I. PRIORITIES

PEKING. NATO WARN OF SOVIET THREAT TO NATO SUPPLY ROUTES

DEC. 11 (IPS) — A CHINESE GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN FROM PEKING HAS CHARGED THAT "IF THE NEW CZARS TAKE CONTROL OF ANGOLA, THE SUPPLY ROUTES OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION (NATO) WILL BE THREATENED, " ACCORDING TO THE FRENCH DAILY LE FIGARO YESTERDAY.

IN A SIMILAR VEIN, ADMIRAL HILL NORTON, CHAIRMAN OF THE NATO MILITARY COMMITTEE, REPORTED AT NATO MEETING IN BRUSSELS YESTERDAY THAT THE COOPERATION OF SOMALI, GUINEA, NIGERIA AND ANGOLA WITH THE SOVIET NAVY SHOULD "UNDERLINE THE IMPORTANCE THAT THE SOVIETS ATTACH TO CUTTING THE WEST'S LIFELINE BETWEEN NORTH AMERICA AND EUROPE AND BETWEEN THE DIL PRODUCING AREA." HILL NORTON'S SPEECH WAS WIDELY QUOTED IN THE NEW YORK TIMES YESTERDAY.

CIA'S NATIONAL FRONT IN ANGOLA MAY VISIT WASHINGTON TO SEEK AID

DEC. 11 (IPS)—THE CIA-LED NATIONAL FRONT IN ANGOLA (FNLA) MAY
SHORTLY SEND A DELEGATION TO WASHINGTON AND OTHER WESTERN
CAPITALS TO DISCUSS ITS MILITARY NEEDS, ACCORDING TO
AN ARTICLE IN THE WASHINGTON POST TODAY WHICH CITED AN FNLA OFFICIAL
IN KINSHASA, ZAIRE, QUESTIONED ON THE REPORT, STATE DEPART—
MENT INFORMATION OFFICER JAMES POPE DENIED THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT
HAD ANY KNOWLEDGE OF FNLA REPRESENTATIVES COMING TO WASHINGTON.
MEXICAN AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE CONDEMNS "DEBT", WARNS OF DANGER OF WAR

DEC. 11 (IPS) — MEXICAN AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE, CARLOS FUENTES. STATED THAT TE "MAIN PROBLEM OF ECONOMIC DEPENDENCE IS DEBT." WHICH HAS DAMAGING EFFECTS ON BOTH UNDERDEVELOPED AS WELL AS DEVELOPED COUNTRIES. DURING AN TELEVISED INTERVIEW IN MEXICO DEC. 9.

FUENTES ALSO WARNED RECENTLY THAT "ECONOMIC WAR, AS WELL AS NUCLEAR WAR, ON THIS OCCASION WOULDN'T LEAVE A FIELD OF VICTORS AND DEFEATED. ALL OF US, WITHOUT EXCEPTION, WOULD BE DEFEATED," ACCORDING TO THE MEXICAN GOVERNMENT DAILY EL NACIONAL YESTERDAY.

FUENTES WHO WAS NAMED AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE ABOUT SIX MONTHS AGO. IS PART OF THE TEAM OF PRO-DEVELOPMENT LEFT-LEANING ADVISORS TO PRESIDENT LUIS ECHEVERRIA AND LAST PUT FORTH A PROGRAM FOR CAPITALIZING AGRICULTURE AND FOR INDUSTRIALIZATION.

CIA TERRORIST BOMB MEXICAN CONSULATE IN ARGENTINA

MEXICO CITY, DEC. 11 (IPS)—THE MEXICAN CONSULATE IN BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA WAS BOMBED THREE DAYS AGO BY A GROUP OF "CUBAN EXILES."

A TELEPHONE CALL TO THE MEXICAN CONSULATE BY AN INDIVIDUAL "WITH A CUBAN ACCENT" DESCRIBED THE BOMBING AS AN ATTACK. "IN RE-PUDIATION OF TRAITOR LUIS ECHEVERRIA, "FOR HIS FRIENDSHIP TO FIDEL CASTRO, ACCORDING TO THE MEXICO CITY NEWSPAPER ULTIMAS NOTICIAS DEC. 9.

THIS LATEST BOMBING COMES LESS THAN TEN DAYS AFTER ANTI-CASTRO CUBAN EXILES BOMBED TE CAR OF THE CUBAN AMBASSADOR TO MEXICO AND THE SOVIET TRADE OFFICES IN MEXICO CITY. IT IS WELL-KNOWN THAT THE CIA DIRECTS TERRORIST GROUPS OF ANTI-CASTRO CUBAN EXILES, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "GUSANOS."

