I. INTERNATIONAL

COMECON. UNCTAD MEETING TO DISCUSS EXPANDED TRADE. TRANSFER RUBLE

UNITED NATIONS. OCT. 3 (IPS) — UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT (UNCTAD) AND THE SOVIET BLOC TRADING COMMUNITY. THIRTY REPRESENTATIVES FROM THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES ARE MEETING TODAY IN MOSCOW TO DISCUSS THE MEANS FOR EXPANDING TRADE AND THE TRANSFER OF TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC RESOURCES BETWEEN THE TWO BLOCS.

RELIABLE SOURCES REPORT THAT THE PARTICIPANTS, INCLUDING ECONOMISTS FROM THE UNITED NATIONS, COMECON AND COUNTRIES SUCH AS INDIA, PERU, GHANA, ARGENTINA AND IRAN AMONG OTHERS, WILL DISCUSS THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TRANSFER RUBLE AS A MEANS OF EXPANDING TRADE. THE SAME SOURCES REPORT THAT A SUCCESFUL SETTLEMENT OF THE TECHNICAL QUESTIONS INVOLVED WILL PAVE THE WAY FOR A THIRD WORLD DECLARATION OF A MORATORIUM ON ITS DOLLAR DEBT, BECAUSE AN ALTERNATE WORLD MONETARY SYSTEM BASED ON THE TRANSFER RUBLE WILL THEN BE AVAILABLE.

KOSYGIN HITS U.S. OIL-FOR-GRAIN "OFFER"

OCT. 3 (IPS) — SOVIET PREMIER ALEXEI KOSYGIN BLASTED HENRY KISSINGER'S LONG-TERM OIL-FOR-GRAIN BLACKMAIL PROPOSAL TO THE SOVIETS YESTERDAY, ACCORDING TO U.S. DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL HOPE-FUL SARGENT SHRIVER, WHO MET WITH THE SOVIET LEADER FOR THREE HOURS YESTERDAY IN MOSCOW. ACCORDING TO SHRIVER, KOSYGIN SAID THAT THE OIL-FOR-GRAIN EXCHANGE WAS "CHARACTERISTIC OF THE PAST," MEANING, OBVIOUSLY, BARTER. HE SAID IT WAS OUT OF DATE AND UNNECESSARY. MODERN CREDIT AND BANKING ARRANGEMENTS MAKE POSSIBLE DEALING ON A COMPLETELY COMMERCIAL BASIS."

SHRIVER TOLD THE PRESS THAT "THE SOVIETS WANT TO PURCHASE GRAIN FOR CASH AND IF HE DON'T SELL IT. THEY WILL GET IT ELSEWHERE."
ACCORDING TO TODAY'S JOURNAL OF COMMERCE. KOSYGIN ALSO PREDICT—
ED THAT U.S.-USSR TRADE WOULD DOUGLE IN THE NEXT FIVE YEARS.

MEANWHILE, UNDERSECRETARY OF STATE CHARLES ROBINSON—WHOM KISS-INGER DEPLOYED TO MOSCOW TO MEGOTIATE A LONG-TERM GRAIN DEAL WITH IPS LATE 10.03 PAGE 2

THE SOVIETS—HAS BEEN SHUTTLED BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN VARIOUS SOVIET OFFICIALS AND HAS NOT BEEN RECEIVED BY KISSINGER.

SCHMIUT CALLS FOR FIXED RATES TO FACILITATE LOOTING

OCT. 3 (IPS) — WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT, TOGETHER WITH LUDWIG POULLAIN, CHAIRMAN OF THE WESTDEUTSCHE LANDESBANK GIROZENTRALE, CALLED YESTERDAY FOR FIXED EXCHANGE RATES BETNEEN THE DOLLAR AND EUROPEAN CURRENCIES, EXPLICITLY TO FACILITATE MASSIVE CAPITAL DRAINS FROM EUROPE TO THE U.S. THE INFLUX OF CAPITAL TO THE U.S. IS TO BE BASED ON ROCKEFELLER'S CURRENT PUSH FOR FASCIST WAGE POLICY IN THE U.S. THEY SPOKE AT THE U.S. COUNCIL OF THE INTERNATIONAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IN NEW YORK.

