## Crack British Troops Sent to Cyprus to Enforce NATO Control

July 27 (IPS) — The July 21 issue of the London Sunday Telegraph has unwittingly supplied supporting evidence for the IPS analysis that Britain and the U.S., through the CIA/NATO apparatus, have intentionally created a Northern Ireland-style "hot spot" in the eastern Mediterranean. The Telegraph reports that among the British UN forces transferred to Cyprus were an experienced armoured car squadron, B Squadron Blues and Royals, previously trained in counterinsurgent warfare in Northern Ireland.
