ANTUNES ATTEMPTING TO ORGANIZE MUTINY

KISSINGER TO BE EXCOMMUNICATED?

AUG. 8 (IPS)—THE JEWISH DEFENSE LEAGUE, LED BY RABBI MEIR KA-HANE, AND TWO AFFILIATED "ACTIVIST" JEWISH GROUPS DECIDED SEVERAL DAYS AGO TO JOINTLY INSTITUTE PROCEEDINGS TO CONSIDER THE EXCOM-MUNICATION OF SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER, ACCORDING TO THE JEWISH WEEK-AMERICAN EXAMINER.

MEXICAN PRODUCERS CALL FOR CAPITAL INVESTMENT IN AGRICULTURE

AUG. 8 (IPS)—SPEAKING AUGUST 5 AT THE 27TH CONGRESS OF THE MEXICAN FEDERATION OF AGRICULTURE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE MEXICAN AGRICULTURE PRODUCERS' FEDERATION SAID THAT THE PROBLEM OF HUNGER CAN ONLY BE SOLVED THROUGH CAPITAL INTENSIVE DEVELOPMENT OF AGRICULTURE. MR. ALBERTO SALINAS RAMOS STATED THAT "THE TYPE OF AGRICULTURE BEING SOUGHT IS THAT WHICH DEMANDS GREATER INVESTMENTS IN MACHINERY, A JUST AND SAFE SYSTEM OF LAND HOLDINGS, INCREASED CREDITS, MORE FERTILIZERS AND PESTICIDES, MORE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH, MORE INFORMATION SERVICES AS WELL AS OTHER RELATED INSTALLATIONS."

THE SALINAS STATEMENT WAS REPORTED AUGUST 6 BY THE MEXICAN DAILY EXCELSIOR, WHICH EMPHASIZED REPORTS ON WIDESPREAD FAMINE THROUGHOUT SOME REGIONS OF THE COUNTRY.

AUG. 8 (IPS)—THE NEW YORK TIMES TODAY ACKNOWLEDGES THAT FUSION IS "CHEAP AND SAFE ENERGY....A FAR MORE DESIRABLE AND SAFER CONCEPT IN ATOMIC TECHNOLOGY....(WHICH) CAN LEAPFROG OVER THE TRANSITORY BREEDER PHASE INTO WHAT CAN BECOME AN ULTIMATE SOLUTION TO MAN'S ENERGY NEEDS."

CHICAGO TRIBUNE WARNS WORKERS MAY GO SOCIALIST

AUG. 8 (IPS)—IN A FRONT-PAGE ARTICLE WHICH REPORTS ON "DOZENS OF RANDOM INTERVIEWS IN TWO WHITE AMERICAN WORKING CLASS NEIGHBOR-HOODS." YESTERDAY'S CHICAGO TRIBUNE WARNS THAT THE DETERIORATING ECONOMIC SITUATION MAY PROPEL WORKERS TOWARD "THIRD PARTIES." SUCH AS THAT OF GEORGE WALLACE OR OF "THE SOCIALISTS."

THE TRIBUNE REPORTED THAT A WORKER FROM THE DETROIT SUBURB OF WARREN COMMENTED. "I MAY JUST GO THIRD PARTY. I'M ABOUT READY." WHEN ASKED WHICH THIRD PARTY, HE REPLIED. "SOCIALIST. I THINK THEY MAY HAVE SOMETHING."

FORD WON'T CAMPAIGN WITH ROCKY

AUG. 8 (IPS)—PRESIDENT FORD SAID IN A TELEVISION INTERVIEW YESTERDAY THAT REPORTS THAT HE PLANNED TO DUMP NELSON ROCKEFELLER FROM HIS TICKET NEXT YEAR WERE A "TEMPEST IN A TEAPOT." FORD SAID THAT MR. ROCKEFELLER "WORKS HARD. HE IS COOPERATIVE. HE HAS TAKEN EVERY JOB I HAVE GIVEN HIM." FORD EMPHASIZED, HOWEVER. THAT GIVEN CURRENT POLITICAL REALITIES HE AND ROCKEFELLER WOULD NOT CAMPAIGN FOR THE NOMINATION TOGETHER.