FINANCIAL ANALYSTS AT MONEY MANAGER MAGAZINE FURTHER TERMED THEIR PROPOSAL A "COMPROMISE" WITH GAULLIST DEMANDS FOR A GOLD-BASED FIXED-RATES SYSTEM IN WHICH "THE U.S. AGREES TO FIXED RATES IN RETURN FOR THE DEMONETIZATION OF GOLD."

SCHMIDT ASKED "CLOSER COOPERATION AND A SKILFUL INTERVENTION POLICY" BY U.S. AND EUROPEAN CENTRAL BANKS FOR "ACTUAL EXCHANGE RATE STABILITY." POULLAIN POINTED OUT THAT PRESENT EXCHANGE RATES, WHICH HAVE ALREADY BEEN VIRTUALLY FIXED BY CENTRAL BANK COOPERATION, "WERE AN EXCELLENT BASIS FOR INVESTMENT IN THE U.S." WITH ITS "LOW LABOR COST." POULLAIN SAID HE WAS "ABSOLUTELY CONVINCED" THAT GERMAN INTEREST RATES MOULD SOON BE LOWERED FURTHER, ENCOURAGING MASSIVE FLOWS OF FUNDS INTO THE NEW YORK MARKETS.

BANGEMANN FAILS TO BREAK UP SPD-FDP COALITION -FORCED TO RESIGN

OCT. 3 (IPS) — MARTIN BANGEMANN. THE GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE WEST GERMAN FREE DEMOCRATIC PARTY (FDP). HAS BEEN FORCED TO RESIGN FROM HIS POSITION. THE FDP IS THE PARTNER OF THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY (SPD) IN MEST GERMANY'S COALITION GOVERNMENT. BANGEMANN'S RESIGNATION WAS FORCED BY PARTY COLLEAGUES WHO MERE HORRIFIED AT BANGEMANN'S PERSISTENT ATTEMPTS TO WRECK THE COALITION. SINCE HE BECAME GENERAL SECRETARY LAST YEAR, BANGEMANN'S CRUDE ATTEMPTS TO WRECK THE COALITION AND FORM A NEW GOVERNMENT WITH THE OPPOSITION CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION PARTY, HAVE EXPOSED HIM AS A KEY ROCKEFELLER AGENT INSIDE THE RULING COALITION. HIS RESIGNATION WAS DEMANDED, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S SUEDDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG, BECAUSE "IN THE FDP, DEBATE ABOUT THE COALITION IS THOUGHT TO BE VERY DANGEROUS.

PCF DEFINES "PLURALISM"

OCT. 3 (IPS) — FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) POLITBURO MEMBER ROLLAND LERGY TODAY BLASTED ULTRALEFTIST PROVOCATIONS CARRIED OUT UNDER THE RUSE OF THE MOBILIZATION AGAINST THE SPANISH FRANCO GOVERNMENT. LERGY ACCUSED THE "GAUCHISTE" AGENTS OF FURNISHING "THE OCCASION DREAMED OF BY (INTERIOR MINISTER) PONIATOWSKI TO THREATEN TO PROHIBIT DEMONSTRATIONS."

SOVIET GENERAL WARNS AGAINST FRANCE REJOINING NATO

OCT. 3 (IPS) — FOLLOWING U.S. DEFENSE SECRETARY JAMES SCHLESINGER'S TOUR OF EUROPE, WHICH INCLUDED MEETINGS WITH FRENCH PRESIDENT GISCARD AND OTHER FRENCH OFFICIALS WHO FAVOR CLOSER TIES WITH THE UNITED STATES, YESTERDAY'S FRENCH DAILY LE MONDE FEATURED A GUEST OPINION COLUMN BY SOVIET GENERAL SVIATOSLAV KOZLOV. KOZLOV WARNED AGAINST THE REINTEGRATION OF FRANCE INTO NATO. AND. CITING THE HISTORICAL PRECEDENT OF GEN. DE GAULLE'S DEFINITIVE BREAK WITH NATO IN 1966, POINTED OUT THAT THIS IMMEDIATELY OPENED VAST NEW HORIZONS FOR THE FRENCH THROUGH EXPANDED RELATIONS WITH THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES. FRENCH ALLEGIANCE TO NATO. KOZLOV SAYS. MOULD THREATEN TO INVOLVE THE FRENCH "AGAINST THEIR WILL IN WARS NOT IN THEIR OWN INTERESTS."

