PRIORITIES

BRITISH STEEL STRIKE ENDS; CAUSED NO PAMIC

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- FOUR THOUSAND CRITISH BLAST FURNACE WORKERS WHO HAD WALKED OUT OM STRIKE FIVE DAYS AGO ARE RETURNING TO WORK PEND-ING A PUBLIC INQUIRY INTO THE UNION'S GRIEVANCES, THE BRITISH BROADCASTING SYSTEM REPORTS TORIGHT.

AN IPS SURVEY OF ARAB FIMANCIAL SPOKESMEN AND NEW YORK BANKS YESTERDAY SHOWED THAT NO PARICKY FLIGHT OF DOLLARS FROM LONDON TO NEW YORK HAD OR WAS LIKELY TO OCCUR. THIS WAS THE INTENDED PURPOSE OF THE STRIKE PROVOCATION BY THE "ATLANTICIST" AGENTS IN THE GOVERNMENT OF BRITAIN.

CDU ECONOMIC COUNCIL CONSIDERS TRANSFER RUBLE AND DEST MORATORIUM

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- HIGHLY PLACED SOURCES INSIDE THE MEST GERMAN OP-POSITION PARTY, THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION, REVEALED TO IPS TODAY THAT THE CDU'S ECONOMIC COUNCIL MET YESFERDAY TO CONSIDER A NEW CRE-DIT SYSTEM INCLUDING DEST MORATORIA AND THE EURO-RUBLE.

OTHER SOURCES REVEALED THAT THE CDU IS ALSO SENDING A DELEGATION TO THE UNITED STATES TO GAUGE THE STRENGTH OF OPPOSITION TO ROCKE-FELLER, REGARDED BY WEST GERMAN PRO-DEVELOPMENT FORCES AS VACILLATING. ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE ECONOMIC COUNCIL, WHO IS ALSO A FORMER HEAD OF THE GERMAN GENERAL ESLECTRIC CO., JAN EILERS, HAS JUST RETURNED FROM A TRIP TO THE SOVIET UNION. THERE, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S DIE WELT, EILERS FOUND "A STRONG INTEREST IN LONG TERM BUSINESS" BY SOVIET OFFICIALS.

BLACK DEATH SPREADS IN BRAZIL

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- OHE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-FIVE NEW CASES OF BUBONIC PLAGUE HAVE BROKEN OUT IN NORTHEAST BRAZIL SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THIS MONTH. THE NEW SURGE OF THE DISEASE THREATENS 7 MILLION PEOPLE AND LIVE IN THE AREA. THE PLAGUE IS CAPRIED BY A RAT POPULATION THREE TIME LARGER THAN THE MUMAN POPULATION, ACCORDING TO THE INFLUENTIAL DAILY, O ESTADO DE SAO PAULO. THE BLACK DEATH HAS SPREAD HORTH OUTSIDE ITS ORIGINAL ENDEMIC AREA IN THE STATES OF PERNAMBUCO AND CEARA TO THE STATE OF PIAUL WHERE IT HAS ALREADY KILLED TWENTY PEOPLE. IN A DESPERATE EFFORT TO CONTAIN THE RAPIDLY GROWING PLAGUE EPIDEMIC, BRAZILIAN HEALTH AUTHORITIES ARE TRYING TO SEND VACCINE AND OTHER REDICIBE INTO THE AREA.

RIGHT-WING PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT WILL FACE HEAVY WORKING-CLASS PRESSURE

SEPT: 19 (IPS) — THE COMPOSITION OF THE NEW PORTUGUESE CABINET OF PREMIER-DESIGNATE AZEVEDO WILL BE PROPORTIONAL TO THE PARTY RESULTS ATTAINED IN LAST APRIL'S CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS, STIMME DER DDR, THE EAST GERMAN RADIO, REPORTS. THE SOCIALIST PARTY WILL RECEIVE FOUR MINISTERIAL POSTS IN THE SOON TO BE ANNOUNCED CABINET, WHILE THE POPULAR DEMOCRATS WILL RECEIVE TWO AND THE COMMUNISTS ONE. RIGHT-WING MILITARY OFFICER, MAJOR MELO ANTUNES, IS SLATED TO BECOME THE NEW FOREIGN MINISTER.

