of his book <u>The Long Generation: Germany's Road to Ruin</u>. The book, published in 1972 by Marper and Row, presents source material on the brainwashing of the German working class from 1914 to 1945, a process which Meyer and his masters are currently duplicating worldwide.

UAW PULLS LEADING GOONS FROM DETROIT PLANT FOR BRAINWASHING RETREAD

DETROIT, Nov. 4 (IPS)--Jesse Gregory, United Auto Workers local president and one-time chief goon against the U.S. Labor Party at the Ford Woodhaven Stamping plant here, has been pulled out of the plant and sent to the UAW's Black Lake Brainwashing Center for rewiring as a result of the Labor Party's counter-harassment campaign.

Gregory, who is known as "Joyboy" at his plant, along with the entire local UAW bureaucracy, was shipped off to Black Lake the day after angry workers at Woodhaven slammed him up against a wall and told him he was through harassing Labor Party organizers. UAW Presi dent Woodcock and his labor lieutenants, who monitor the success of Labor Party nationwide organizing at least daily, knew that Gregory no longer could be relied upon to keep workers in line and decided he needed a refresher course.

Last week Gregory showed up with 18 goons at a Labor Party campaign rally led by Labor Party candidate for Governor of Michigan Pete Signorelli. Four squads of police in riot gear mysteriously ar rived at the same moment and arrested Signorelli for breach of the peace as soon as he announced, "This is a Labor Party campaign rally.

Coming after a month-long Labor Party campaign against Gregory' thuggery, that incident precipitated a feverish in-plant debate on the Labor Party which climaxed when the workers put Gregory up against the wall. Immediately afterwards, active anti-Woodcock caucuses in the plant called Labor Party offices to say that they would work to get out the Labor Party vote on election day. The next day, as Gregory and his goons departed for Black Lake, a Woodhaven worker came to the Labor Party office to report that workers throughout the plant were discussing "The Party." He then invited Labor Party organizers into the plant to conduct a rally in the cafeteria.

Only a few weeks ago, Labor Party organizers were selling only four copies of <u>New Solidarity</u> per distribution at Woodhaven as a result of Gregory's harassment. The Labor Party launched its successful counterattack with a leaflet entitled "Corporativism in the Flesh," which exposed Joyboy's "profit-sharing" arrangement with the management for the favors of a young lady.

Enraged, Gregory went berserk and started rooting through plant garbage cans for copies of the leaflet in a futile effort to find ou who was distributing it inside the plant. Since then this pathetic macho has blundered from one psychotic outburst to the next, while the workers he once terrorized have begun to realize their capacity to fight Woodcock and Rockefeller.

Workers eager to master the principles behind the Labor Party's successful psychological warfare campaign are reportedly now circulating in the Woodhaven plant copies of "Beyond Psychoanalysis," Labor Party Chairman Lyn Marcus' groundbreaking essay on Marxian psychology.

SED HARDLINERS MOUNT COUNTEROFFENSIVE AGAINST POLYCENTRISM ADOPTED AT WARSAW

Nov. 4 (IPS)--Hardliners in the Politburo of East Germany's ruling Socialist Unity Party (SED) have initiated an active campaign against the suicidal "National Roads to Socialism" policy pushed through the recently concluded Warsaw meeting of European Communist Parties. The Gierek faction of Poland and the Italian faction, headed by CIA agent Giorgio Amendola, led the fight for this polycentrist policy in Warsaw.

The theme running through recent issues of the SED's newspaper <u>Neues</u> <u>Deutschland</u> also includes a warning to the Eastern Bloc against being hoodwinked by the psychological warfare "detente" pushed by Rockefeller agents. The international character of the "hard" faction, led by the Ponamarev-Suslov grouping in the USSR, is established by the somewhat milder attacks on the Warsaw meeting appearing in the Oct. 30 issue of <u>Pravda</u>.

