I. WORLD PRESS ROUND-UP -- INTERMATIONAL NEWS

SCHMIDT ATTACKS DOLLAR EMPIRE

WIESBADEN, BRD OCT. 14 (IPS) -- SPEAKING BEFORE THE ANNUAL CON-GRESS OF THE GERMAN EMPLOYEES' ASSOCIATION (DAG) HERE, WEST GER-MAN CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT HINTED IN THE DIRECTION OF A BREAK WITH THE ROCKEFELLER-DOLLAR MACHINE, CALLING FOR EXPANDED EAST-WEST TRADE AND STATING: "I DO NOT WANT TO BE MISUNDERSTOOD.I DO NOT THINK THAT IF HAVE DEGATIVE INTENTIONS WHEN I STRESS THAT THERE WAS ONE COUNTRY WHICH SPENT A LOT OF MONEY FOR PRODUCTION WHICH DID NOT PRODUCE WEALTH, BUT RATHER FOR MEANS OF DESTRUCTION, FOR THE WAR IN SOUTH-EAST ASIA."

ACTING UNDER EXTREME PRESSURE FROM WEST GERMANY'S ANTI-DOLLAR FACTIONS IN ALL PARTIES, SCHMIDT DREW THUNDEROUS APPLAUSE FROM THE ASSEMBLED TRADE UNIONISTS WHEN HE SHOUTED, "LOOK AT POLAND, GODDAMMIT! IF WE WANT TO GUARANTEE AND INCREASE OUR EMPLOYMENT HERE, THEN WE HAVETO GIVE THEM THE CREDIT SO THAT THEY CAN ORDER AND PAY FOR INDUSTRIAL GOODS FROM WEST GERMANY."

FLATLY REJECTING THE NATO POLICY OF TRADE WAR AGAINST THE EAST BLOC PUT FORWARD BY THE U.S. AT MEETINGS IN COPENHAGEN TWO WEEKS AGO, SCHMIDT MAINTAINED THAT "IF YOU MANT TO SECURE PEACE, YOU ARE FORCED TO MAKE COMPROMISES NITH YOUR MEIGHBORS."

SOVIETS/PCF CALL ON GISCARD TO CONCRETIZE FRANCO-SOVIET COOPERATION

OCT. 14 (IPS) --ON THE EVE OF FRENC'I PRESIDENT GISCARD D'ESTAING'S TRIP TO THE SOVIET UNION, SOVIET PRESS AND THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) HAVE CALLED ON GISCARD TO ONCE AND FOR ALL "CONCRET-IZE" HIS MUCH-TOUTED COMMITMENT TO COOPERATION BETWEEN THE TWO NATIONS.

YESTERDAY'S L'HUMANITE, MEWSPAPER OF THE PCF, SUGGESTS THAT THE PRESIDENT DEMONSTRATE MIS "GOOD INTENTIONS" BY SIGNING THE TREATY PROHIBITING MUCLEAR TESTING, AND PARTICIPATE IN THE VIENNA ARMS CONTROL TALKS. IN ADDITION, THE PCF DEMANDS THAT GISCARD OPPOSE WEST GERMAN CALLS FOR THE REINTEGRATION OF BERLIN INTO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC.

PCP WARNS GOVERNMENT AGAINST RIGHTWING COURSE

OCT. 14 (IPS) -- THE POLITICAL COMMISSION OF THE PORTUGUESE COM-MUNIST PARTY (PCP) HAS RELEASED A COMMUNIQUE BLASTING THE GOVERN-MENT FOR NOT TAKING MEASURES AGAINST THE POPULAR DEMOCRATIC PARTY FOR THE VIOLENCE THAT IT INSTIGATED LAST WEEKEND IN THE NORTHERN CITY OF OPORTO. THE PCP COMMUNIQUE WARNED THE GOVERNMENT THAT SUCH POLICY ON ITS PART "IS NOT DIRECTED AGAINST THE REACTION, AS FORESEEN IN THE PLATFORM FOR THE FORMATION OF THE 6TH PROVIS-IONAL GOVERNMENT," AND IS THEREBY ILLEGAL. THE COMMUNIQUE WAS PUBLISHED IN YESTERDAY'S NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, NEWSPAPER OF THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