CARVALHO AND COUTINHO IN SWEDEN NEXT MONDAY TO TALK WITH PALME

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- PORTUGUESE MADIST GENERAL OTELO SARAIVA DE CAR-VALHO AND REAR-ADMIRAL ROSA COUTINHO, CHARACTERIZED AS "RED ROSA" BY THE WESTERN CIA PRESS, WILL GO TO SWEDEN NEXT MONDAY AT THE INVITATION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THAT COUNTRY. THEY WILL BE RE-CEIVED BY SWEDISH PRIME MINISTER OLOF PALME AND BY INTERNATIONAL AS-SISTANCE MINSTER GERTRUD SIGURDSEN. THE VISIT ITINERARY INCLUDES MEETINGS WITH WORKERS SINDICAL CENTRAL LEADERS AND VISITS TO IN-DUSTRIAL PLANTS IN THE STOCKHOLM AREA. THE INFORMATION WAS CARRIED BY YESTERDAY'S LISBON DAILY DIARIO DE NOTICIAS.

USLP TO TESTIFY BEFORE GRAND JURY ON TRENTON WATER SABOTAGE

TRENTON, SEPT. 18 (IPS) -- USLP RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT EXPERT ERIC LERNER TESTIFIED BEFORE THE TRENTON CITY COUNCIL LAST NIGHT, EXPOSING THE SABOTAGE OF THE CITY WATER SUPPLY BY THE LEAA AND RELATED AGENCIES. FOLLOWING THE USLP TESTIMONY, COUNCILMAN JAMES MITCHELL REQUESTED THAT LERNER REPEAT HIS TESTIMONY BEFORE THE GRAND JURY EMPANELLED BY MAYOR HOLLAND TO INVESTIGATE THE HIGHLY SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT. THE TRENTON TIMES CONDUCTED AN INTERVIEW WITH LERNER TO BE PUBLISHED TOMORROW.

TODAY'S EDITION OF THE TIMES CONTAINS PROMINENT COVERAGE OF THE ILLEGAL ARREST OF USLP CANDIDATE FOR MAYOR ELLIOT GREENSPAN AND THREE OTHER ORGANIZERS WHO WERE HELD ON \$250 BAIL FOR "OBSTRUCT-ING TRAFFIC." THE TIMES SAYS THE ARRESTS WERE INTENDED TO PREVENT GREENSPAN FROM TESTIFYING BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL.

DEM LIBERALS COALESCE AROUND MURPHY COMMISSION CIA "REFORMS"

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- SEVERAL WELL-PLACED SOURCES CONFIRMED TODAY THAT LIBERAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY LAYERS ARE COALESCING AROUND NELSON ROCKE-FELLER'S MURPHY COMMISSION "REFORMS" OF THE CIA, WHICH ARE PRIMARILY AIMED AT USING ECONOMIC WARFARE MEASURES MORE EFFECTIVELY AS A TOOL OF THE ROCKEFELLER BROTHERS' POLITICAL AMBITIONS.

A SPOKESMAN FOR PRESIDENTIAL HOPEFUL SARGENT SHRIVER SALD TO-DAY THAT HE EXPECTED THE CHURCH COMMITTEE INVESTIGATING THE CIA TO DEVELOP A SET OF PROPOSALS ALONG THESE LINES WHICH "MR. SHRIVER AND OTHER DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL CADIDATES COULD ACT ON." AN AIDE TO SENATOR STUART SYMINGTON (D-MO) VOLUNTEERED TO A LONG ISLAND JOURNALIST THAT THE SENATOR MAD JUST THE OTHER DAY INTRO-DUCED A BILL WHICH WOULD MAKE THE TREASURY SECRETARY A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL. AFTER CLAIMING THAT THE IDEA HAD "SPONTANEOUSLY" OCCUPRED TO THE SENATOR. THE EMBARRASSED AIDE ADMITTED THAT SYMINGTON HAD STUMBLED OVER THE RECOMMENDATION IN THE MURPHY COMMISSION REPORT A FEW HEEKS AGO. THE AIDE ENTHUSIASTI-CALLY AGREED THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT DEPLOYMENT OF UNDERSECRETARY OF STATE CHARLES ROBINSON TO THE SOVIET UMION LAST WEEK TO NEGOTI-ATE A LONG-TERM GRAIN DEAL--AN UNPRECEDENTED CIRCUMVENTION OF CON-GRESS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE -- WAS EXACTLY THE KIND OF THING SYMINGTON HAD IN MIND IN INTRODUCING HIS BILL.

