4TH PORTUGUESE COLAALITION DISSOLVED AFTER PPD RESIGNS; NEW GOVERNMENT IN THE OFFING

JULY 17 (IPS)--THE PORTUGUESE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL TODAY DISSOLVED THE CALITION GOVERNMENT AFTER THE CENTER-RIGHT POPULAR DEMOCRATIC PARTY (PPSD) RESIGNED FOLLOWING THE COUNCIL'S REJECTION OF ITS SO-CALLED DEMOCRATIC ULTIMATUM, REPORTS EAST GERMAN RADIO.

THE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL DESIGNATED THE TASK OF FORMING A NEW NEW GOVERNMENT TO THE PRO-COMMUNIST PRIME MINISTER, GEN. VASCO GON GONCALVES, WHO IS EXPECTED TO NAEME BOTH PROGRESSIVE MILITARY MEN AND MEN AN CIVILIAN TECHNOCRATS.

ACCORDING TO UPI, BOTH THE PPD AND THE SOCIALIST PARTY (PSP) . WHICH WAS OUTSSTED FROM THE GOVERNMENT EARLIER, ANNE NOW PLANNING TO HOLD ANTI-MILITARY DEMONSTRATIONS IN NORTHERN POORTUGAL, A TRADITIONAL RIGHTWING STRONGHOLD.

PORTUGUESE ECONOMIC BATTLES CALLED DESCISIVE

THE ARTICLE SPECIFICALLY ACCUSED PORTUGALS'S SOCIAL DEMOCRATS AND MADISTS MADISTS OF WORKING AS PROVOCATEURS FOR THE CAPITALISTS: "THE SABOTAGE SAVBOTAGE OF PRODUCTION ORGANIZED BY THE EXPLOITER CLASS, WHICH IS POLITICALLY ROUTED AND ECONOMICALLY CURTAILED, INCLUDES THE AGGRAVATION OF SOCIAL CONFLICTS, STRIKES AND DISTURBANCES. JULY 17 (IPS)--THE CIA PUPPET PRESIDENT OF AIZAIRE, MOBUTU SESE SEKO, TODAY INFORMED LISBON THAT HE MAY BE FORCED TO REVIDSE HIS "NEUTRAL" POLICY TOWARD THE CONFLICT IN ANGOLA IF PORTUGAL DOES NOT EDND ITS PROOCOMMUNIST AID TO THE PRO-COMMUNIST POPULAR MOVEMENT (MPLA) ACCORDING TO THE JULY 13 EDITION OF LE MONDE.

MOBUTU HAS ALREADY DONE EVERYTHING IN HIS POWER TO AID THE MAOI MAOIST NATINAL FRON TT (FNLA) SHORT OF FULL-CSCALE INVASION. LE LE MONDE ADDS THAT PORTUGUESE FOREIGN MINISTER MELO ANTUNES IN LISBON LISBON RESPONDED TO THE WAR THREAT BY SNDING UN SECRETARY=GENERAL WALHDHEIM A MESSAGE WARNING THAT POORTUGAL "MAY HAVE TO TAKE URGANE URGENT MEASURES" IF ZAIRE SHOULD INVADE ANGOLA.

JULY 17 (IPS)—CHINESE LEADER TENG HSAIIAO PENG HATOLD VISITING POLITICIANS THAT THERE HAS BEEN MORKER JNDREST OVER DEMANDS FOR HIGHER WAGES IN SEVERAL CHINESE CITIES AND THAT IN A FEW DOASES THE ARMY HAS BEEN USED TO SUPPORTESS AGITATION.