INFLATION HITS AGAIN: RENEWED COMMODITY SPECULATION

AUG. 8 (IPS)—THE WHOLESALE PRICE INDEX IN JULY ROSE BY 1.2 PER CENT, INDICATING AN ANNUAL RATE OF PRICE INFLATION OF MORE THAN 14 PER CENT, ACCORDING TO FIGURES RELEASED YESTERDAY BY THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR. ATTRIBUTED LARGELY TO FOOD AND FUEL PRICE HIKES, THE JULY RISE DOES NOT REFLECT EITHER THE RECENT OIL PRICE DECONTROL OR THE RECENTLY ANNOUNCED PRICE RISES FOR STEEL AND OTHER BASIC INDUSTRIAL MATERIALS.

WHILE THE RISE IN AGRICULTURAL PRICES IS WIDELY ATRIBUTED TO THE SOVIET GRAIN PURCHASES. IT IS NOTEWORTHY THAT ANOTHER ROUND OF SHEER SPECULATION IN THE COMMODITY FUTURES MARKETS HAS BEGUN. A ROUND OF SPECULATION WHICH ALREADY TOPS THE DISASTROUS SPECULATIVE BINGES OF 1972 AND 1973 BY AS MUCH AS 15 PER CENT. ACCORDING TO TODAY'S WALL STREET JOURNAL.

POUND CONTINUES SEVERE SLIDE; BANK OF ENGLAND NOT INTERVENING

AUG. 8 (IPS)—THE POUND CONTINUED ITS DECLINE ON THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE MARKETS, ENDING THE DAY IN LONDON AT \$2.1035 AFTER TOUCH-ING A LOW OF \$2.0985 YESTERDAY.

THIS REPRESENTS A DEVALUATION OF ABOUT 29 PER CENT OF THE POUND'S VALUE SINCE THE PREVAILING CURRENCY PARITIES WERE ESTABLISHED IN DECEMBER 1971. JUST ONE WEEK AGO, THE POUND WAS AT \$2.1490.

THE BANK OF ENGLAND HAS SO FAR BEEN UNWILLING TO SUPPORT ITS OWN CURRENCY DURING THE LAST WEEK'S ROUND OF SEVERE ATTACKS. ACCORDING TO THE FINANCIAL PRESS. THE BANK HAS ONLY ABOUT \$6 BILLION IN DOLLAR RESERVES. HAVING SPENT \$1 BILLION DEFENDING THE POUND IN THE LAST SIX MONTHS ALONE.

SAUDIS PULL OUT OF DEAL WITH WEST GERMANS

AUG. 8 (IPS)—AT THE CONCLUSION OF ECONOMIC TALKS IN WEST GER-MANY, SAUDI ARABIAN OFFICIALS HAVE CALLED OFF TRILATERAL DEVELOP-MENT PROJECTS INVOLVING BONN, THE SAUDIS, AND SUDAN, "TO WEST GERMAN SURPRISE AND DISAPPOINTMENT," YESTERDAY'S FINANCIAL TIMES OF LONDON REPORTS.

"THE SAUDIS APPEAR TO HAVE COME TO THE CONCLUSION," THE TIMES REMARKS, "THAT SUCH PARTICIPATION WOULD MEAN TOO GREAT A STRAIN ON THEIR RESOURCES AS THEY EMBARK ON THEIR HIGHLY AMBITIOUS NEW FIVE-YEAR DEVELOPMENT PLAN."

WEST GERMAN-POLISH DEAL "NEW BREAKTHROUGH"

BONN, AUG. 8 (IPS)—THE WEST GERMAN ECONOMICS MINISTRY DESCRIBED THEIR COUNTRY'S RECENTLY CONCLUDED ECONOMIC TREATY WITH POLAND AS A "NEW BREAKTHROUGH" IN ECONOMIC RELATIONS BETWEEN BOTH COUNTRIES. IF ALL THE MINISTRY'S EXPECTATIONS ARE FULFILLED, "ECONOMIC RELATIONS BETWEEN BONN AND WARSAW WILL BECOME A SPECIAL DYNAMIC ELEMENT IN RELATIONS BETWEEN EUROPE'S DIFFERENT ECONOMIC SYSTEMS."

U.S. TO VETO VIETNAM ENTRY TO UN

UNITED NATIONS, AUG. 8 (IPS)—A JOINT STATEMENT WAS RELEASED YESTERDAY BY THE PERMANENT OBSERVER MISSIONS OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH VIETNAM AND THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM (DRV) INDICATING THAT THE TWO NATIONS ARE "EAGER TO ESTABLISH NORMAL RELATIONS WITH THE UNITED STATES, BASED ON THE PARIS PEACE ACCORDS, AND FRIENDLY RELATIONS BETWEEN THE PEOPLES OF THE COUNTRIES." HOWEVER, "IF THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT IS INTENT ON FOLLOWING ITS HOSTILE POLICY TOWARD THE PEOPLES OF VIETNAM, THE U.S. IS FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS ACTIONS."

THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED WEDNESDAY NIGHT THAT THE U.S. WOULD USE ITS VETO POWER IN THE UNITED NATIONS TO BLOCK THE ADMISSION OF SOUTH VIETNAM AND THE DRV INTO THE UN, UNLESS THE ADMISSION OF SOUTH KOREA WERE ALSO APPROVED.

U.S. DEFOLIANTS CAUSE LIVER CANCER IN VIETNAM

UNITED NATIONS, AUG. 8 (IPS)—VIETNAM IS NOW SUFFERING FROM AN ABNORMALLY HIGH INCIDENCE OF LIVER CANCER THAT IS REPORTEDLY LINKED TO CONTINUED EFFECTS OF THE 100 MILLION POUNDS OF CHEMICAL DEFOLIANTS SPREAD OVER BOTH NORTH AND SOUTH VIETNAM DURING THE WAR BY THE UNITED STATES. ARTHUR GALSTON, A PLANT PHYSIOLOGIST JUST RETURNED FROM A MONTH-LONG VISIT TO NORTH VIETNAM, REPORTED THE PROBABLE LINK YESTERDAY AT A PRESS CONFERENCE AT THE UNITED NATIONS. GALSTON REVEALED THAT THE INCIDENCE OF LIVER CANCER IN NORTH VIETNAM IS SIX TIMES HIGHER THAN BEFORE THE WAR.

CRAZED PL'ERS STILL LOOSE IN DETROIT

DETROIT, AUG. 8 (IPS)—YESTERDAY, ONE HOUR AFTER HIS DETROIT COURT HEARING FOR A PREVIOUS ASSAULT AGAINST LABOR PARTY ORGANIZERS, PROGRESSIVE LABOR PARTY (PLP) MEMBER WILLIAM GILBRAITH LED ANOTHER ATTACK ON A LABOR COMMITTEE MEMBER—THIS TIME IN FRONT OF THE DETROIT GREENFIELD UNEMPLOYMENT CENTER. GILBRAITH AND A BLACK MALE ACCOMPLICE KNOCKED ORGANIZER HANK COONEY TO THE GROUND, RIPPED HIS SHIRT OFF, AND FLED INTO THE CENTER WITH COONEY'S WALLET AND \$70.

POLICE FROM THE 16TH PRECINCT BRIEFLY QUESTIONED THE TWO AS-SAILANTS BUT LET THEM GO, CLAIMING THAT IT WAS NOT IN THEIR JUR-ISDICTION. CHARGES OF ASSAULT AND ROBBERY HAVE BEEN FILED WITH THE 12TH POLICE PRECINCT. GILBRAITH IS ALSO OUT ON BAIL FOR AS-SAULT CHARGES STEMMING FROM A SIMILAR HIGHLAND PARK, MICHIGAN AT-TACK.

PA. COURT STRIKES DOWN RESTRICTIVE PETITIONING REQUIREMENTS FOR 3RD PARTIES

PHILADELPHIA, AUG. 8 (IPS)—A THREE-JUDGE PANEL IN THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF PENNSYLVANIA COURT HAS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED PENNSYLVANIA OFFICIALS FROM ENFORCING RESTRICTIVE ELECTORAL PETITIONING REQUIREMENTS AGAINST THE LABOR PARTY IN PENNSYLVANIA. THE RULING, IN FAVOR OF THE LABOR PARTY IN THE CASE OF SALERA AND THE U.S. LABOR PARTY VS. C. DOLORES TUCKER, STRIKES DOWN PETITIONING REQUIREMENTS ORIGINALLY INTENDED TO KEEP COMMUNISTS OUT OF THE ELECTORAL PROCESS.

PENNSYLVANIA'S PETITIONING REQUIREMENTS WERE THE LATEST ATTEMPTS IN A CAMPAIGN WHICH HAS LASTED 35 YEARS TO DISCOURAGE COMMUNISTS AND OTHER THIRD PARTIES FROM ENTERING ELECTIONS. IN THE 1940'S COMMUNIST PARTY ELECTORAL WORKERS WERE ROUNDED UP AND ARRESTED FOR A SUPPOSED "ELECTORAL FRAUD" VIOLATION UNDER THE LAWS THEN OPERATING IN THAT STATE.

IF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORITIES APPEAL THE SALERA DECISION, THE CASE WILL MOVE DIRECTLY TO THE SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES.