UNPRECEDENTED DROP IN BUSINESS LOAMS PRESAGES NEW GOV'T FISCAL CRUNCH

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- DUSINESS LOADS AT MAJOR NEW YORK BANKS FOR THE WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 17 FELL BY \$45 MILLION, ACCORDING TO FEDERAL RESERVE STATISTICS RELEASED YESTERDAY, A VIRTUALLY UNPRECEDENTED OCCURRENCE FOR MID-SETEMBER INCOME TAX PAYMENT PERIOD. CORPORATIONS NORMALLY BORROW HEAVILY DURING THIS PERIOD TO MEET TAX PAYMENTS -- IN FACT THIS IS THE FIRST TIME "IN AT LEAST 15 YEARS...AND PERHAPS IN YEARS PRIOR," ACCORDING TO THE MEW YORK TIMES, THAT SUCH A DROP HAS BEEN RECORDED. THE UNPRECEDENTED DEADLINE REFLECTS DRASTICALLY REDUCED CORPORATE INCOME. THE COMPLEMENTARY DROP IN CORPORATE TAX PAYMENTS TO CASH-STRAPPED STATE AND FEDERAL COFFERS WILL PRECIPITATE ANOTHER DRASTIC UPWARD REVISION IN TREASURY BORROWING NEEDS.

SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PAPER CALLS FOR TURKEY TO LEAVE NATO

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- IN A POWERFUL EDITORIAL WRITTEN IN THE SEPT. 12
TURKISH SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC DAILY CUMMURIYET, ALI SIRMEN CALLS EXPLICITLY FOR TURKEY TO STRENGTHEN RELATIONS WITH THE SOVIET UNION
AND TO SEVER ITS TIES MITH NATO. "SUCH A MOVE," MOTES SIRMEN, "NOT
ONLY WOULD RAPIDLY GET TURKEY OUT OF ITS ISOLATION (THE RESULT
OF THE U.S. ARMS EMBARGO) BUT ALSO MILL PROVIDE IT MITH NEW ECONOMIC RESOURCES." REPORTING THAT "MANY CIRCLES" INSIDE TURKEY ARE
SERIOUSLY CONSIDERING, THE "NEW ALTERNATIVES FOR TURKISH FOREIGN
POLICY" OFFERED BY THE SOVIETS, SIMMEN DEMANDS A REVIEW OF TURKISH-SOVIET RELATIONS AND CITES THE MEED FOR "MORE OPEN, FRIENDLY
AND CLOSER COLLABORATION. SIRMEN ATTACKS THE CIA-CONTROLLED
TURKISH GOVERNMENT FOR MOT MORKING MORE CLOSELY MITH THE SOVIET
UNION, ESPECIALLY IN THE LIGHT OF THE "MORSENING OF TURKISH-AMERICAN RELATIONS."