PORTUGUESE PRESIDENT INVITES BREZHNEV TO VISIT PORTUGAL: COOPERATION ACCORDS SIGNED

OCT. 3 (IPS) — PORTUGUESE PRESIDENT COSTA GOMES, CURRENTLY IN MOSCOW ON AN OFFICIAL VISIT, INVITED SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY GENERAL SECRETARY, LEONID BREZHNEY, AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE SUPREME SOVIET, MIKOLAI PODGORNI, TO VISIT PORTUGAL. THE INVITATIONS WERE ACCEPTED "WITH GRATITUDE," ACCORDING TO TASS, THE SOVIET NEWS AGENCY. BURING GOMES, VISIT, A SOVIET-PORTUGUESE DECLARATION WAS SIGNED ALONG WITH A COLLABORATION ACCORD IN THE FIELDS OF CULTURE AND SCIENCE, AND A LONG-TERM ECONOMIC, SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL COOPERATION ACCORD.

WORKER-PEASANT ALLIANCE FORGED IN NORTHERN PORTUGAL

OCT. 3 (IPS) — A MEETING OF THE CENTRAL LABOR COUNCIL IN THE NORTHERN PORTUGUESE CITY OF OPORTO, HAS PASSED A MOTION SUPPORTING "THE REVOLUTIONARY STRUGGLE OF THE AGRICULTURAL WORKERS, WHICH IS AN INDISPENSABLE CONDITION FOR SMASHING THE REACTION AND CONSTRUCTION OF SOCIALISM," ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S LISBON DAILY DIARIO DE NOTICIAS. THE WORKERS ALSO DECIDED TO HOLD A "DAY OF CLARIFICATION AND DEBATE" ON OCTOBER 12 IN OPORTO, TO DISCUSS AGRARIAN REFORM, TO WHICH BOTH AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL WORKERS HAVE BEEN INVITED, ALONG WITH "ALL THE LEADERS OF THE AGRICULTURAL

WILL FORD'S NEWARK VISIT GIVE ROCKEFELLER THE PRESIDENCY?

OCT. 3 (IPS) — TOMORROW PRESIDENT FORD WILL TRAVEL TO NEWARK, NEW JERSEY FOR A GOP FUND-RAISING DINNER. AT THE SAME TIME, NEWARK MAYOR KENNETH GIBSON HAS GRANTED PERMITS TO TWO GROUPINGS OF BRAINWASHED ZOMBIES—THE "REVOLUTIONARY UNION" AND THE FORCES OF BLACK ZOMBIE "IMAMU IMIRI BARAKA" TO DEMONSTRATE IN THE VICINTY OF FORD'S APPEARANCE. WHILE THE CITY RALLY PERMITS HAVE ALREADY BEEN GRANTED TO THE HIGHLY UNSTABLE AGENTS, LEAA POLICE DIRECTOR HUBERT WILLIAMS HAS NOT YET MADE "A FINAL DECISION ON WHERE THE DEMONSTRATORS WOULD BE ALLOWED TO GATHER." THE RU IS AN F.B.I. CREATION, EXPOSED BY IPS AS FORMING PART OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL'S DRUG, GUN, AND EXPLOSIVES—RUNNING OPERATION CENTERED IN READING, PENNSYLVANIA. "BARAKA" WAS EXPOSED IN 1973 AS A SYNTHETIC PRODUCT OF AN INTERNATIONALLY ACTIVE COUNTERINSURGENCY AND BRAINWASHING CENTER—LONDON'S TAVISTOCK CLINIC.

THE EAST ORANGE OFFICE OF THE NATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITCES HAS TURNED OVER TO THE SECRET SERVICE WRITTEN INFORMATION WARNING THE IMMEDIATE POTENTIAL DANGER TO FORD BY THE PRESENCE IN THE AREA OF AIR FORCE INTELLIGENCE AGENT H. BRUCE FRANKLIN. A FORMER R.U. CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBER. WHO RECENTLY BEGAN TO TEACH AT THE NEWARK CAMPUS OF RUTGERS UNIVERSITY. FRANKLIN IS AN OUTSPOKEN MADIST AND HAS DEFENDED TERRORISM. THE DOCUMENTS ALSO WARNED OF THE R.U. AND THE BARAKA GANG. AND IMPLICATED VICE PRESENT ROCKEFELLER IN THE TERRORIST OPERATIONS WHICH SPAWNED THE TWO ASSASSINATION ATTEMPTS ON FORD LAST MONTH.