PERUVIAN THIRD WORLDISM ATTACKED

DEC 11 (IPS)—THE LATEST ISSUE OF THE VENEZUELAN WEEKLY RESUMEN ATTACKED PERU'S TRADE RELATIONS WITH THE SOVIET UNION. CHARGING THAT "SOVIET UNION AND THE COUNTRIES OF THE RUSSIAN ORBIT DO NOT CONTITUTE A MARKET WHICH ALLOWS AN UNDER- DEVELOPED NATION TO DEVELOP." ATTACKING THE "THIRD WORLDISM" OF PRO-DEVELOPMENT PERU. RESUMEN CITES PERU'S PRECARIOUS ECONOMIC SITUATION AS A WARNING TO OTHER DEVELOPING NATIONS THAT IT DOES NOT PAY TO TRADE WITH THE SOVIETS. AND FURTHER REMINDS PERU THAT IT IS SURROUNDED BY COUNTRIES WITH CLEAR "ANTI-MARXIST" TENDENCIES.

THE ARTICLE APPEARED AT THE SAME TIME AS NEW YORK BANKS AND THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND HAVE LAUNCHED A CREDIT BLACKMAIL CAMPAIGN AGAINST PERU TO FORCE IT TO DROP ITS PRO-DEVELOPMENT STANCE.

MEXICAN PAPER DEVOTES FULL-PAGE AD TO PROMOTION OF NORTH-SOUTH CONFERENCE, SCIENTIFIC ADVANCES

DEC. 11 (IPS)—THE PROGRESSIVE MEXICAN DAILY EL SOL DEVOTED AN ENTIRE PAGE OF ITS DECEMBER 9 EDITION TO QUESTION OF INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC AND SCIENTIFIC DEVELOPMENT. THE KEYNOTE ARTICLE DEMANDS THAT THE ADVANCED SECTOR COUNTRIES AT THE NORTH-SOUTH CONFERENCE IN PARIS PARTICIPATE "WITH A GENUINE SPIRIT OF UNDERSTAND—ING AND COOPERATION," WHILE THE THIRD WORLD DELEGATES MUST "EFFECTIVELY SPEAK FOR THE WHOLE OF THE THIRD WORLD IN THE SEARCH FOR THE NEW INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC ORDER."

OTHER ARTICLES STRONGLY PROMOTE THE NECESSITY OF SCIENTIFIC DEVELOPMENT. "THE FUTURE OF MANKIND," EL SOL NOTES, "DEPENDS IN LARGE MEASURE ON THE ACHIEVEMENTS AND DISCOVERIES GENERATED IN SCIENTIFIC LABORATORIES AND IN THE TECHNOLOGICAL MEANS THAT MAN USES TO MAKE USE OF THE ENVIRONMENT WHICH SURROUNDS HIM." THE ARTICLE SINGLES OUT THE POSITIVE DEVELOPMENT OF RECENT SOVIET SCIENCE.

ARGENTINE MILITARY TARGETS FACTORIES IN "ANTI-SUBVERSION" WAR

DEC: 11 (IPS)—ARGENTINA'S SECURITY COUNCIL MET LAST WEEK WITH LABOR MINISTER RUCKAUF TO ANALYZE THE PROBLEM OF THE SO-CALLED "INDUSTRIAL GUERRIALLA" ACCORDING TO THE BUENOS AIRES DAILY LA OPINION DEC. 6. THE PROBLEM WILL DE DEALT WITH "FACTORY BY FACTORY" AS THE ARGENTINE ARMED FORCES ESCALTE THE "ANTI-SUBVERSION" WAR INTO DIRECT CONFRONTATION WITH THE WORK-ING -CLASS.

THIS MILITARY CAMPAIGN COMES AS THE ARGENTINA MILITARY IS ATTTEMPTING TO CRUSH THE REMNANTS OF LAST SUMMER'S STRIKE WAVE
IN ORDER TO INCREASE ARGENTINA'S FOREIGN DEBT SERVICE PAYMENTS
BY 50 PERCENT. THE PLANT-BY PLANT SCOPE OF THE OPERATION CLOSELY
RESEMBLES THE PAINSTAKING ANTI-WORKING CLASS MEASUES THAT WERE
FUNDERTAKEN AGAINST WORKERS IN NAZI GERMANY.

COLOMBIAN CP CONGRESS LAUNCHED EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN FOR CUMMUNIST CADRE

BOGOTA, DEC. 11 (IPS)—GILBERTO VIEIRA, GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE COLOMBIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCC), ANNOUNCED THAT THE PCC IS LAUNCHING A MASSIVE EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN FOR PCC CADRES TO PREPARE THEM FOR AN EXPECTED OUT BREAK OF MASS STRIKES THROUGHOUT COLOMBIA. VIEIRA MADE THE AMNOUNCEMENT IN THE CLOSING REMARKS OF HIS SPEECH TO THE 12TH PCC CONGRESS WHICH TOOK PLACE IN BOGOTA ON DECEMBER 9-15, 1975.