ECOMOMIST ADMITS POLICE CONTROL OF SPAIN'S LEFT TERRORIST GROUPS

ONCT. 14 (IPS) -- "THERE ARE GROUNDS FOR BELIEVING THAT PSEUDO-LEFT GROUPLETS IN SPAIN HAVE ON OCCASION BEEN SPONSORED BY THE PO-LICE FOR POLITICAL REASONS AND IN ORDER TO INFILTRATE A MORE IM-PORTANT ORGANIZATION," THE LATEST ISSUE OF THE INFLUENTIAL BRITI-ISH MAGAZINE "THE ECONOMIST" HAS NOTED. THE ARTICLE ADDS THAT "ONE SUCH GROUPLET, HAVING OBTAINED ADVICE FROM ETA (THE BASQUE TERRORIST ORGANIZATION) AND ARMS FROM A MAFIA SUPPLIER, WENT IN-TO BUSINESS ON ITS OWN ACCOUNT AND CAPRIED OUT AN EMBARRASSING OPERATION."

AGENTS STRENGTHENED IN SPANISH MILITARY RESHUFFLE

OCT. 14 (IPS) -- WHEN HALF OF SPAIN'S EIGHT MAINLAND REGIONAL ARMY COMMANDERS WERE RESHUFFLED INTO OTHER POSITIONS LAST FRIDAY, ONE OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT CHANGES WAS THE REPLACEMENT OF ULTRA-RIGHT LT. GEN. ANGEL CAMPANE OF THE CRUCIAL MADRID MILITARY RE-GION BY LT. GEN. ALVAREZ-ARENAS PACHECO, A FORMER REPUBLICAN OFF-ICER WHO, ACCORDING THE THE OCT. IO NEW YORK TIMES "HAS TAKEN COURSES AT FORT BENNING, GEORGIA." AT THE SAME TIME, GEN. MANUEL DIEZ-ALEGRIA, WHO IS KNOWN TO BE CLOSELY LINKED TO THE DEPUTY DIR-ECTOR OF THE CIA, VERNON WALTERS, "IS DUE TO ASSUME TWO KEY CON-STITUTIONAL AND POLITICAL ROLES AT THE BEGIMNING OF NEXT YEAR" WHEN HE WILL TAKE SEATS ON THE COUNCIL OF THE REGENCY AND THE COU-CIL OF THE REALM, REPORTS THE OCT. 10 FINANCIAL TIMES. STOFFAES ARTICLE APPEARED IN A SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT ON PROB-LEMS OF THE PARIS CONFERENCE ON ENERGY AND RAW MATERIALS WHICH BEGAN TODAY.

LES ECHOS DECLARES "INEVITABLE BANKRUPTCY" OF NEW YORK CITY, CALLS FOR BAILOUT

OCT. 14 (IPS) -- THE FRENCH FINANCIAL DAILY, LES ECHOS, WARNED ON OCT. 10 THAT THE "INEVITABLE BANKRUPTCY" OF NEW YORK CITY WOULD RUIN THE POSSIBILITY OF AN ECONOMIC UPTURM IN THE UNITED STATES. THE ARTICLE EMPHASIZED THE DISASTROUS IMPACT OF A NEW YORK CITY BANKRUPTCY ON THE INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL MARKETS, AND STATED THAT IT COULD HAVE "A DOMINO EFFECT" AND CREATE "A CRISIS OF CONFIDENCE" SIMILAR TO THAT FOLLOWING WEST GERMANY'S HERSTATT BANK FAILURE LAST SPRING. LES ECHOS CONCLUDED BY CALLING ON THE FEDERAL RESERVE TO ENGAGE IN MAJOR BAILING-OUT OPERATION FOR SHAREHOLDERS IN NEW YORK CITY DEBT.