PAKISTANI MILITARY REVIVES DANGLADESH ISSUE TO DESTABILIZE BHUTTO

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- IN A MOVE TO BRING DOWN THE GOVERNMENT OF PRIME MINISTER ZULFIKAR ALL BHUTTO OF PAKISTAN, A GROUP OF HIGH-LEVEL MILITARY OFFICERS HAD MADE SOME PREPARATIONS CALLING FOR MAN OPEN TRIAL" FOR ALL THOSE RESPONSIBLE IN THE 1971 BANGLADESH DEBACLE

INCLUDING BHUTTO, ACCORDING TO LEFT-WING DAILY PATRIOT SEPT. 12. MAJOR GENERAL NIAZI AND OTHER MILITARY OFFICERS WERE SUBSEQUENT-LY OUSTED FROM THEIR POSITIONS IN A MAJOR MILITARY RESHUFFLE SEPT. 1.

THE MOVES BY THE FACTIONS IN THE MILITARY, KNOWN TO BE TRAINED BY THE U.S., CAME AS BHUTTO WAS ATTEMPTING TO REESTABLISH RELATIONS WITH BANGLADESH AND NORMALIZE RELATIONS WITH INDIA. THE NIAZI GROUP HAS CHARGED THAT, AS FOREIGN MINISTER DURING THE BANGLADESH WAR, BHUTTO WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR MISCUIDED POLICY ASSURANCES THAT THE UNITED STATES AND CHIMA WOULD MILITARILY AND/OR POLITICALLY GUARANTEE THAT THE INDIAN ARMY DID NOT LIBERATE THE THEN EAST PAKISTAN. SUBSEQUENTLY, THE OFFICERS CHARGED, THE MILITARY WAS MADE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MILITARY DEFEAT AND THE ATROCITIES THAT OCCURRED.

THESE MOVES BY THE RIGHT-WING ISLAMIC MILITARY FACTION REPRESENT STRONG PRESSURES BEING BROUGHT ON BHUTTO TO RETREAT FROM AN OPEN ENDORSEMENT OF THE PRO-DEVELOPMENT EURASIAN BLOC POLICIES IT PRE-SENTED AT THE UNITED NATIONS SPECIAL SESSION.

HOUSING LEADS "RECOVERY" TAILSPIN

SEPT. 19 (IPS) -- THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT HOUSING STARTS FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST EDGED UP A PALTRY 2 PER CENT. FROM DOLDRUM JULY LEVELS, AND PERMITS -- THE KEY INDICATOR OF FUTURE ACTIVITY -- DROPPED FULLY 5 PER CENT IN THE SAME PERIOD. "PERMITS REALLY SHOULD HAVE INCREASED," THE CHIEF ECONOMIST FOR THE NATION-AL ASSOCIATION OF HOME BUILDERS WAILED TO THE WALL STREET JOURNAL.

IPS ALSO CONFIRMED YESTERDAY THAT THE MORTGAGE MARKET IS IN A STATE OF COLLAPSE. LENDERS HAVE SHARPLY CURTAILED MORTGAGE LOANS IN ANTICIPATION OF AN OUTFLOW OF MONEY FROM SAVINGS AND LOANS AND OTHER KEY CONSTRUCTION LENDING INSTITUTIONS AS A RESULT OF THE SOARING INTEREST RATES ON TREASURY DERT.

FORD SHUTS DOWN SMALL CAR PLANT TO RELIEVE INVENTORIES

SEPT. 19 (IPS)—THE FORD MOTOR COMPANY HAS ANNOUNCED THAT IT WILL TEMPORARILY CLOSE DOWN OPERATIONS AT ONE OF ITS SMALL CAR ASSEMBLY PLANTS IN KANSAS CITY, MO. "TO RELIEVE A GROWING SURPLUS OF CERTAIN UNSOLD SMALL CARS," ACCORDING TO TODAY'S WALL STREET JOURNAL. THIS NEWS, COMING WHEN THE AUTO INDUSTRY IS ENTHUSIAS—TICALLY GEARING UP FOR A "RECOVERY," IS THE HARBINGER OF THE RENEWED COLLAPSE IN AUTO WHICH WILL TAKE HOLD OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF MONTHS. AS NEW SOLIDARITY HAS REPORTED, AUTO INVENTORIES ARE PRESENTLY BACKED UP TO EVEN HIGHER LEVELS THAN THOSE PRECEDING LAST OCTOBER'S SHUTDOWN.