KENNEDY ATTACKS LEAA

OT. 3 (IPS) — SENATOR EDWARD KENNEDY (D.-MASS.) HAS BLASTED THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION FOR NOT COMBATTING CRIME, ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S WASHINGTON STAR. SPEAKING AT SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE SUBCOMMITTEE REVIEWING THE LEAA. KENNEDY WARNED THAT THE LEAA WAS "NO LONGER A SACRED COW" WHICH GOULD AUTOMATICALLY RECEIVE FUNDS, AND PROPOSED TO EXTEND THE LEAA'S FUNDING FOR ONLY TWO YEARS, INSTEAD OF THE FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION SOUGHT BY THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT TO ENSURE THE LEAA'S LONG-RANGE PROJECTS.

SENATOR THOMAS EAGLETON (D.-MO.) TESTIFIED BEFORE THE COMMITTEE AND PROPOSED THAT THE LEAA BE RESTRICTED TO A FEW STATES OR COM-UNITIES WHERE "THE TOTALITY" OF ITS PROGRAMS COULD BE EVALUATED.

DON'T TAKE KRESGE'S FOR GRANTED

OCT. 3 (IPS) — W.T. GRANT'S, THE THIRD LARGEST DISCOUNT CHAIN STORE IN THE UNITED STATES, FILED FOR BANKRUPTCY YESTERDAY IN THE LARGEST FINANCIAL COLLAPSE IN RETAIL HISTORY. THE BANKRUPTCY THREATENS MORE THAN ONE BILLION DOLLARS IN LOANS EXTENDED BY 30 BANKS AND RAISES THE POSSIBILITY OF ACTUAL BANK FAILURES. ACCORDING TO THE WALL STREET JOURNAL, "SUCH SMALLER BANK CREDITORS OF GRANT'S PARTICULARLY THOSE WORRIED ABOUT THEIR HOLDINGS OF NEW YORK CITY BONDS AND REAL ESTATE MIGHT HAVE THEIR OWN CREDIT IMPAIRED." WHILE MOST FINANCIAL ANALYSTS INTERVIEWED BY IPS REFUSED TO SPECULATE ABOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF A BANK RUN, THEY ALL AGREED THAT SUCH "LOAN LOSSES" WOULD IMPAIR THEIR ABILITY TO FINANCE THE MUCH-HERALDED ECONOMIC RECOVERY.

THE U.S. LABOR PARTY IS CONDUCTING A NATIONWIDE POLITICAL STRIKE AGAINST THE KRESGE-K-MART RETAIL CHAIN, ALSO REPUTED IN PRECARIOUS FINANCIAL CONDITION.

FEDERAL OFFICIALS MOOT SUPPORT OF NYC

NEW YORK, OCT. 3 (IPS) — NEW YORK STATE AND CITY BONDS CONTINUED TO RECEIVE NO BIDS FOR THE FOURTH STRAIGHT BUSINESS DAY, SETTING OFF WHOLESALE PANIC AMONG GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND BANKERS. IN WHAT IS BEING VIEWED AS A SUDDEN PANIC REVERSAL, FEDERAL RESERVE BOARD CHAIRMAN ARTHUR BURNS AND TREASURY SECRETARY SIMON HAVE NOW CONCEDED THAT THE NEW YORK CRISIS HAS REACHED SEVERE PROPORTIONS WHICH MIGHT REQUIRE FEDERAL INTERVENTION. MEANWHILE, THE HEAD OF ONE OF THE NATION'S LARGEST MUNICIPAL BROKERAGE FIRMS, WHO FOR MONTHS HAS WELCOMED A NEW YORK CITY DEFAULT, NOW ADMITS THAT SUCH A DEFAULT WILL PRODUCE "AN INTERNATIONAL DEPRESSION" AND SHOULD BE AVOIDED AT ALL COSTS BY FEDERAL RESERVE BANK BAIL—OUT OPERATIONS.

IN A RELATED DEVELOPMENT WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT WAS QUOTED IN THE WASHINGTON POST ACCUSING PRESIDENT FORD OF PLAY-ING WITH FIRE BY NOT COMING TO THE AID OF THE CITY. FORD, HOWEVER, REITERATED HIS HERBERT HOOVER STRATEGY OF NON-INTERVENTION TODAY.