In an open factional rebuff to the "detente all the way" posture adopted at Warsaw, the Oct. 24 lead commentary in <u>Neues Deutschland</u> states: "It would be a great illusion for communists to believe that ...because the correlation of forces has changed in favor of socialism and the revolutionary workers' movement, that the imperialist system and reactionary ideology could change." This commentary, reflecting the post-Warsaw deliberations of the SED Politburo, is buttressed by two other articles from Politburo members Horst Sindermanr and Albert Norden.

GDR premier Sindermann, after devoting lip service to peaceful coexistence, proceeds to put it into the context of "the attempt by world imperialism to plunge humanity into new wars." Then he blasts the Gierek-Amendola polycentrists: "We have, and so I stress, the Warsaw Pact as socialism's military coalition to protect our borders and the socialist states."

Norden's theme is the deepening crisis of capitalism, including a reminder of the danger of war and "humanity's annihilation."

The SED Politburo's lead commentary in <u>Neues</u> <u>Deutschland</u> Oct. 25, "On the European CP Conference," does not cover at all the propolycentrist parties who dominated the conference--the Polish, Italian, and Spanish Communist Parties. The following denunciation, however, is meant specifically for them: "We communists consider things in real terms, and know the obstacles imperialism's reactionary, aggressive forces put in the way...[only] by such recognition can the Communist Parties and workers' parties construct a new situation in Europe."

The SED Politburo then definitively announces that they, with Soviet allies, are spearheading a counteroffensive to reverse the Warsaw fiasco, noting that "things will be different" at the next European Communist Party conference, to be held in the East German

capital Berlin. <u>Neues Deutschland</u> states: "The coming conference will not confine itself to mere opinion exchanges. It will draw conclusions for common tasks and struggle, which stand before the European working class."

This commentary does not occur in isolation. Erich Mielke, candidate member of the Politburo and Minister for State Security, stated recently in a Politburo speech: "There are strong imperialist forces using detente to implement their political goals, through military and various other subversive means. The socialist states will do all required to parry imperialist attempts to bury or push back Socialism in individual [Bloc] countries."

1953 Again

The SED's vanguard role in the international Soviet Bloc factior now emerging is an eleventh hour bid to reverse the catastrophic results of the Warsaw meeting's de facto endorsement of Rockefeller's Trilateral Commission line--the dismantling of the Warsaw Pact and the workers' states in Eastern Europe. The SED leadership is well aware how the present situation of Bloc factional weakness, in the wake of the triumph scored by the capitulationists at Warsaw, parallels a similar situation seen only once before in postwar history-immediately following Stalin's death in 1953.

They know that if the Gierek-Amendola factions prevail, the Eastern European workers' states are negotiable. The SED "Old Guard" also recalls that now (as then, with Beria-Malenkov) the German Democratic Republic is the first bargaining chip.

PCI'S AMENDOLA PUSHES CIA LINE; ELC CAMPAIGNS TO EXPEL HIM

TURIN, Nov. 4 (IPS)--During a press conference here yesterday, Giorgio Amendola, top CIA strategist on the politburo of the Italian Communist Party (PCI), proposed extending the "self-reduction of public rates" movement (anarchist refusal to pay utility rate increases) to all of Italy. He also advocated "trust in the Army" to defend Italian freedom.

Amendola's statement on "self-reduction" flies directly in the face of the official party line against this form of militant selfdestruction of the workers' movement. This CIA-manufactured "selfreduction" was designed to pit industrial workers against the employees of public utilities and transport in a battle over shrinking funds. Amendola closed his speech with a limp appeal to Italian nationalism.

Such statements can only add to the anger of betrayed workers now being catalyzed by the European Labor Committees' (ELC) campaign to expel Amendola from the PCI.

At yesterday's press conference, PCI members first attempted half-heartedly to keep the ELC from distributing leaflets exposing agent Amendola's dirty tricks and demanding his expulsion. After reading the leaflets, the PCI harassers gave up their obstruction and left the conference. Another PCI cadre told ELC organizers today in Milan: "I know Amendola, and I know his politics. Believe me, expulsion would not be enough!"