NEW YORK TIMES HITS S-1

OCT. 3 (IPS) — TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES EDITORIAL TELLS CONGRESS THAT THE S-1 BILL—WHICH IT POINTS OUT WOULD MAKE NEWSMEN AS WELL AS THEIR SOURCES LIABLE TO SEVERE FINES AND UP TO SEVEN YEARS IN JAIL FOR "DISCLOSING SOMETHING VAGUELY CALLED "NATIONAL DEFENSE INFORMATION"—MUST BE EITHER " REVISED THOROUGHLY OR REJECTED OUTRIGHT BY THE SENATE."

PIKE COMMITTEE VOTES TO SUBPOENA KISSINGER DOCUMENT

OCT. 3 (IPS) — BY A VOTE OF 9-2 YESTERDAY, THE HOUSE SELECT COM-MITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES VOTED TO SUBPOENA SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER TO PRODUCE A SECRET MEMORANDUM ON THE 1974 CYPRUS CRISIS. THE MEMORANDUM WAS WRITTEN BY A FORMER STATE DEPARTMENT CYPRUS CHIEF, THOMAS BOYATT, WHO TOLD THE COMMITTEE THAT HE WAS PROHIBITED BY AN ORDER FROM KISSINGER FROM TESTIFYING ON HIS RECOMMENDATIONS DURING THE CYPRUS CRISIS.

ACCORDING TO TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN. PIKE SAID THAT THE SUBPOENA IS NOT AIMED AT SETTLING THE COMMITTEE'S DISPUTE WITH THE
SECRETARY OF STATE OVER A NEW POLICY DIRECTIVE PROHIBITING LOWERLEVEL OFFICIALS FROM TESTIFYING ON RECOMMENDATIONS THEY MAKE IN
THE DEVELOPMENT OF U.S. FOREIGN POLICY. SAID PIKE: "THAT IS
SORT OF SITTING THERE AS A VERY SERIOUS DISAGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
COMMITTEE AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE."

SABOTAGE AT WASHINGTON POST MAY BE AIMED AT HALTING PRESS ATTACKS ON ROCKEFELLER

OCT. 3 (IPS) — THE WASHINGTON STAR YESTERDAY REFUSED A REQUEST BY THE WASHINGTON POST, WHOSE OWN PRESSES HAVE BEEN DESTROYED, ALLEGEDLY BY MEMBERS OF THE STRIKING NEWSPAPER AND GRAPHIC COMMUNICATIONS UNION, TO PRINT THE POST, SAYS TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. IPS IS INVESTIGATING WHETHER THE ATTACK ON THE POST, OWNED BY KATHERINE GRAHAM, A LEADING SPOKESMAN FOR THE LIBERAL WING OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY, IS A WARNING TO NEWSPAPERS WHICH ARE ATTACKING ROCKEFELLER'S POLICIES AND BEGINNING TO PUBLISH DETAILS OF HIS DRUG AND TERRORIST OPERATIONS.

NEW YORK TIMES COLUMNIST JAMES RESTON TODAY PROPOSED THAT THE STAR PRINT THE POST EVEN IF THE STAR IS FINANCIALLY RUINED AS A RESULT. THE STAR RECENTLY PRINTED A FRONT-PAGE ARTICLE ON FORMER CIA AGENT ROY FRANKHAUSER'S EXPOSE OF CIA-FBI DRUG AND GUN-RUNNING OPERATIONS.

CHASE INSOLVENT

OCT. 3 (IPS) — A LEADING CANADIAN FINANCIAL CONSULTANT CONFIDED TO IPS YESTERDAY THAT IT IS "GENERALLY ACCEPTED THAT THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK IS INSOLVENT."

TANNIAN: "I'LL DO IT BECAUSE I WANT TO AND NOT BECAUSE YOU TELL ME TO."

THEN, REFERRING TO A POLICE SERGEANT WHO HAS BEEN HARASSING USLP'ERS AT KRESGE PARKING LOTS, TANNIAN VOLUNTEERED: "YOU'LL HAVE NO TROUBLE WITH CAPIZZO AGAIN."

THE POLICE COMMISSION WILL MEET ANYWAY. ON OCT. 9. TO GIVE FOR-MAL CONSIDERATION TO AN ORDER REQUIRING TANNIAN TO PERMIT THE USLP TO CAMPAIGN.