UN REPORT: HOW RUMORS MAKE NEWS

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., Nov. 4 (IPS)--At a recent press briefing for UN correspondents, the press attache from the British Mission to the United Nations prefaced his daily briefing to newsmen by saying that his remarks that day were "not attributable."

When journalists pressed him to be more specific, he explained that his remarks were not to be attributed to him, to the mission, or even to "a British source." Instead, he requested that his "news" was to be reported simply as "British thinking" on the topic of the expulsion of South Africa from the UN.

The views which he wanted to percolate among the press corps and its readerships were to debunk any of the naive who still take UN proceedings at their face value. "A great deal happens privately which contrasts rather sharply with what is going on publicly," British thinking stated.

TOP CIA AGENTS LURE SOVIETS INTO BARBAROSSA TRAP

NEW YORK, N.Y., Nov. 4 (IPS)--C. L. Sulzberger, chief CIA conduit, has called for the dismembering of the Soviet bloc in Eastern Europe. The conclusion of Sulzberger's Nov. 3 <u>New York Times</u> column, entitle "Doing Unto Others As...", claims that Western Europe has been "Finlandized" by Moscow's detente policy, threatening the existence of NATO. Why, queries Sulzberger, can't "Washington do to the Soviet bloc internally what Moscow is already doing to the West?"

"Finlandization," referring to the neutrality of Russia's north ern neighbor, is a version of the line developed by such Rockefeller agents as Senator Walter Mondale and Zbigniew Brzezinski in Foreign Affairs, the magazine of the Rockefeller Council on Foreign Relation and at the Trilateral Commission meeting in Bellagio, Italy last month.

The "Bellagio line" calls for disengagement of Western Europe from the United States, in favor of a single European political enti ty including the Eastern bloc--on Rockefeller's terms. It is a lure

enticing the Soviet Union to bargain away even their allies' territory in return for the illusion of concessions from Rockefeller's European henchmen. The deals won in Moscow last week by West German Chancellor Helmut Schmidt and his accomplices, seemingly weighted to the Soviets' advantage, are a case in point.

Sulzberger's column makes devastatingly clear the actual significance of the Bellagio pan-European policy. In the light of this article, the recent remarks of Austrian Premier Bruno Kreisky concerning Central Europe (Mittleuropa) were a bold affront to the political and territorial integrity of the Soviet bloc. "Mittleuropa" traditionally has meant the area covered by Austria, Germany, and Soviet-allied workers states to the east: Hungary, Czechoslovakia, Poland, etc. Kreisky further said: "Only a concerted action of Europe will result in a constructive contribution to the reduction of tension in this section of the world....Detente demands liberalization."

West German Defense Minister Leber, with whom Kreisky conferred at the time of his remarks Oct. 23, has since added that the Soviet Union is dangerously increasing the power of the Warsaw Pact (Easter Europe) countries and thus endangering West Germany.

Deadly Game

In this climate of intense psychological warfare, reports have been circulated that the terrified Soviets made a major concession at the Vienna, Austria talks on troop reductions in Central Europe. The Russians had been adamant that these talks must deal with absolute reduction of all NATO and Warsaw Pact forces in the area, not just American and Soviet, because NATO forces contain a high proportion of Bundeswehr troops. These would be unaffected by a preliminary bilateral agreement, while the Soviets would have to remove their own divisions from East Germany, Czechoslovakia, and Hungary.

Now, according to stories in the <u>New York Times</u> and the <u>Finan-</u> <u>cial Times</u> (London), the Soviets may have backed down to the point of considering only U.S. and Soviet cuts. If this is true, it represents another big Soviet retreat in the face of the Rockefeller Operation Barbarossa now raging against them. As Moscow tolerates the class-collaborationist policies of the Western Communist Parties and the looting of Eastern Europe, they are giving up political ground--even geographical territory--to "buy time" against a major enemy offensive.
